Measurements

- **Night of Navy Cardstock**
 - 4-1/4 x 11", scored at 2-3/8 & 7-7/8"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the fruit and leaves using the Sweet Citrus Stamp Set and Sweet Citrus Hybrid Embossing Folder & Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the 3-1/2 x 4-7/16" stitched and scalloped rectangle using the Scalloped Contours Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the largest banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
- **Bubble Bath Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the flowers using the Sweet Citrus Stamp Set and the Sweet Citrus Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - 4-1/4 x 4-1/2"
- **Lemon Lime Twist Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the smallest banner using the Nested Essentials Dies
- **Glorious Gingham Designer Series Paper**
 - 2-1/8 x 4" - Blueberry Bushel
 - 4 x 5-1/4" - Pecan Pie
- **Starry Sky 1/8" Metallic Woven Ribbon**
 - about 18"

Instructions

1. Prepare the card base by scoring and burnishing using a Bone Folder. Emboss the fruit image on the front of the 3-1/8" section of the card base using the Sweet Citrus Hybrid Embossing Folder.
2. Emboss the Pecan Pie cardstock using the Timber 3D Embossing Folder. Cut the "wood" pieces into FIVE 1/2 x 4-1/4" strips and FOUR 1/2 x 3-1/2" strips.
3. Adhere the outside vertical "wood" pieces to the top flap of the card on the outside. Be sure that the pieces are about the same distance from the left and right edge and that the bottom edge lines up with the bottom of the card. Line the horizontal pieces up with a small space between each of the five pieces, I like to work from the top and bottom to the center. Adhere the horizontal pieces to the back of the vertical pieces working on the inside of the card. To finish the inside and make it a pretty as the outside, adhere the remaining vertical pieces back to back with the outer vertical pieces using liquid glue.
4. Adhere the designer series paper using liquid glue.
5. Stamp the "Sending You a Big Squeeze" sentiment on the right side of the Basic White banner. Stamp the "thanks a Bunch" sentiment to the center right of the scalloped rectangle using Night of Navy ink.
6. Punch a 1/8" hole on the top of the Lemon Lime Twist banner. Wrap the ribbon around the banner, then thread the hole with the ribbon and make a bow. Place a Mini Stampin' Dimensional under the banner for extra support. Adhere the sentiment pieces to the card using liquid glue.
7. Stamp the fruit images on a scrap of Basic White Cardstock using Lemon Lolly ink for the inside of the fruit image and Daffodil Delight ink for the fruit's skin. Die cut using the Hybrid Embossing Folder. Stamp the leaves using Granny Apple Green ink. Stamp the flower image on Bubble Bath Cardstock using Berry Burst ink. Die cut the leaves and flowers.
8. Dry fit the fruit and leaves on the card, then dab liquid glue to adhere together as one piece. With the fruit and leaves on the crate piece, place Stampin' Dimensionals directly on to the wood planks under where the fruit and leaves go. Be careful not to glue your card closed.
9. Adhere a leaf to the whole lemon and glue it on the inside of the card. Adhere the flowers to the front of the card and the inside using a combination of liquid glue and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Embellish using the Iridescent Rhinestone Basic Jewels.
