STAMP A STACK TIP: If you are making the Taco Fiesta Stamp a Stack you will cut THREE papers of your choice according to Wonder Recipe #4. The kit makes THREE of this design.

Measurements

- **Garden Green Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the hat and llama
 - scrap for die cutting the 1-11/16 x 3-11/16" tag using the Stitched Rectangle Dies
- **Basic Black Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the pinking strip using the Basic Borders Dies
- **Enjoy the Journey Designer Series Paper**
 - THREE 1-3/8 x 3-1/4" patterns of your choice - cut using Wonder Recipe #4
- **Black and White 1/4" Gingham Ribbon**
 - about 10"
- **Black and White or Basic Black Baker's Twine**
 - about 2-1/2"

Instructions

1. Prepare the card base by scoring and burnishing using a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the crisscross pattern from the Basic 3D Embossing Folder set.
2. Adhere the designer series paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the llama piñata and hat on a scrap of Basic White Cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento Ink. Color the images using the Stampin' Blends listed. Fussy cut the llama and hat.
4. Stamp the sentiment on the white stitched rectangle using Garden Green ink. Then stamp the candy images on the rectangle using Tuxedo Black Memento Ink. Color the images using the Stampin' Blends listed.
5. Adhere the Basic Black pinking strip to the back of the stitched rectangle then adhere it to the card using liquid glue.
6. Adhere one end of the baker's twine to the back of the llama using a dimensional. Adhere the llama to the card.
7. Tie a gingham ribbon bow and adhere it to the top of the rectangle with a Mini Glue Dot being sure to secure the other end of the baker's twine under the ribbon.
8. Embellish using the Flat Adhesive Backed Pearls.
