



## CLUE #1 – GATHER YOUR SUPPLIES

Layer, collage, & art! Think about building stamps and ink with die cuts and embellishments! It's going to be a little different experience on Coffee and a Mystery tomorrow!

- Solid color cardstock, 8-1/2 x 5-1/2" scored at 4-1/4"
- Basic Black cardstock, 4 x 5-1/4"
- Solid color cardstock, 3-7/8 x 5-1/8"
- Two or three different designer series paper and/or specialty papers
- Dies to cut some shape elements from the designer and specialty paper
- Basic Black + one solid color cardstock scraps for punch or die cut elements
- More dies to cut the cardstock elements
- Solid color cardstock, NOT white or vanilla, for stamping a focal image
- Focal image, small images, background texture images and sentiment stamps
- Ink pads
- BLING!



## **CLUE #2 – Collage Stamping**

- Stamp some images on the 3-7/8 x 5-1/8" solid color cardstock using ink of your choice, full strength.
- Stamp some background, supporting and sentiment images on the 3-7/8 x 5-1/8" solid color cardstock using ink of your choice, second generation.



## **CLUE #3 – STAMP on a COLOR**

- Stamp the focal image of your choice on the NOT white or vanilla cardstock.
- Die cut, punch or fussy cut.



## **CLUE #4 – Get PUNCHy Or DIE CUT**

- Punch or die cut your designer series paper, specialty paper, black and color cardstock bits.
- Glue the die cuts to the stamped collage background.



## **CLUE #5 – Stack ‘EM Up**

- Glue the collage cardstock piece to the 4 x 5-1/4" Basic Black cardstock.
- Adhere the layers of cardstock to the card.
- Pop the focal image on the front with dimensional adhesive.



## **CLUE #6 – Embellish**

- Embellish with **BLING** of your choice.



## **CLUE #7 – Stamp the INSIDE**

- Stamp the inside with some of the images from the outside collage. Use your choice of ink color.
- Stamp the inside greeting with black, brown or navy.



# CLUE #8 – MYSTERY SOLVED
