Measurements:

Basic Black: 6-3/4 x 9-3/4", scored at: **6-3/4" side** - 1 & 5-3/4", **9-3/4" side** - 2-3/4, 5-1/4, 6-1/4, 7-1/4, 8-1/4 & 9-1/4"

- 3/4 x 4-5/8" to secure Hershey's Kisses

Whisper White: 2 x 4-3/4" for stamping and punching out with the Tailored Tag Punch

Silver Foil: 1-1/2 x 1-1/2"

Classic Garage Designer Series Paper:

- Crushed Curry Electric Pattern: 2-1/2 x 4-1/2"

- Basic Black Modeled: 3/4 x 3"

Window Sheet: 3/4 x 4-1/2"

Black/Silver 1/4" Striped Metallic Ribbon: 2-3/4"

Instructions:

1. Prepare box according to the scoring and cutting directions above. Burnish the score lines with a bone folder, cut away the excess panels, and liberate the box end tabs. Add Tear & Tape adhesive to the long edge of the first largest panel. Also add Tear & Tape across the second long panel to keep the gift card from getting pushed in too far. Fold the first panel over the and secure to the second panel.
 2. Using SNAIL Adhesive, adhere the Basic Black designer series paper to the Crushed Curry designer series paper. Using just a dab of Multipurpose Liquid glue, adhere the Black/Silver 1/4" Striped Metallic Ribbon to the designer series paper as shown. Staple the paper and ribbon as shown. Adhere the Crushed Curry DSP to the box using SNAIL Adhesive. Cut a "thumb - notch" for the gift card using a 1-1/4" circle punch.
 3. Add Tear & Tape along the narrow glue tab, it's the most narrow panel at the other side of the box and fold back the tab to keep it out of the way. Now you will use your Classic Label Punch to punch a window in the second panel from the glue tab. You can line the right edge of the label punch up with the 1" right side score line, punch, slide the punch to line up with the 1" left score line and punch again. Using this technique will give you a window that is centered in the panel.
 4. Add the small strip of window sheet to the inside of the box using a bit of Snail Adhesive.
 5. Remove the liner from the Tear & Tape on the glue tab and fold up your box. You can use your Bone Folder to burnish the inside of the box adhering the box together. Close up one end of the box with Tear & Tape, be sure that the front tab is the last one down for a finished look from the front of the box. On the extra strip of Basic Black Cardstock, adhere the 5 Hershey Kisses using a bit of Snail or Fast Fuse Adhesive and slide inside box. Close the other side of the box with Tear & Tape also making sure the front fold goes down last.
 6. On the Whisper White Cardstock, stamp the sentiment using Tuxedo Black Memento Pad. Punch out using the Tailored Tag Punch.
 7. Die cut the small gear using a Silver Foil Sheet. Adhere to the stamped tailored tag using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the tag to the box with Stampin' Dimensionals as shown.
