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Sweet Citrus Split Front Card



Measurements

- **Daffodil Delight Cardstock**
 - 4-1/4 x 11", scored at 5-1/2"
 - scrap for die cutting TWO of the largest hexagon using the Stylish Shapes Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 4 x 5-1/4"
 - scrap for die cutting the second largest hexagon and smallest fishtail banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the citrus and leaves using the Sweet Citrus Stamp Set and Hybrid Embossing Folder
- **Lemon Lolly Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the flowers using the Sweet Citrus Stamp Set and Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the smallest fishtail banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
- **Delightfully Eclectic Designer Series Paper**
 - TWO 1-3/4 x 4" pieces

Instructions



1. Burnish the score line on your card base then put the card in your paper trimmer on the 11" side. Cut off 2", reserve this piece. Flip the card over to the other 11" side and line the fold up on the 2" mark then cut. The piece you just removed is a scrap.
2. Glue the designer paper pieces to the card base and to the 2 x 4-1/4" piece of Crushed Curry.
3. Stamp the greeting on the liner between the flap and the 2 x 4-1/4" piece. Once it is stamped successfully glue the liner into the card. See the photo below for reference.
4. Glue the white hexagon to one of the larger Crushed Curry hexagons then wrap with Linen Thread and tie a bow. Slide the ribbon under the thread and tie a bow.
5. Stamp "hi" on the white fishtail banner using Garden Green ink. Glue the white to the Old Olive fishtail banner. Punch a hole in the banners, thread with Linen Thread, then slide under the the bow and tie another bow.
6. Line up the 2 x 4-1/4" piece at the bottom of the card. Put glue on the top and bottom, back side, of the ribbon wrapped hexagon. Use the hexagon to glue the card front back together.
7. Glue the second hexagon inside the card to finish the back further securing the card front. See the photo below.
8. Stamp the citrus using Daffodil Delight for the peels and Lemon Lolly for the flesh, cut using the hybrid embossing folder. Stamp the leaves with Garden Green ink and die cut. Stamp the flowers on Lemon Lolly using Daffodil Delight ink and die cut.
9. Adhere the citrus, leaves and flowers using a combination of liquid glue and dimensionals.
10. Embellish with Pastel Adhesive-Backed Sequins.



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
