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Spooky Sweet Sour Cream Container

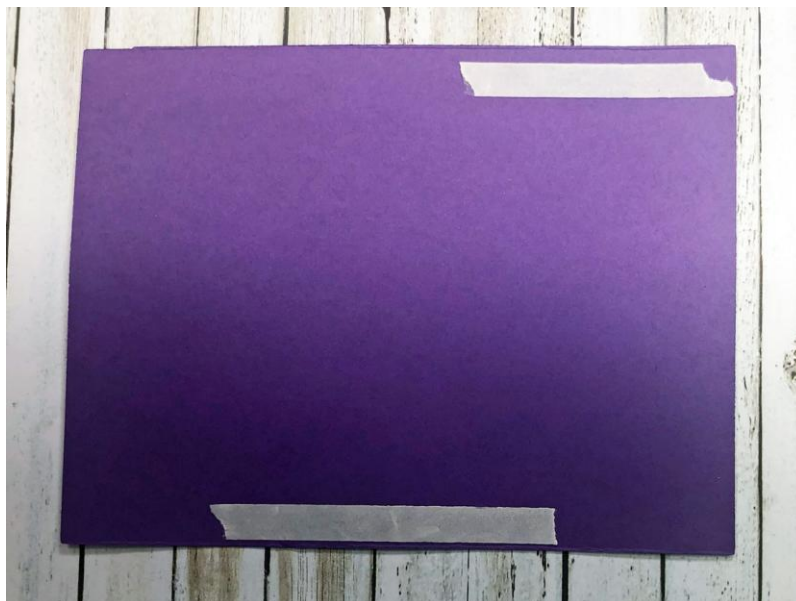
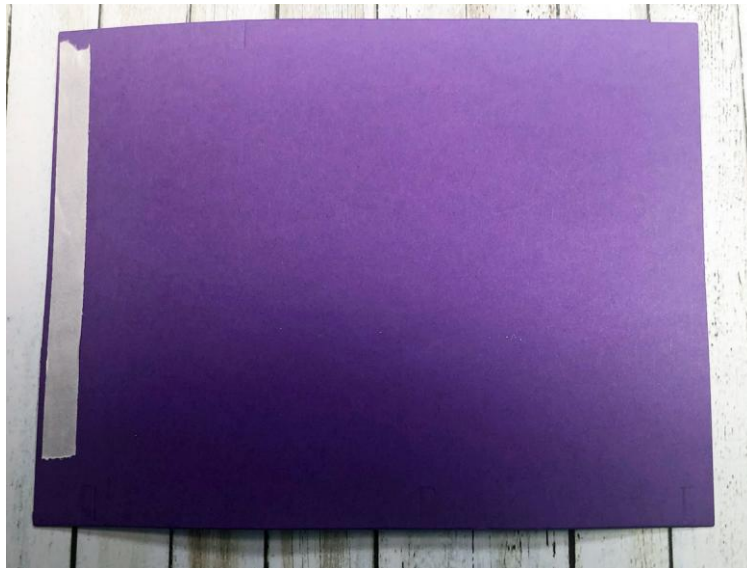

Project Details:

- Toil & Trouble Designer Series Paper
 - 6" x 6"
- Gorgeous Grape card stock
 - 3" x 3"
- Whisper White card stock
 - 2" x 2"
- Silver Glimmer Paper
 - 2" x 2"
- Black Foil Paper
 - 2" x 2"

Instructions:

- 1) Select the die cut from Petite Treat Framelits that creates a rectangle.
- 2) Use Big Shot to die cut rectangle from 6" x 6" piece of Toil & Trouble DSP.
- 3) Die cut two (2) scallops from Gorgeous Grape card stock.
- 4) Place Tear & Tape Adhesive on front and back side of rectangle.



- 5) Remove backing paper from tape and roll the length of the Toil & Trouble Designer Series paper into a tube. Gently place ends together and press careful not to flatten out the tube.

- 6) Remove the backing paper from the bottom of container. Press together to seal. Now is the time to add your favorite treats.
- 7) Remove the backing paper from the top and press in opposite direction so it makes the classic sour cream container.
- 8) Adhere Gorgeous Grape scallops on front and back of container using Fine-Tip Glue Pen.
- 9) Using Stamparatus, place Whisper White card stock on platform. Mask off all words except "no". Ink "no" using Memento Tuxedo Black ink and stamp on card stock.
- 10) Clean off stamp and mask off all words except "tricks". Ink "tricks" using Gorgeous Grape and stamp on card stock.
- 11) Repeat above steps with "just" using Memento Tuxedo Black ink and "treats" using Granny Apple Green ink.
- 12) Die cut the stamped sentiment on a diagonal using the smallest square from Stitched Shapes Framelits.
- 13) Die cut layering scallop square using Silver Glimmer Paper.
- 14) Die cut layering square using Black Foil Sheet.
- 15) Adhere all three (3) squares together using SNAIL Adhesive.
- 16) Create a "nest" of Silver Metallic Thread and adhere to back of Black Foil square.
- 17) Adhere stamped image to front of container using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 18) Use Paper-Piercing Tool to create a hole in one of the scallops.
- 19) Thread Spider Trinket using Silver Metallic Thread.
- 20) Thread through hole and knot in back so it dangles in front.

Belly Band Baker's Box

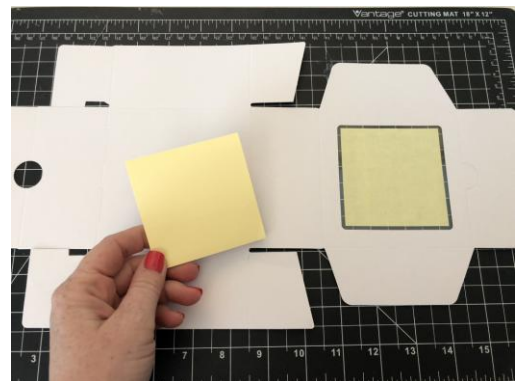
Project Details:

- Whisper White card stock
 - Cut leaf base & intricate leaf
- Smokey Slate card stock
 - 3 1/2" x 3/4"
- Crushed Curry card stock
 - 11" x 3/4"
- Country Lane Designer Series Paper
 - 12" x 2 1/2" (Blackberry Bliss print)
 - 12" x 2" (decorative piece)

Instructions:

- 1) Use a post it note and cover the window on the baker's box.
- 2) Prepare a Stampin' Spritzer, filled with 5-10 drops of crushed curry reinker and rubbing

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alcohol and spritz the box while it's laying flat. Allow to dry. Box will look wet and messy but will dry even and nice.

- 3) Layer the decorative 2" strip of designer paper on top of the 2 1/2" strip of designer paper.
- 4) To make the decorative strip of Crushed Curry card stock, cut with the edge lit piece in the framelits, make a mark with a pencil at the end of the edge lit and cut. Then move the edge lit down and cut again. Continue this until the entire 11" strip is cut. Layer this piece on top of the designer series paper pieces.
- 5) Wrap completed piece around the Baker's Cox. If it will not connect, use a piece of scrap paper to attach each end on the bottom of the bakers box.
- 6) Lastly cut out the intricate leaf and the border of the leaf from Whisper White card stock. Do not punch any of the pieces out of the intricate leaf. Add Tombow liquid glue to the back of the intricate leaf and carefully place it down on the large solid leaf. If pieces fall out put them back in their place after adhering the leaf.
- 7) Last, stamp the thankful sentiment on the Smoky Slate card stock. Cut one end at a fish tail and adhere to the box. Add the leaf piece to the box using Dimensionals.

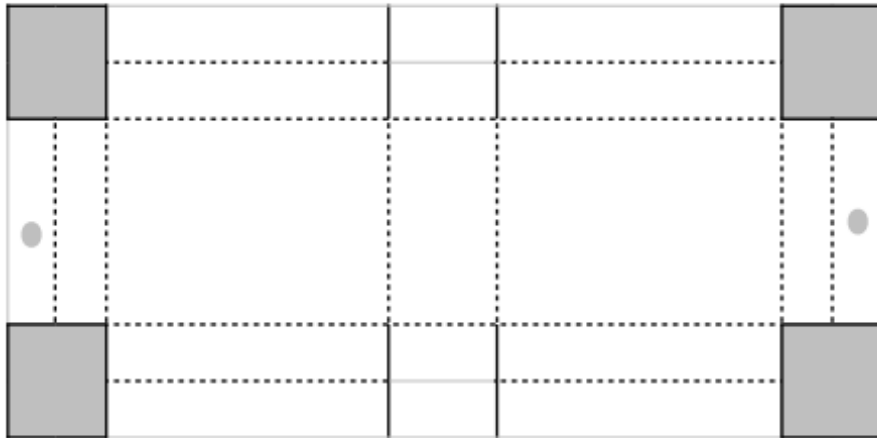
Project Details:

- Highland Heather
 - 8 x 4
 - 1-3/4 scallop circle
- Toil & Trouble Designer Series Paper
 - 1-3/4 x 2-1/2
- Black Foil
 - 1-7/8 circle
- Whisper White

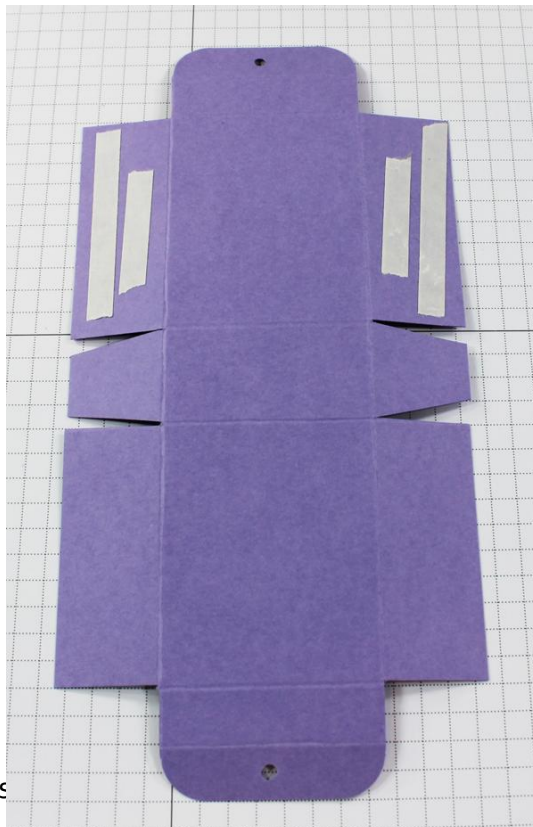
- 1-1/2 circle

Instructions:

- 1) Place the 8 x 4 piece of Highland Heather card stock on the Simply Scored Scoring Tool and score on the 4" side (portrait side) at 1" on both sides. Turn and score on the 8" side (landscape side) at 1/2", 1", 3-1/2, 4-1/2, 7, 7-1/2.



- 2) Fold on score lines and cut box according to the diagram below.



- 3) Round edges of the top of the box using the Detailed Trio Punch.
- 4) Cut two ribbon holes at the top using the 1/8" Circle Punch.
- 5) Add Glittered Organdy Ribbon. Tie a knot using the Black Bakers Twine, add Spider Trinket and then tie a bow with the twine.



- 6) Stamp "Trick or Treat" and ghost with Jet Black Memento Ink on Whisper White Card Stock. Cut out with the 1-1/2 Circle Punch. Use a Sponge Dauber with Highland Heather ink and sponge ink on it (rub most of the ink off on scrap paper before adding it to the ghost). Add Twinkle Adhesive Backed Sequins with the Paper Piercing Tool.
- 7) Add the image to a 1-3/4 Highland Heather scallop circle cut out with the Layering Circles Framelits Dies using a Stampin' Dimensional.
- 8) Add this layer to a 1-7/8 Black Foil circle using Mini Glue Dots and then add to box using Mini Glue Dots.

Pop Out Banner Card

Project Details:

- Lemon Lime Twist card stock
 - 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" scored at 4-1/4"
 - 1-1/2" x 5" strip
 - Oval: 1-3/4" x 2-3/4"
- Whisper White card stock
 - Four squares cut at 1-7/8" x 1-7/8"
 - Oval: 1-1/2" x 2-1/2"
- Basic Black card stock
 - 3-3/4" x 5"
 - 1" x 8-1/2" scored at 4-1/4"
 - Four squares cut at 2" x 2"
- Gorgeous Grape card stock
 - 1-1/4" x 4-3/4"

Instructions:

- 1) Fold Lemon Lime Twist card base and add the 3-3/4" x 5" Basic Black card stock.
- 2) Build the center strip... Wrap the Black Glittered ribbon around the 1-1/4" x 4-3/4" Gorgeous Grape and tie at the top. Pop the Grape piece up with Stampin' Dimensionals onto the Lemon Lime Twist 1-1/2" x 5" strip.
- 3) Before adhering this piece to the front of the Basic Black, cut out two spider webs with the Silver Foil sheets using the Cauldron Framelits. Add them both behind the Lemon Lime Twist strip & adhered the whole piece down with Snail adhesive to the Basic Black card stock.
- 4) Stamp both the ghost/bird and greeting in Memento black ink, then cut out with the Layering Oval Framelits. Color the bird with Mango Melody Stampin' Blends. Color the outline of the sheet covering bird with Smoky Slate Stampin' Blends. Then color the bird's beak and feet with Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blends. Die-cut the Lemon Lime Twist scrap with coordinating scallop oval. Adhere the Whisper White oval to the Lemon Lime Twist scallop oval, and attach this with Stampin' Dimensionals towards the right side of glitter ribbon strip.

- 5) Inside of card...Fold the 1"x 8-1/2" strip fold in half and then fold the ends back to center to form a "W" (should be equal parts). The outside edges of your "W" will be adhered down to the inside of your card. The center part of the W should pop up (shown in photo).
- 6) Adhere one side of "W" at a time. Adhere 1st side near inside right edge of base of card. Then add Snail to the other side of "W" and close base of card. The pop up piece will then be perfectly aligned.
- 7) Stamp all four squares with the Halloween images from Trick or Tweet stamp set with Memento black ink. Color in images using the Stampin' Blends. (Colors used are shown in the photo below.)



- 8) Adhere your finished stamped/colored images to the Basic Black squares.
- 9) Add Wink of Stella to certain parts of each image: elephant - bat wings and mask, dog - hat rim and cape, cat - bandages, and the whole piece with greeting.
- 10) Adhere each layered square in between the fold lines on the "W" pop up strip.

Sweet Treats Spider Box

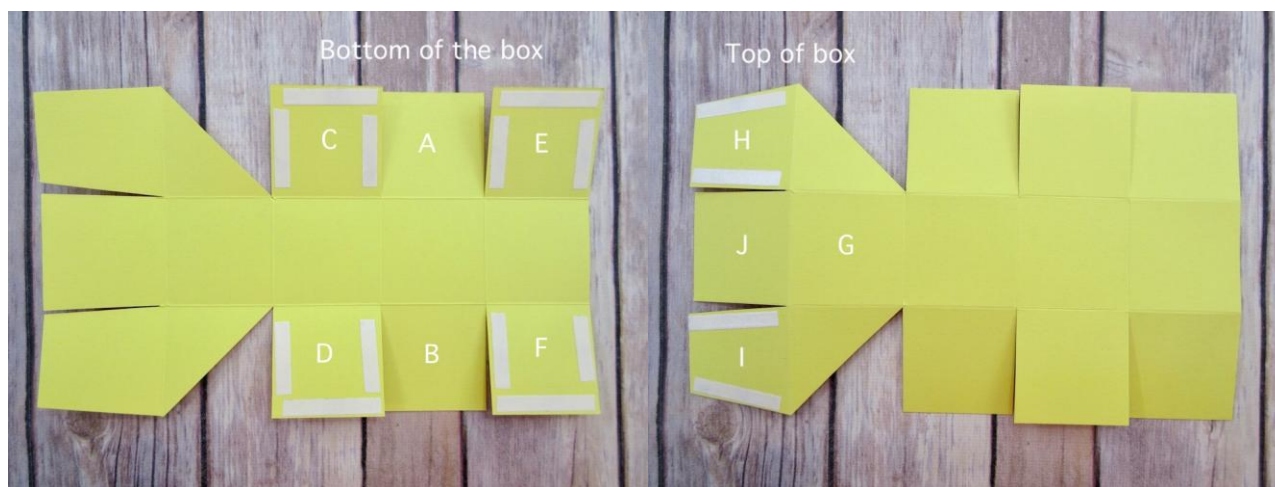

Project Details:

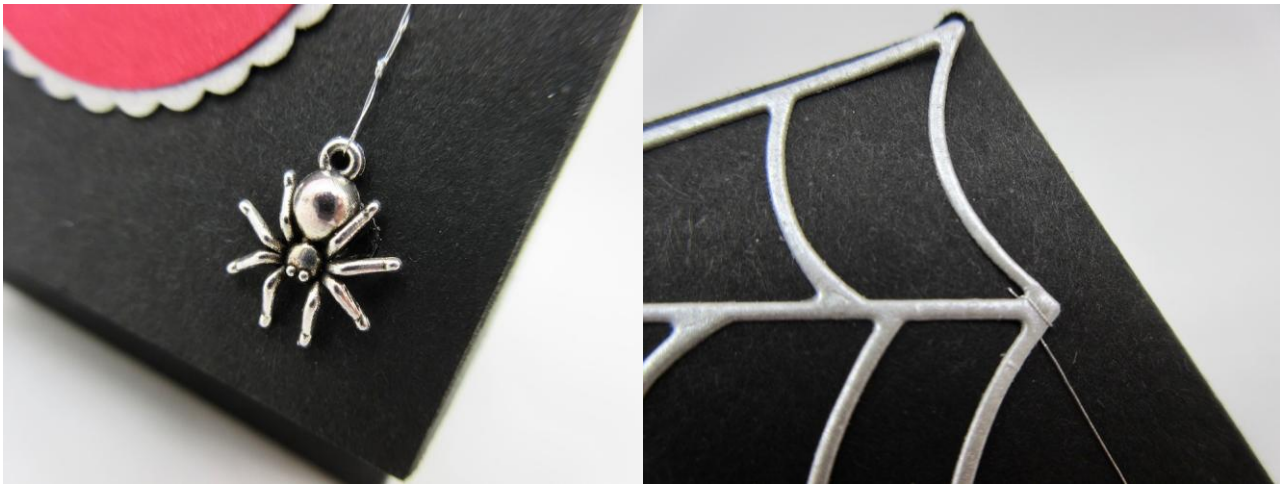
- Basic Black card stock
 - 6" x 10" scored at 2" and 4" parallel to the long edge & at 2", 4", 6" and 8" parallel to the short edge
- Real Red card stock
 - 1-1/2" x 3" scrap for stamping & punching out two 1-1/4" circles
- Galvanized Metallic paper
 - 1-1/2" x 3" scrap for punching out two 1-3/8" scallop circles
 - 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" scrap for die-cutting spider web
- Silver Metallic thread
 - About 6"

Instructions:

- 1) After scoring Basic Black cardstock, add cuts and Tear & Tape adhesive as shown below. (Use a pencil and straight-edge to draw the diagonal lines before cutting.) The first photo shows the inside of the box, the second shows the outside.



- 2) Fold the middle un-taped flaps (A and B) of the bottom of the box inward first. Then pull the other sections up and together into a cube. Attach panels C and D first to A and B. Then attach panels E and F to secure the bottom of the box together.
- 3) Then fold panel G over the top and bring together the panels of this lid by securing H to I (making sure they are not tilted). Finally bring down and attach J over where H and I are connected.
- 4) Put Adhesive sheets on the back of the 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" scrap of Galvanized Metallic paper. Then die-cut with the web framelit from the Cauldron Framelits dies.
- 5) Remove the metal jump ring from a Spider Trinket using a pliers. Tie one end of silver thread to the spider. Stick spider on the front of the box with a Glue Dot.
- 6) As you secure spider web to the top of the box, pull the remainder of the Silver Thread up and around the corner of the web. (No need to tie in a knot if the thread is wrapped a few times and the adhesive is stick under that section of the web.)



- 7) Stamp sentiments onto Real Red cardstock. Punch with 1-1/4" Circle punch. Layer these using SNAIL adhesive each onto two pieces of 1-3/8" Scallop Circles punched from the Galvanized Metallic paper scrap. Then attach to the outside and inside of the box lid.
- 8) Fill with shredie and a treat/gift and hand out on Halloween.



Scare Up A Little Fun Treat Box

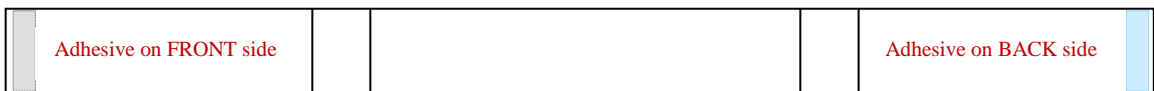

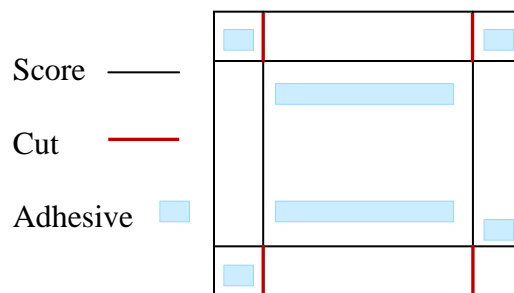

Project Details:

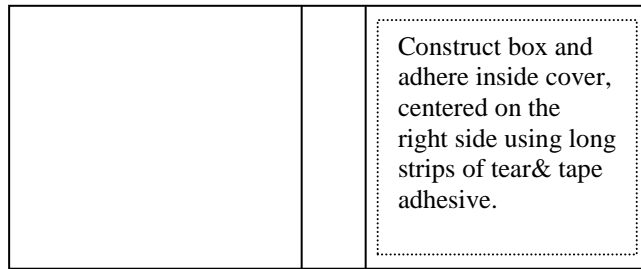
- Basic Black Cardstock
 - Belly band: 8 1/2 x 1", scored landscape at 2, 2 1/2, 5 3/4, and 6 1/4"



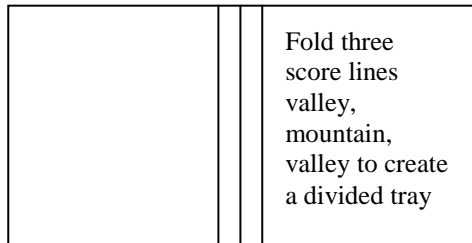
- Box: 4 x 4", scored at 1/2" all around, cut according to the diagram:



- Cover: $3\frac{1}{4} \times 7''$, scored landscape at $3\frac{1}{4}$ and $3\frac{3}{4}$



- Insert: $3\frac{3}{4} \times 2\frac{3}{4}$, scored landscape at $1\frac{1}{2}$, $1\frac{7}{8}$, and $2\frac{1}{4}$



- Toil & Trouble Designer Series Paper – Your choice of two patterns
 - Frog Pattern: $3 \times 3''$
 - Grape and Heather Stripe Pattern: $\frac{3}{4} \times 3''$

Instructions:

- 1) Cut and score your Basic Black cardstock pieces as shown above.
- 2) Add Tear & Tape Adhesive as illustrated above.
- 3) To construct your treat box, build the $4 \times 4''$ piece into the box base, then adhere centered on the right side of the cover. Fold the tray piece and drop into the box base if you are filling with small treats like the erasers I used. You can skip the divided tray if you are going to fill the box with fun size treats like M&M's.
- 4) Close up the cover of your box and decorate with $3 \times 3''$ piece of Toil & Trouble Designer Series Paper.
- 5) Wrap the scored belly band around the front of the box and secure with Tear & Tape Adhesive strips. **Please note that the adhesive is on the front side on one end and on the back side on the other end of the belly band.**
- 6) Cover the seam of the belly band with the $\frac{3}{4} \times 3''$ strip of Toil & Trouble Designer Series Paper.
- 7) Punch a Basic Black Starburst from a scrap of cardstock. Die cut a Granny Apple Green Stitched Labels circle. Punch a scrap of Gold Foil with the $1\frac{3}{8}''$ Scallop Circle Punch and adhere the three pieces as shown using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

- 8) Line 2 or 3 Stampin' Dimensionals up on the belly band and expose the adhesive. Adhere the layered starburst to the belly band centered left to right.
- 9) Stamp "scare up some fun!" on Whisper White cardstock scrap and punch out with 1 ½" Circle Punch. Adhere to center of the layered starburst.
- 10) Punch a smallest bat from Basic Black cardstock scrap using the Spooky Bat Punch. Fold up the wings and adhere to the layered starburst to embellish.
