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Measurements

- **Fresh Freesia Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - 5-1/4 x 4", scored at 3-1/4" on the 5-1/4" side
 - 2-3/8" circle
- **Masterfully Made Designer Series Paper**
 - 5-1/4 x 4" ◦ 3 x 3-3/4"
 - 1-3/4 x 3-3/4" ◦ 2-1/2 x 4", cut with a notch using the 2" Circle Punch
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scraps for stamping and die cutting the flowers using the Timeless Charm Bundle
 - second largest deckled rectangle cut using the Deckled Rectangles Dies
- **Pretty Peacock Cardstock**
 - scraps for die cutting the stems and sprig using the Timeless Charm Dies
- **Lost Lagoon Cardstock**
 - 1/2 x 3"

Instructions

1. Burnish the folds on the card bases. Adhere the designer series paper and then glue the small card on the front of the large card, centered.
2. Stamp the sentiment, using Berry Burst ink, and the sprig using Pretty Peacock ink, on the deckled rectangle. Glue the deckled rectangle on the inside right of the the card. Glue the designer series paper that is cut with the notch on the inside left of the card to make a pocket. See the photo for referance.
3. Stamp the 2-3/8" circle with the background image using Fresh Freesia ink and adhere it to the card with Stampin' Dimensionals. Be careful of placement, don't glue your card closed.
4. Stamp the leafy sprig in Berry Burst ink and die cut. Die cut the flowery sprig and flowers. Assemble the flowers using liquid glue. Glue the flowers and sprigs to the circle.
5. Unravel the jute trim and tie two of the strands in a bow. Attach the bow next to the circle using a glue dot.
6. Stamp the greeting on the banner using Pretty Peacock ink. Trim the ends and adhere to the card.
7. Embellish with Adhesive-Backed Sequins.
