Simple File or Candy Holder



Supply List:

- 148644 Hey Love Stamp Set
- 132708 Memento Tuxedo Black Ink

Project Details:

- Whisper White Thick Cardstock
 - Scrap to cut heart
- All My Love Designer Series Paper
 - 3-1/4" x 12"
- Crumb Cake Cardstock
 - 5/8" x 3-1/4"

Instructions:

1. Score the All My Love Designer Series Paper along the long side (12" side) at 4-1/2" and 4-3/4".
2. Add small strip of Crumb Cake Cardstock to the front of the pocket using Snail Adhesive.



3. Place candy bar or nail file packets in the pocket. Tie the Petal Pink Metallic Ribbon around the pocket, over the Crumb Cake Cardstock strip.
4. Stamp the bird image in Memento Tuxedo Black Ink on the Whisper White Thick Cardstock scrap. Color the bird body with Mint Macaron Blend, the heart on the bird with the Flirty Flamingo Blend, and the beak with the Calypso Coral Blend.
5. Cut the bird out using a heart from the Meant to Be Framelits.
6. Punch a hole in the top of the heart. Then use the Whisper White Bakers Twine to tie it on the Metallic Ribbon.

Project Details:

- Flirty Flamingo Cardstock
 - 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"
 - Scrap for die-cutting scallop stitched heart
- Soft Sea Foam Cardstock
 - 5-1/4" x 8"
 - 1" x 9-1/2"
- Whisper White Cardstock
 - 3-3/4" x 5"
 - Scrap for die-cutting stitched heart
- All My Love Designer Series Paper
 - 1-3/4" x 5" (two pieces)

Instructions:

1. Start with largest piece of Soft Sea Foam Cardstock, place it on Simply Scored Tool in landscape orientation, and score at 2" and 6".
2. Place 1" Soft Sea Foam strip in landscape orientation and score at 2-1/2" & 6-7/8"
3. Using Bone Folder, burnish on all score lines.
4. Adhere gate fold Soft Sea Foam Cardstock centered on Flirty Flamingo Cardstock.
5. Adhere the designer series paper to the front panels of the Soft Sea Foam gate fold.

6. Stamp floral heart in bottom right corner of Whisper White panel using Flirty Flamingo Ink.
7. Ink striped heart in Flirty Flamingo and stamp off once. Stamp image in the bottom right two times, stamping off each time.
8. Ink small heart in Flirty Flamingo and stamp off twice. Stamp image five times, each time stamping off twice, to fill in around the larger hearts. Adhere Whisper White panel to the inside of Soft Sea Foam Cardstock.



9. Wrap 1" Soft Sea Foam bellyband, ends to the front, around card base, and adhere closing the band with SNAIL adhesive.
10. Wrap Flirty Flamingo 1/8" ribbon around bellyband and tie a bow. Trim ends.
11. Stamp "Happy Valentines Day" in Soft Sea Foam Ink on Whisper White Cardstock. Die cut sentiment using coordinating heart framelit from the Be Mine Stitched Framelits.
12. Die cut coordinating scalloped heart framelit from Flirty Flamingo Cardstock. Adhere stamped heart on top of solid Flirty Flamingo heart using Multipurpose Glue. Adhere Flirty Flamingo Stitched Heart to belly band with Multipurpose Glue. TIP: Be sure to place your glue carefully, making sure the bellyband can slip on/off the card.

Project Details:

- Early Espresso Cardstock
 - Scraps for die-cutting two crate bases
 - Scrap for punching 1-1/4" Circle
- All My Love Designer Paper
 - Two pieces that are 3-1/8" x 1-1/2"
- Whisper White Cardstock
 - Scrap for stamping & punching 1" Circle
- Silver Foil Paper
 - Scrap for punching 1-1/8" Scallop Circle
- All My Love Lipstick Ribbon
 - 9"

Instructions:

1. Die-cut two Early Espresso crate bases. Then use the Bone Folder to help crease along the score lines.
2. Add Tear & Tape Adhesive as shown in the photo below.



3. Next attach the 3-1/8" x 1-1/2" designer paper pieces to the front and back of the box. Then assemble the two crate bases to form the box.
4. Loop the ends of the ribbon through the crate handles. Secure each ribbon end with a metallic brad. You should be able to just poke the brad prong through. But if not, make a starter hole with a push pin or a Paper-Piercing Tool.



- Stamp and punch the 1" Circle sentiment piece from the Whisper White Cardstock scrap. Punch the 1-1/8" Scallop Circle from the Silver Foil Sheet scrap. Punch the 1-1/4" Circle from the Early Espresso Cardstock scrap. Then layer these together using SNAIL.
- Add this to the front of the box using SNAIL. (Be sure to only add the SNAIL on the lower half of the back of the layered circles.)
- Embellish with Rhinestones.



- And add the candy/treat.

Project Details:

- Whisper White Thick Cardstock
 - 5-1/2" x 8-1/2"
 - Scraps for stamping and die cutting card pieces
- Needlepoint Nook Designer Series Paper
 - Two 4-1/4" x 5-3/4"
 - Two 4-1/4" x 2-3/4"
 - 3-3/4" x 5" (for card)
 - 1" x 3-3/4" (for card)
- Balmy Blue Cardstock
 - One stitched rectangle (for card)
- Poppy Parade Cardstock
 - 12" x 12"
 - 4" x 5-1/4" (for card)

Box Instructions:

1. Start with the 12" x 12" piece of card stock. Score at 3" and 9" on one side, turn the card stock 90 degrees and score at 4-1/2" and 7-1/2". Fold on all score lines.
2. Trim in on the 4-1/2" and 7-1/2" score lines on each side. Do not cut past the 3" and 9" score lines.



3. Add all designer series paper pieces to the box before assembling it. One of the larger pieces of designer paper and the two smaller pieces go on one end of the box. One larger piece goes on the opposite end of the box, see photo below.



4. Next add Tear & Tape adhesive to the flaps in the photo below. Remove the backing on the adhesive strips. Close up the side of the box that does not have adhesive on it first. Then fold up the side that has 3 strips of adhesive on it.



5. Fill the box with your choice of Valentine's treats.

Card Instructions:

1. Fold card base in half, and burnish with bone folder.
2. Layer Poppy Parade Cardstock on to card base. Layer Needlepoint Nook Designer Series Paper on to the Poppy Parade Cardstock. Add 1" strip of Needlepoint Nook Designer Series Paper on the left side of the card.
3. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the Balmy Blue stitched rectangle and add to the card base, over the 1" strip of Needlepoint Nook Designer Series Paper.
4. Use the scraps of Whisper White Thick Cardstock for stamping your images, then cut out using the Needlepoint Elements Framelits. Add the cut out pieces to the top of the Balmy Blue stitched rectangle as shown using Stampin' Dimensionals.



Valentine Nugget Holder

Project Details:

- Flirty Flamingo Cardstock
 - 3" x 7"
- All My Love Designer Paper
 - 2-¹/₂" x 2-⁷/₈"
 - 1-¹/₄" x 2-⁷/₈"
 - Three pieces of 1" x 3"

Instructions:

1. Score your 3" x 7" Flirty Flamingo piece of cardstock at 1-³/₈", 1-⁷/₈", 3-¹/₄" and 3-³/₄".
2. Fold and burnish all score lines.
3. With the Detailed Trio punch round corners of the Flirty Flamingo cardstock on the end closest to the 3-³/₄" score line. Then round two corners on one long side of the 2-¹/₂" x 2-⁷/₈" All my Love designer paper piece.
4. Add the designer paper to the Flirty Flamingo cardstock. Both rounded edges on the cardstock and designer paper should layer nicely together. This will create the back panel of your holder.

5. Add your Tear & Tape adhesive to the other end of the Flirty Flamingo cardstock up to the 1-3/8" score line to fold up and into the back panel. The edge should line up with the 3-3/4" score line. This will form your pocket to hold three Hershey Nuggets inside.
6. Adhere the 1-1/4" x 2-7/8" piece of All My Love designer paper to the front bottom section of your holder.
7. Stamp the Happy Valentine's Day greeting on a scrap piece of Whisper White cardstock with Flirty Flamingo classic ink. Punch out with the 1-3/4" Circle punch.
8. Punch out the Sparkle Glimmer paper with 2" Circle punch. Layer the greeting and the Sparkle Glimmer paper together with Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Tie a bow with the All My Love Ribbon pack in Flirty Flamingo color and adhere to the greeting with a Mini Glue Dot.
10. Adhere the greeting with bow to the holder with Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. Add Tear & Tape adhesive to both short ends of the three 1" x 3" pieces of All My Love designer paper. Wrap the three Hershey chocolate nuggets with designer paper to match your treat holder. Insert wrapped nuggets into the pocket (shown in photo below)

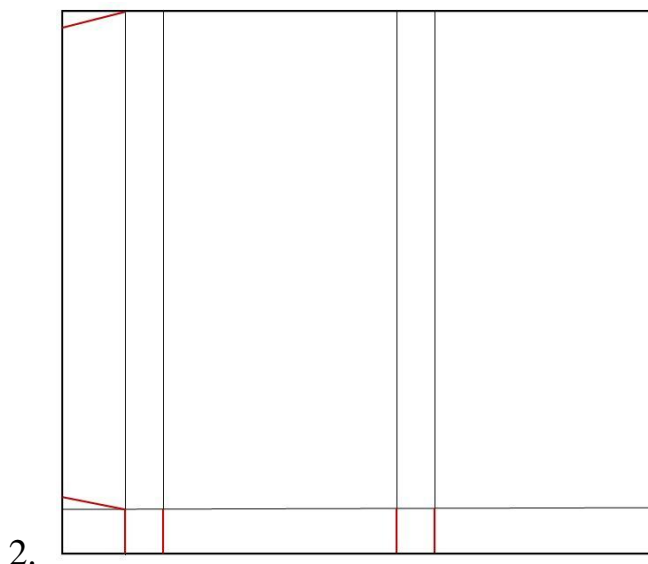
Project Details:

- Gingham Gala 6 x 6" Designer Series Paper
 - 5" Square
- Real Red Cardstock
 - 2" Scallop Layering Circle
- Whisper White Cardstock
 - 1-7/8" Stitched Circle
 - 1" x 1-3/4" scrap for die cutting tag from Wood Crate Framelits
- 3/8" Real Red Cotton Ribbon
 - 14" length

- Basic Black Solid Baker's Twine
 - 5" length

Instructions:

1. Prepare the candy bar bag. Score the 5" square at 3/8" then rotate 90 degrees. Score at 1/2", 7/8", 2-3/4", and 3-1/8". Cut as indicated by red lines on the score and cut diagram below. Close the bag with Tear & Tape Adhesive on the 1/2" tab and the left most bottom tab securing the box.



3. Stamp skunk image on the stitched circle with Memento ink and color with Stampin' Blends. Adhere to Real Red scallop circle with Mini Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere to the front of the bag with Tear & Tape Adhesive.
4. Add candy bar to the bag. I used Moser Roth from Aldi – they are a perfect fit for this little bag.
5. Pinch the sides of the bag to form a gusset. Punch through the bag at the center with the 1/8" Handheld Circle Punch. Thread 3/8" Real Red Cotton Ribbon through the hole and tie secure but hold off on the bow.
6. Stamp sentiment on the tag die cut from Wood Crate Framelits using Memento ink. Thread tag with Basic Black Solid Baker's Twine and tie a thread knot about an inch and a quarter from the tag.
7. Slip Basic Black Solid Baker's Twine loop over one of the tails of 3/8" Real Red Cotton Ribbon then tie a pretty bow and trim the tails. Secure the sentiment tag to the stitched circle using a single Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
