Let It Ride Pillow Box



Supply List:

- 148765 Let It Ride Cling Stamp Set
- 143982 Burlap Clear-Mount Stamp Set
- 146667 Itty Bitty Greetings Clear-Mount Stamp Set
- 132708 Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad
- 147273 Soft Suede Stampin' Blends Markers Combo Pack

Project Details:

- Whisper White Cardstock
 - 2-5/8" x 2"
 - 1" Circle

Instructions:

1. Gently take apart the Kraft Pillow Box and turn it inside out. Use Tear & Tape Adhesive to seal it closed.



2. Use the Sponge Brayer to ink up Burlap Stamp Set with the Crumb Cake Classic Stamp Pad and stamp it on both sides of the Pillow Box.
3. Use the Sponge Brayer with the Soft Suede Classic Stamp Pad to sponge the edges of the Pillow Box. You can also run it across the Pillow Box if you desire a darker shade.
4. Wrap the 5/8" Burlap Ribbon around the pillow box and tie it closed with a strand of the 5/8" Burlap Ribbon. To get one strand of the burlap ribbon, trim off one long edge and then pull each strand.
5. Add True Gentleman Button to burlap using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
6. Stamp Let It Ride image with the Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad on the Whisper White Cardstock that measures 2-5/8" x 2". Color the background with the Light Pool Party Stampin' Blends Marker. Color the horse with the Soft Suede Stampin' Blends Markers Combo Pack.
7. Stamp greeting with Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad on Whisper White Cardstock and cut it out with the 1" Circle Punch. Color background with the Light Pool Party Stampin' Blends Marker. Attach this layer to the main layer with a Stampin' Dimensional and then add to box using Liquid Glue on the Burlap.
8. This pillow box will hold a gift card or a small gift (candy, mini flashlight, swiss army knife, etc).

Pop Up for Dad Card

Project Details:

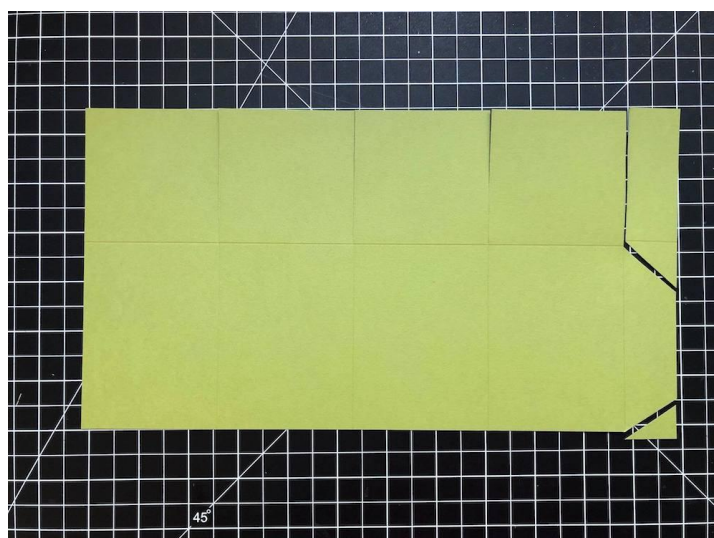
- Whisper White Cardstock
 - Scrap for stamping and die cutting the fish
- Old Olive Cardstock
 - 8-1/2" x 12" (After scoring in step one, you can cut the other pieces for inside of card.)
 - Three 1-1/2" circle punches
 - Scraps for die cutting three weeds
- Crushed Curry Cardstock
 - Scrap for die cutting the small fish
- Bermuda Bay Cardstock
 - Scrap for die cutting the small fish
- Wood Textures Designer Series Paper
 - Four 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares
 - Four 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles
- Window Sheets
 - 1/4" x 4" (then cut to fit when adding to card)

Instructions:

1. Score Old Olive cardstock on the 12" side at 2-3/4", 5-1/2", 8-1/4" and 11". Cut a 2" strip from this piece along the edge where the scores were made. The score lines are needed. With the 1" score line in trimmer first measure to 4-3/4" and cut to get a finished piece of 2" x 4-3/4". Cut this piece in half at 1" mark to create both of the insert pieces in the pop up card.



2. After cutting the 2" x 12" strip off in step one, the remaining piece will be 6-1/2" x 12". On the 6-1/2" side score at 2-3/4". Trim in on each of the score lines on the 2-3/4" side and trim away the top piece of the 1" scored area.



3. Add the larger pieces of designer series paper to the outside sections of the bottom. Add the 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" square pieces to the underside (which will become the inside) flaps at the top.

4. Use Tear & Tape Adhesive to close the box. Add the inserts with Tear & Tape on the small end square tabs. Attach one of them toward the front of the box and the other one facing the back of the box.



5. Add all the cut-out elements by attaching them to the inserts on the inside of the box. Stagger them on different inserts and use the window sheet pieces to create height for the fish and fly. The window sheets pop up out of the box but are not easily seen.
6. Stamp on the punched circles and attach them to the flaps with Dimensionals.

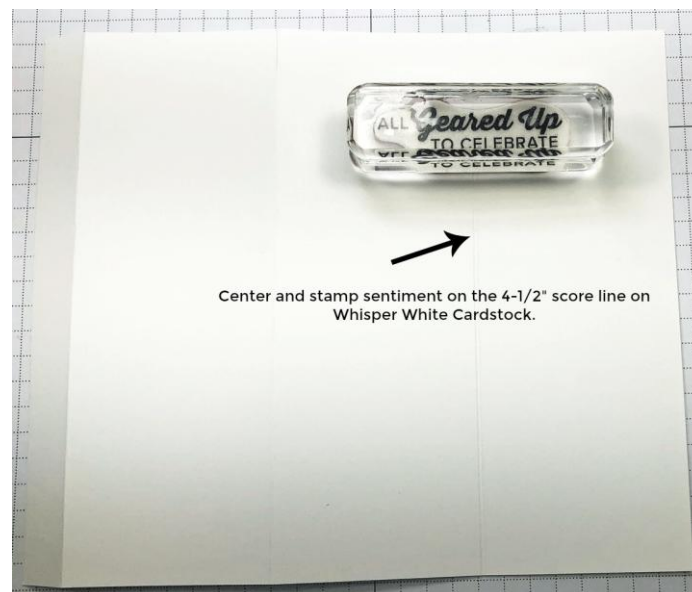
- Basic Black Cardstock
 - 3" x 3" for die-cutting scallop circle
 - Scrap for die-cutting gears
- Gray Granite Cardstock
 - 5-1/2" x 8-1/2"
 - Scrap for die-cutting tool box
- Real Red Cardstock
 - Scrap for die-cutting gas can
- Tranquil Tide Cardstock
 - 4" x 5-1/4"
 - Scrap for die-cutting Father's Day label
- Whisper White Cardstock
 - 5-1/2" x 6-1/2"
 - 3" x 3" for die-cutting circle

Instructions:

1. Score Gray Granite Cardstock (long side) at 4-1/4". Fold and burnish with Bone Folder.
2. Score Whisper White Cardstock (long side) at 1/2", 2-1/2", and 4-1/2". Fold and burnish 1/2" strip and 2-1/2" score line away from you. Fold and burnish the 4-1/2" score line the opposite way. See image below.

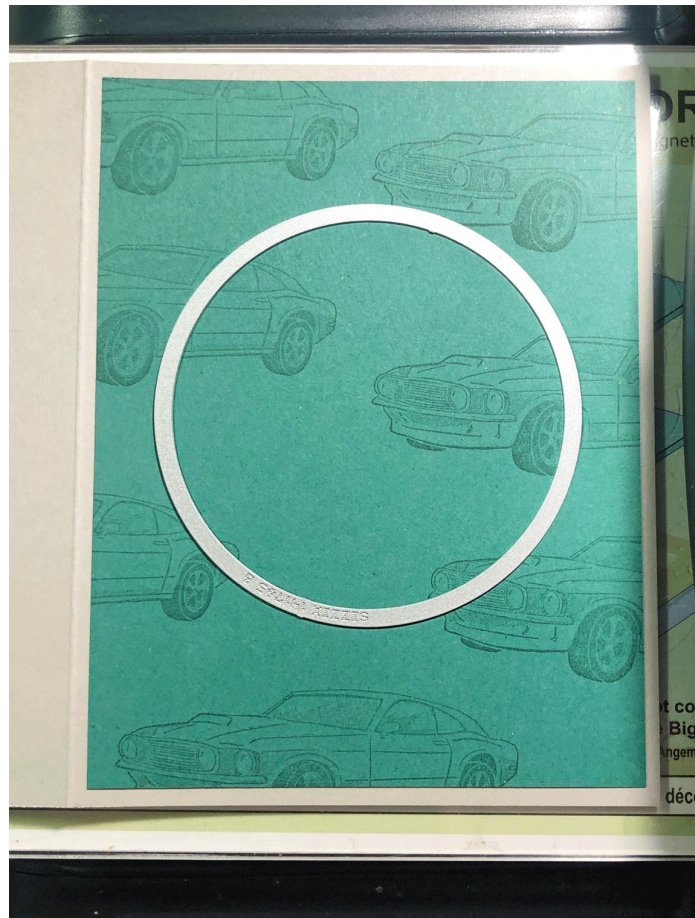


3. Stamp sentiment on the Whisper White Cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento Ink.



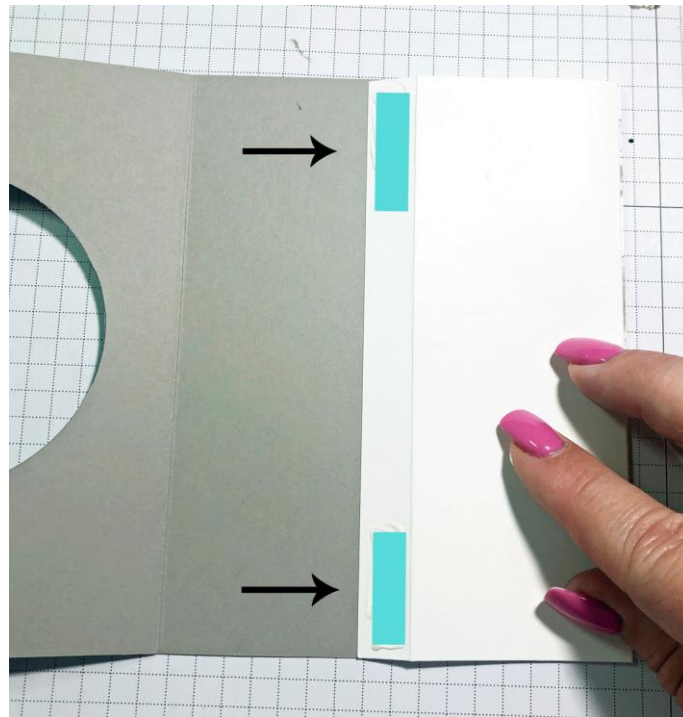
4. Stamp the “splotchy” background image around the sentiment and at the bottom of Whisper White Cardstock using Gray Granite Classic Stampin’ Pad.
5. Stamp car image multiple times on Tranquil Tide Cardstock using Tranquil Tide Classic Stampin’ Pad. Adhere layer to Gray Granite card base.

- Using the 3” plain circle from Layering Circle Framelits to cut a circle in the center.

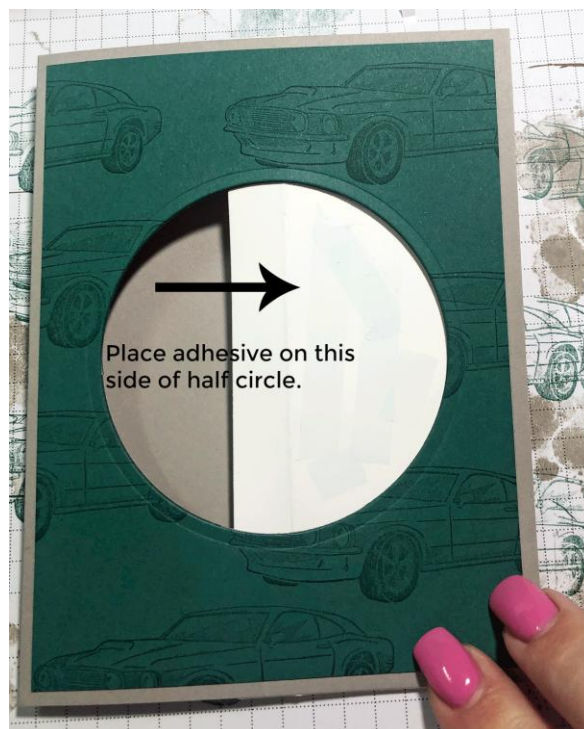


- Die-cut a 2-7/8” scallop circle from Layering Circle Framelits using Basic Black Cardstock. Die-cut a 2-1/2” plain circle using Whisper White Cardstock.
- Stamp the tool box image on Gray Granite Cardstock and gas can image on Real Red Cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento Ink. Use matching framelits from Geared Up Garage Bundle to cut out.
- Stamp “Happy Father’s Day” image on Tranquil Tide using Tuxedo Black Memento Ink cut out using die.
- Stamp the “splotchy” background image on the Whisper White circle using Gray Granite Classic Stampin’ Pad. Adhere this circle to the Basic Black scallop.
- Adhere “Happy Father’s Day” stamped image to center of Whisper White circle using Stampin’ Dimensionals.
- Adhere gas can, tool box and gear die-cuts at the bottom of Whisper White Cardstock.
- To adhere the Whisper White stamped panel to card base, only place adhesive on the last section (4-1/2”) of cardstock and attach. Be sure to line up with edge of Gray Granite Cardstock.

14. Place adhesive at top and bottom of the ½” side of Whisper White Cardstock. Adhere to inside front panel of card base.

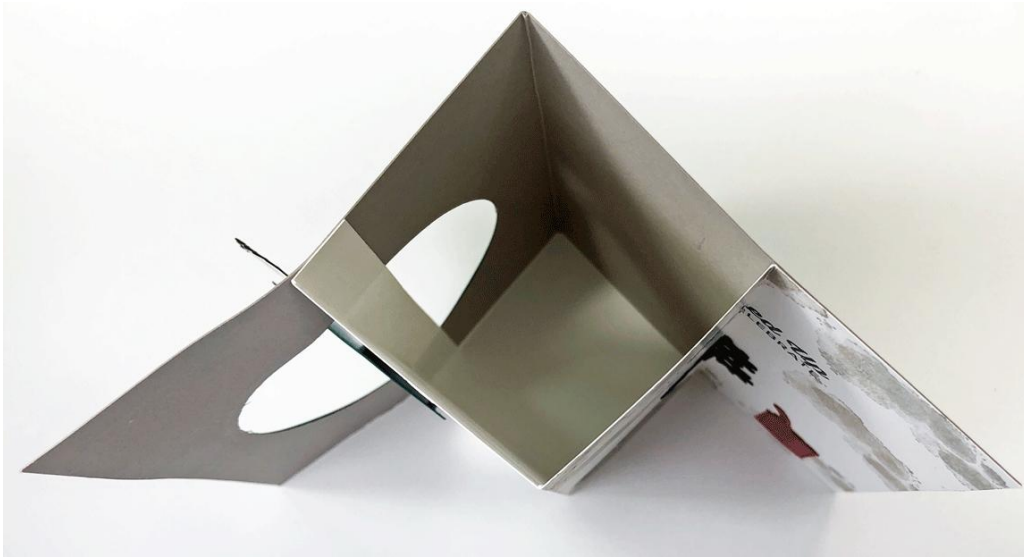


15. Place adhesive on the right part of circle. Do not put any adhesive on the ½” section.

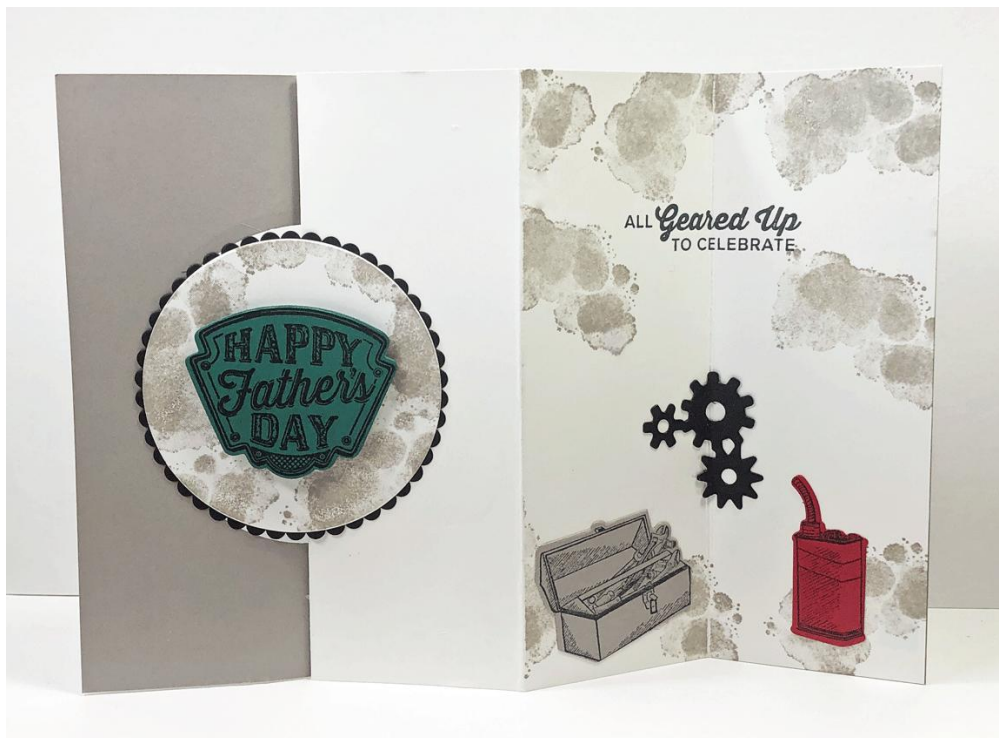


16. Adhere scallop circle to front of card. Open and close a couple of times to make sure all pieces are adhered well.

Geared Up Candy Box

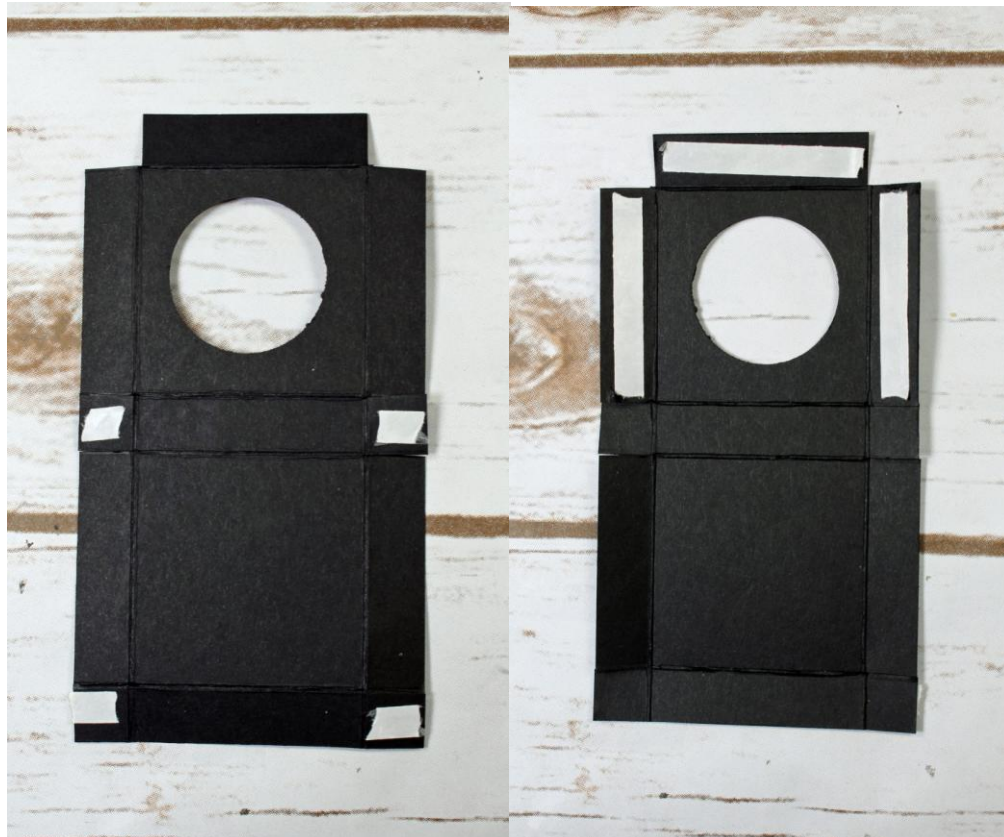

Project Details:

- Basic Black Cardstock
 - 2" x 8-1/2" scored on the 8-1/2" side at 3-1/4" and 5-1/4" (this is the outer box)
 - 3" x 5-1/2" scored on the 3" side at 1/2", 2-1/2" and 1/2" and on the 5-1/2" side at 2-1/2", 3" and 5" (this is the inner box).
- Silver Foil Paper
 - 2" x 3-1/4" for die cutting gears
- Classic Garage 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper
 - 1/2" x 2"
 - 1-3/4" x 2-1/4"

Instructions:

1. Cut and score your Basic Black Cardstock as per directions above and work all the score lines with a Bone Folder.
2. Die cut a window in the outer box by placing your smallest Rectangle Stitched Die about $\frac{3}{4}$ " above the first score line. Punch both ends of this strip with the Scalloped Tag Punch.
3. Trim the tabs for the inner box and cut a 1-3/8" circle (second from the smallest circle die). Apply adhesive as shown in the pictures below. Fold up your box and adhere between the 3-1/4" and 5-1/4" score lines on the outer box using Tear & Tape Adhesive.



4. Using Snail Adhesive, adhere the designer series paper pieces to the outer box as pictured in the main photo above.
5. Add candy to your box then close the top with a little bit of Tear & Tape Adhesive.
6. Die cut your gears from Silver Foil Sheets and decorate your box. Adhere the three little gears to the front of the box using bits of Mini Stampin' Dimensionals. Cover the back of the single gear with Snail and tack the loops of Silver Metallic

Thread in the Snail. Adhere the single gear to the top of the box and further secure with a staple.

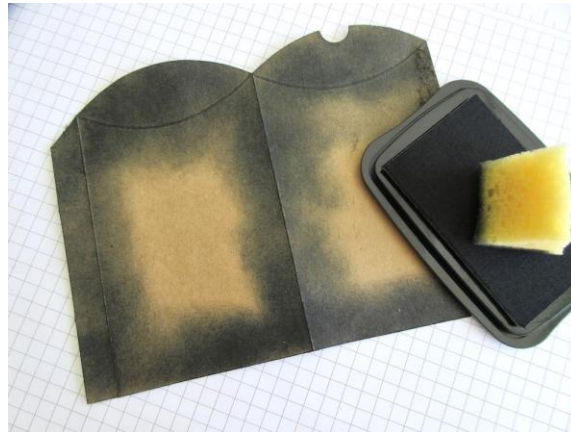

Project Details:

- Basic Black Cardstock
 - 3" x 8-1/2"
 - 1/2" x 3-1/2"
- Soft Suede Cardstock
 - Scrap for stamping and die-cutting the curved banner image
 - 1/2" x 3-1/2"
- Real Red Cardstock
 - 1/2" x 3-1/2"
- Classic Garage Designer Paper
 - Two red pieces that are 2-3/4" x 4-1/4"
 - Motorcycle print piece that is 3" x 5"
 - Gray piece that is 1/2" x 3-1/2"
- Basic Black Shimmer Ribbon
 - 11"

Instructions:

1. Open up a Kraft Pillow Box all the way by separating carefully at the seam. Then trim one inch off one end to remove a curved side.
2. Sponge Tuxedo Black ink on the Kraft side of the box. No need to do the centers of each section since they will be covered with designer paper. (Optional: Sponge the polka-dot side. This design will be on the inside but can be seen somewhat.)



3. Use a curved box scrap and a pencil to draw a line at the end of each red 2-3/4" x 4-1/4" designer paper piece. Then trim along the pencil lines.



4. Curve each red designer paper piece a bit with a Bone Folder.
5. Stamp each of the four 1/2" x 3-1/2" strips with the splatter image and be sure to add sentiments to the Real Red and Soft Suede ones (as shown below).
6. Stamp the "Born to Ride" banner image on the Soft Suede scrap and die-cut.
7. Punch one end of the 3" x 8-1/2" Basic Black piece with the 1-3/4" Circle Punch. Mark the other end 1/2" up from the bottom on each side and angle cut as shown. This will allow the cardstock to insert and connect into the pillow box.



8. It's time to glue! With the polka-dot pattern now on the inside secure the box shut by gluing the strip down. (It may not lie completely flat...that's okay.) When dry, open a bit to close the bottom end (tabbed end in first).
9. Glue the red Classic Garage Designer Paper pieces on the front and back of the box. Then insert and glue the bottom 1/2" section of the 3" x 8-1/2" Basic Black piece to the top inside back of the pillow box. Allow time for the glue to dry with each of these steps.
10. Banner-cut the bottom end of the 1/2" x 3-1/2" strips.
11. Use the Take Your Pick Tool to poke a hole in the top front of the box. (I made my hole off to the side.) Poke a hole in the top end of each of the 1/2" x 3-1/2" banner strips.



12. Tie the ribbon around the box below the hole. Trim the ends.
13. Add the banners with a copper brad.



14. Sponge Soft Suede ink on the motorcycle print Classic Garage Designer Paper piece. Glue to the middle of the Basic Black.

15. Add small copper brads to the ends of the die-cut banner. Then attach to the box using Dimensionals.

Project Details:

- Basic Gray Cardstock
 - 4-1/4" x 8"
 - 1" x 5-1/2"
- Whisper White Cardstock
 - 2-3/4" x 4"
 - Two pieces that are 1" x 4"
 - Scrap for stamping & die cutting
- Basic Black Cardstock
 - Two pieces that are 2-7/8" x 4-1/8"
 - Two pieces that are 1-1/8" x 4-1/8"
- Silver Foil Paper
 - Scrap for die cutting gears

Instructions:

1. Score Basic Gray Cardstock on the 8" side at 1-1/4", 2-1/2", 5-1/2", and 6-3/4". Fold all score lines. The 1-1/4" and 6-3/4" ones will be mountain folds. The 2-1/2" and 5-1/2" ones will be valley folds.
2. Using the exhaust stamp image, stamp randomly on the two 1" x 4" Whisper White pieces for side panels. Stamp the bottom edge of the 2-3/4" x 4" Whisper White piece for center of card.



3. Adhere the stamped exhaust pieces of Whisper White panels onto the Basic Black 2-7/8" x 4" piece and the two 1-1/8" x 4-1/8" pieces. Then adhere them to the card base.
4. Stamp the car and the Happy Father's Day along with the "You're a Classic" onto scrap Whisper White Cardstock.
5. Using the Garage Gears Thinlits, cut out the car, the Happy Father's Day badge, and the gears (from the Silver Foil sheets) with your die cutting machine. Hand cut out the "You're a Classic" with your Paper Snips. Optional: flag both ends.
6. Build your bridge card by adhering Tear & Tape to both ends of the Basic Gray 1" x 5-1/2" piece and adhere one end to each outside panel making a "bridge" to connect the outside panels. (It will help to have one side open and one side folded down when connecting.)
7. Add the Happy Father's Day badge to the back inside panel and start building onto the bridge section around the greeting. Apply Snail Adhesive to only the back-left side of gears and adhere to the left side panel.
8. Add the car with Stampin' Dimensionals. Then layer the "You're a Classic" with Stampin' Dimensionals on the left side to finish your card.
9. This card will fit into a standard sized envelope from Stampin'Up! when folded flat on one side. (shown in photo below)
