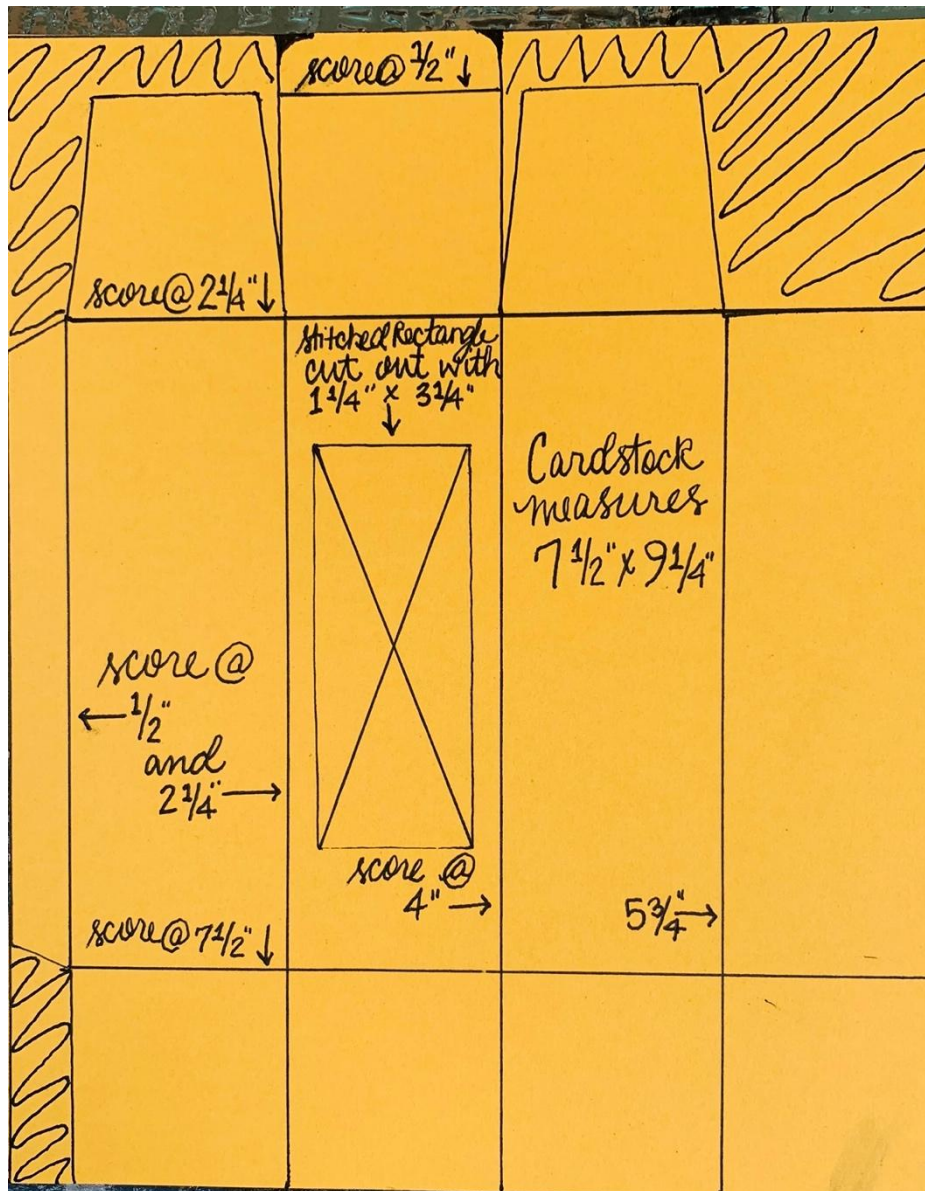

Project Details:

- Real Red Cardstock
 - 7-1/2" x 9-1/4"
 - Score with the 7-1/2" edge across the top at 1/2", 2-1/4", 4" and 5-3/4"
 - Score with the 9-1/4" edge across the top at 1/2", 2-1/4 and 7-1/2"
- Basic White Cardstock
 - 2" x 2-1/2" scrap for sentiment-cut out with the smallest, wide stitched rectangle
- Party Pattern Designer Series Paper-Buffalo Check Pattern
 - 2 ea. 3/4" x 9"
 - 1 ea. 1/2" x 12"
- Window Sheet
 - 1-5/8" 3-3/4"
- Baker's Twine
 - 36"

- Non-Stampin' Up!
 - 3 golf balls and 6 golf tees

Instructions:



1. Score cardstock and cut using measurements above and the photo as a guide. Round the corners of the $\frac{1}{2}$ " tab at the top of the second panel.
2. Using the $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Stitched Rectangle Die, cut out window using the photo for placement.

3. Adhere the Window Sheet to the inside of the opening for the stitched window using Tear & Tape.
4. Assemble the box using Tear & Tape.
5. Starting at the back of the box, adhere the designer paper around the top and bottom edges of the box.
6. Add three golf balls inside the box. This will give more stability when adding the golf tees.



7. Add a piece of Tear & Tape to one end of the ½” strip of designer paper. Adhere it to the right side, front corner of box as shown. Place a tee under the paper and wrap it over the tee. Adhere the designer paper to the box with glue between the tees. Use your Take Your Pick Tool to hold the designer paper in place until it adheres. Repeat with the other two tees. Wrap the designer paper around the back of the box adhering as you go. To finish, repeat the process to adhere three tees on the other side of the box ending with a bit of Tear & Tape Adhesive at the left front corner.
8. Open the lid of box and, using your Take Your Pick Tool, make two small holes side by side in the center of lid about ¼” apart.
9. Make a tassel with white Baker’s Twine by wrapping a piece around your first three fingers six times and trim off. Next, take the bundle and wrap a

length of twine around it about ½” from the top loops three times and tie in a knot to secure. Trim the bottom of the loops across to finish off.

10. Feed a 10” piece of twine through the top loops and feed one end through each of the holes in the lid so that both ends are now on the inside of the lid. Pull tight and tie in a small bow. Trim ends and close the box.
11. Stamp sentiment on a scrap of Basic White once in black and once in red.
12. Trim out just the word “Dad” from the red one and die cut the black one using the widest, small stitched rectangle.
13. Adhere the red “Dad” banner over the black using dimensionals and then add completed piece to the window of the box using dimensionals.

- Basic White Cardstock
 - Stitched Rectangle
- Evening Evergreen Cardstock
 - Largest Hippo Die
- Pansy Petals Designer Series Paper
 - 2" x 5-3/4"

Instructions:

1. Start by trimming a fish tail on one end of the designer series paper.
2. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to attach the Evening Evergreen die cut to the designer series paper piece.
3. Stamp image and use Stampin' Blends to color. Stamp the sentiment in the upper right corner of the Stitched Rectangle using Evening Evergreen ink.
4. Add the Stitched Rectangle to the top of the Evening Evergreen die cut with Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Use the Clever Clips to add tag to the front of the bag.

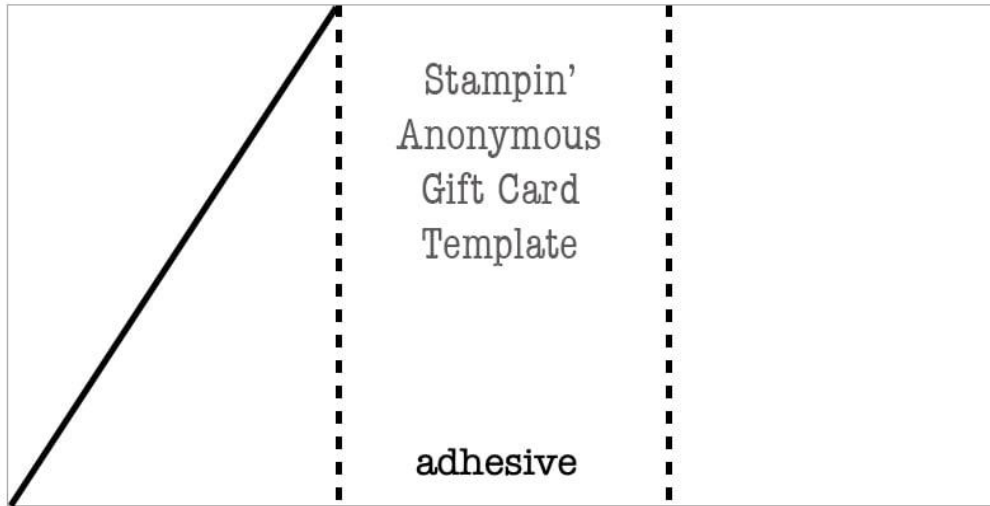

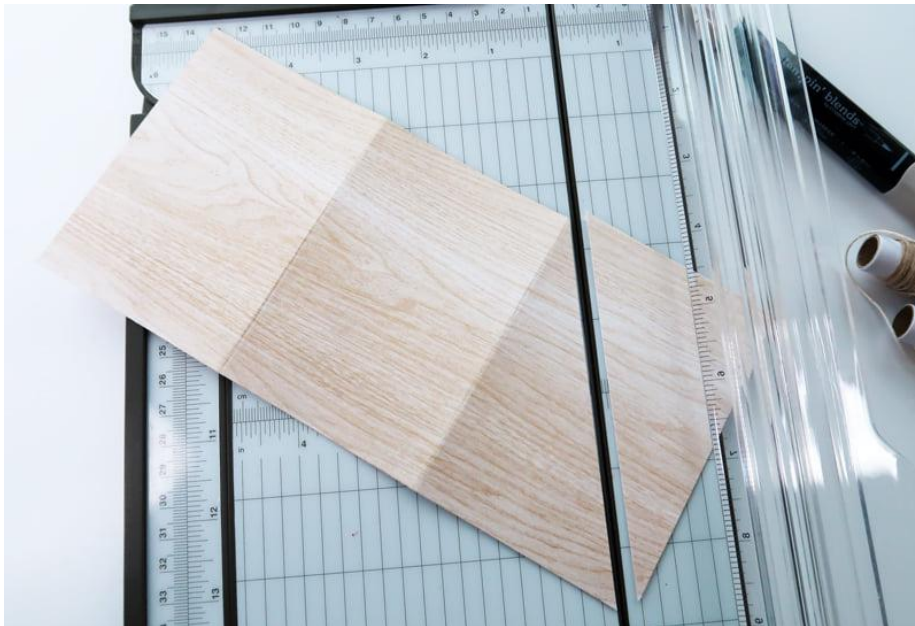
- In Good Taste Designer Series Paper
 - 9" x 4-1/4"
- Beauty of the Earth Designer Series Paper
 - 3-1/4" x 1-7/8"
- Basic White:
 - 2-3/4" x 4"
 - 2-3/4" x 1/2"
 - Scraps

Instructions:

1. Score the 9" x 4-1/4" piece of In Good Taste Designer Series Paper at 3" & 6".



2. Fold on score lines and then place on trimmer and cut the first section at an angle. Place the edges on the track of the trimmer and cut. See picture.



3. Use a small line of Liquid Glue to make the gift card holder.
4. Add the Beauty of the Earth Designer Series Paper to the front.

5. Stamp deer image with Memento Ink on Basic White Cardstock color with the Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends Marker. Fussy cut it out with Paper Snips Scissors. Add to front of gift card holder with liquid glue.
6. Stamp greeting with Memento Ink on Basic White Cardstock and cut out with Tasteful Labels Dies. Add to front of gift card holder with liquid glue.
7. Tie a bow using two strands of the bakers twine (one vanilla and one crumb cake) and add with a Mini Glue Dot.
8. For the inside Stamp "Happy Father's Day" with Memento Ink on the 1/2" x 2-3/4" piece Basic White Cardstock and attach to the larger 2-3/4" x 4" piece of Basic White Cardstock. Adhere to the inside of the gift card holder.

Project Details:

- Cajun Craze Cardstock
 - 10-1/2" x 6" for box
 - 1/2" x 3-1/2" for front of shirt
 - Scrap for pocket
- Well Suited Designer Series Paper
 - 3-7/8" x 3-7/8" – 2 pieces for front and back of box
 - 3-7/8" x 7/8" – 4 pieces for sides and top of box
 - Scrap for shirt collar and pocket
- Basic White Cardstock
 - Scrap for Buttons

Instructions:

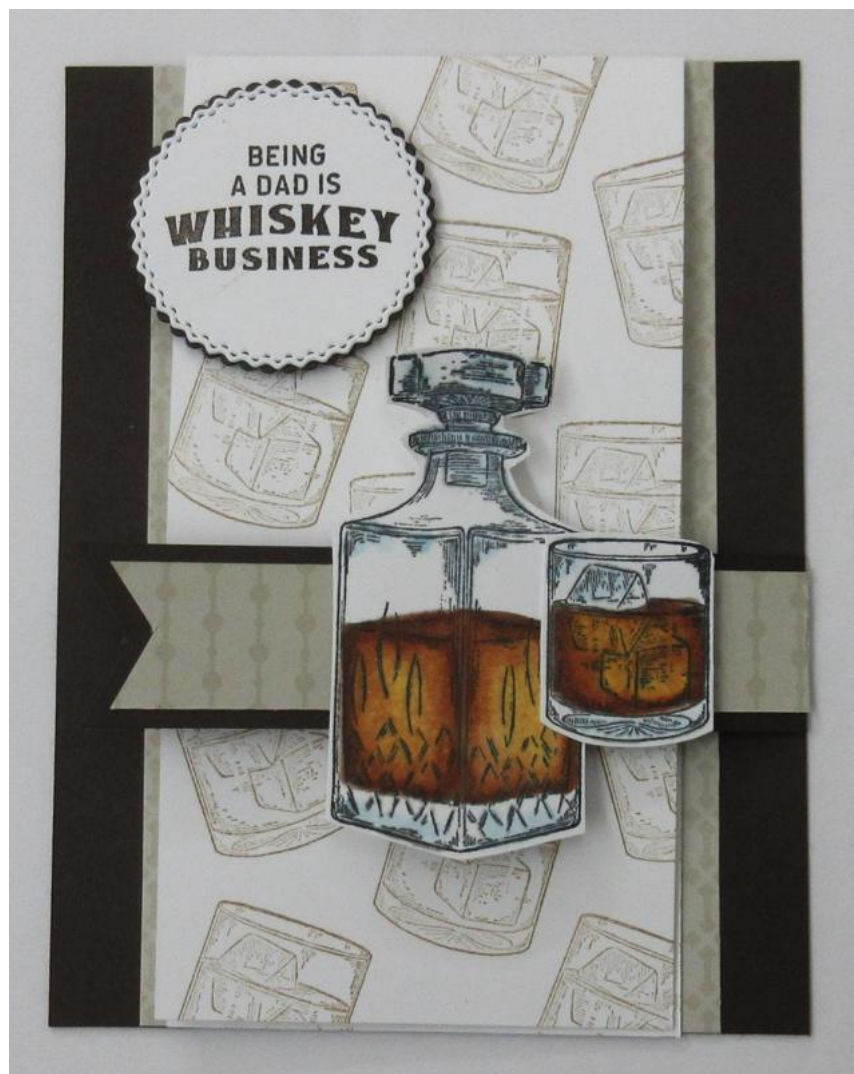
1. Score the 10-1/2" x 6" piece on the 10-1/2" side at 1/2", 1-1/2", 5-1/2", 6-1/2". Score on the 6" side at 1" and 5". Burnish and trim as shown in diagram below.



2. Add adhesive as shown in diagram above and assemble the box.
3. Mat front and back using the 3-7/8" x 3-7/8" Well Suited Designer Series Paper.
4. Using the 1/2" x 3-1/2" piece of Cajun Craze Cardstock add to front center of box. This is the piece under buttons.
5. Cut two shirt collars using Well Suited Designer Series Paper and the Suit & Tie Dies. Glue one piece down flat and add the second collar using Stampin' Dimensionals to give the collar dimension.
6. Cut out the buttons using the Suit & Tie Dies and Basic White Cardstock. Add the buttons to the front as shown using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
7. Stamp the "World's Greatest Dads" sentiment with Versamark Ink onto a piece of Cajun Craze Cardstock scrap. Cover sentiment using the white emboss powder from the Stampin' Emboss Powders Basics and heat emboss with the Heat Tool. Cut out the sentiment using the pocket die from the Suit & Ties Dies.
8. Cut the pocket trim and the handkerchief using the Well Suited Designer Series Paper. Add the trim and handkerchief to the pocket, then adhere pocket to the front of shirt using Multipurpose Glue.

Project Details:

- Early Espresso Cardstock
 - 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"
 - 1" x 5-1/2" scored at 4-1/4"
 - Scrap for die-cutting scallop circle.
- Neutrals 6" x 6" Designer Paper
 - 3-1/4" x 5-1/2"
 - 3/4" x 4-1/4"
- Basic White Cardstock
 - 2 -7/8" x 11" scored at 5-1/2"
 - Scrap for stamping and cutting circle.

Instructions:

1. Score the 1" x 5-1/2" strip of Early Espresso Cardstock at 4-1/4", fold score line and add Stampin' Seal Adhesive to the back of the flap and adhere to front of card base on the right-hand side edge. Using the Paper Snips flag the opposite end of this strip.
2. Layer the 3-1/4" x 5-1/2" Crumb Cake Designer Paper. From the Neutrals collection, in the center of the 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" piece of Early Espresso Cardstock. Your designer paper will cover the end of the strip from step 1, see the photo below:



3. Flag the end of the Crumb Cake Designer Paper 3/4" x 4-1/4" strip with Paper Snips and adhere to the Early Espresso Cardstock flap, trim the end to fit.
4. Score the Basic White Cardstock at 5-1/2" and stamp the whiskey glass randomly all over the front with Crumb Cake Classic Ink. Stamp inside of card with greeting with Memento Black Ink and adhere over the 3-1/4" x 5-1/2" Crumb Cake Designer Paper.
5. Stamp "Whiskey Business" greeting onto Basic White Scrap with Early Espresso Classic Ink. Die cut with the largest circle from the Tasteful Labels Dies. Cut a 1-3/4" scallop circle from Early Espresso Cardstock using Layering Circles Dies. Layer together with Stampin' Seal, pop up in top left corner with Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Stamp the whiskey decanter and glass with Memento Ink and color with Stampin' Blends Markers.

7. Outline the whiskey line with Stampin' Blends Cinnamon Cider Dark and color inside with Stampin' Blends Cinnamon Cider Light, add Stampin' Blends Daffodil Delight Light on top to lighten the whiskey to give the golden-brown caramel color. Color glass areas and ice cube with Stampin' Blends Balmy Blue Light, use the Color Lifter to blend Balmy Blue, see the photo below.



8. Using the Paper Snips hand cut out decanter and glass, pop up on strip with Stampin' Dimensionals.

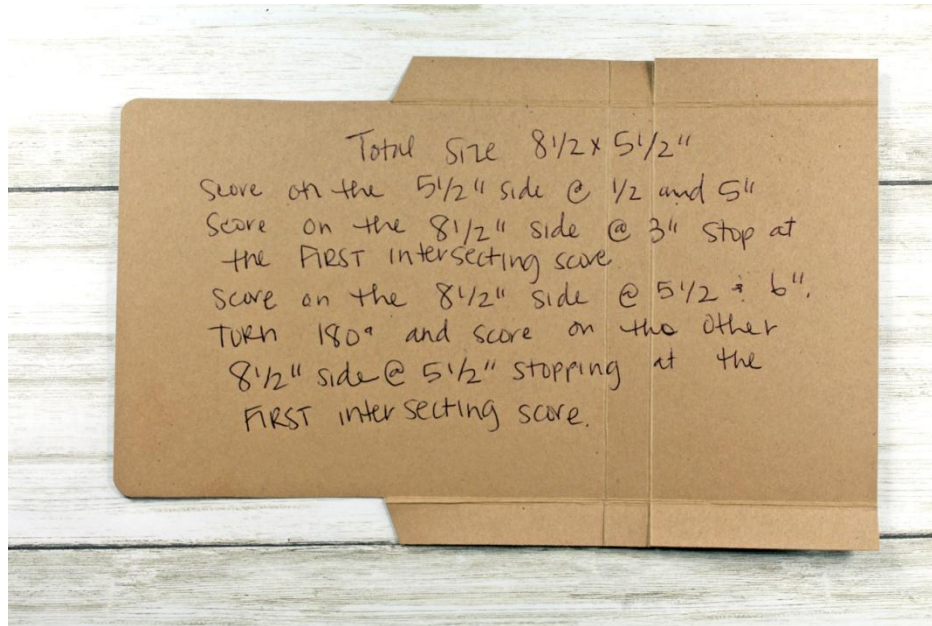

Project Details:

- Pool Party Subtle Designer Series Paper
 - 4-1/2 x 4", scored on the 4-1/2" side at 3/4"
- In Good Taste Designer Series Paper
 - 2-1/4 x 4-1/4"
- Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper
 - Scrap for die-cutting the hill
- Early Espresso Cardstock
 - 5-1/2" x 8-1/2"
 - 5-1/2" side: score at 1/2 and 5"
 - 8-1/2" side: score at 3" stop at the intersecting scored line, score all the way at 5-1/2" and 6", then turn cardstock 180 degrees and score at the 5-1/2" stopping at the intersecting scored line.
 - Scrap for die-cutting the fence
- Cinnamon Cider Cardstock
 - Scrap for die-cutting the windmill
- Pool Party Cardstock
 - Scrap for die-cutting the windmill
- Basic White Cardstock
 - Scrap for die-cutting the clouds
 - Scrap for stamping and die-cutting the cowboy
- Crumb Cake Cardstock
 - Scrap for die-cutting the Tailor Made Tag

Instructions:

1. Prepare treat box base by scoring, folding and cutting as shown in the template photo below. Using Tear & Tape Adhesive on the long tabs and tiny tabs, secure the box.
2. Use the Detailed Trio Punch to round the corners at the top of the box.



3. Adhere the In Good Taste Designer Series Paper to the front of the box using liquid glue. Fold and adhere the Pool Party Designer Series Paper to the inside of the box. Use the same adhesive on the Pool Party paper, adhere the 3/4" segment to the inside of the box. This will create a fold over flap to tuck your treat behind. See the photo below.



- Stamp the cowboy in Memento Ink, color with Stampin' Blends and add dimensionals to the back, Set aside.
- Die cut your pieces from the scraps, glue with liquid glue making a scene on the Pool Party cardstock dome. Adhere to the treat box using the same glue. Pop your cowboy on the front.
- Stamp the greeting on the Crumb Cake tag using Memento Tuxedo Black ink.
- Wrap the box with Mossy Meadow Braided Linen Trim, thread the tag on the ribbon and tie a bow. Secure the tag to the box using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Tuck the treat into the box, folding the Pool Party designer series paper over the cake to finish.
