Measurements

- **Basic Black Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 4 x 5-1/4"
 - scrap for die cutting a 2-5/16" stitched square using the Stylish Shapes Dies
 - scrap for stamping and punching or fussy cutting a large pumpkin, a medium pumpkin, a small pumpkin, THREE stems, TWO leaves and TWO crows
- **Smoky Slate Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching the solid oval using the Double Oval Punch
- **Pumpkin Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a swoopy square using the Handmade Tag Punch
 - scrap for die cutting the tag-O reinforcer using the Tailor Made Tags Dies
- **Starry Sky Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the tag-O reinforcer using the Tailor Made Tags Dies
- **Them Bones Designer Series Paper**
 - THREE patterns of your choice - cut using modified Wonder Recipe #23
 - 2 x 3-3/4"
 - 1 x 3-3/4"
 - 1 x 2-1/4"
- **Linen Thread**
 - 14"
- **3/8" Textured Ribbon - Copper Clay**
 - 5-1/2"

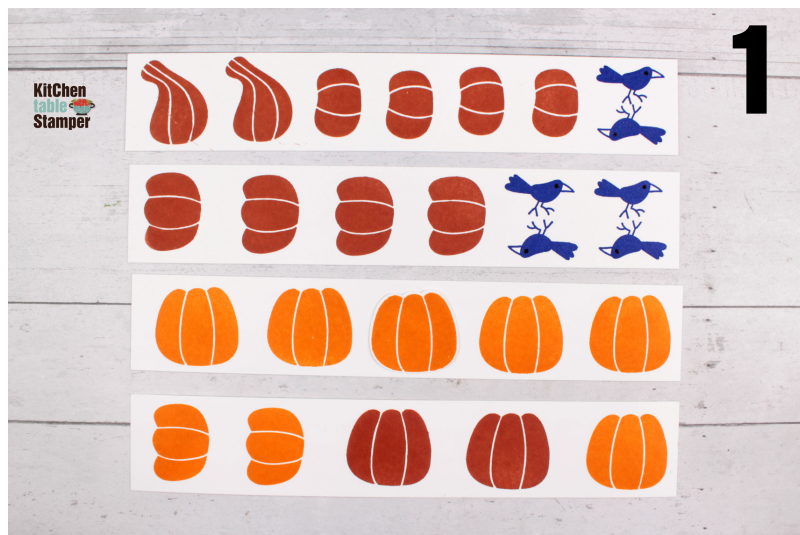


Instructions

1. Score and burnish the card base using your Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Distressed Tile 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Cut the swoopy square in half, then adhere one of the halves to the back of the right side of the 2 x 3-3/4" piece of designer paper pieces using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the 2 x 3-3/4" and the 1 x 3-3/4" pieces of designer paper, then the stitched square using liquid glue. After the square is glued down, adhere the 1 x 2-1/4" piece of designer paper using the same adhesive.
3. Stamp the large pumpkin using Pumpkin Pie ink, the medium and small pumpkins using Copper Clay ink, the stems using Crumb Cake ink and the leaves using Old Olive ink. Punch out using the Pick of the Patch Builder Punch or fussy cut where needed. Adhere the stems to the pumpkins, then adhere the completed pumpkins to the stitched square using liquid glue. Adhere the leaves to the pumpkins using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
4. Stamp one crow using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Stamp the other crow using Starry Sky ink. Fussy cut the full black crow and just the body of the Starry Sky crow. Adhere together using liquid glue. Use the Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker to fill in the bird's eye. Fill in the bird's beak using a Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Write Marker. Adhere to the card using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
5. Stamp the sentiment on the Smoky Slate oval with Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Adhere the Pumpkin Pie or Starry Sky tag reinforcer on the right side of the oval using liquid glue. Use a 1/8" circle punch to punch the Smoky Slate oval making it a tag.
6. Fold the Copper Clay ribbon in half and tie the Linen Thread around it, then thread the tag with the Linen Thread and make a bow. Adhere the ribbon and sentiment piece to the card front using a combination of a Tear & Tape Adhesive and a Stampin' Dimensional.
7. Embellish with the Adhesive-Backed Sparkle Gems.



Pick of the Patch Stamp a Stack Stamping Tips:



Cut the first sheet of 5-1/2 x 8-1/2" Basic White Cardstock into 1-1/2" strips. Stamp the pumpkins that you are going to punch first.

Be sure to take into account the orientation of the punch before stamping.

Stamp the pumpkins that you are going to hand cut in the remaining space.



Cut the second sheet of 5-1/2 x 8-1/2" Basic White Cardstock into 1" strips. Stamp six leaves on each strip. Punch the leaves first.

After punching the leaves stamp the stems between in two rows.

Punch the stems across the bottom row first.



The third sheet of 5-1/2 x 8-1/2" Basic White Cardstock is for your birds and the leaves that need to be fussy cut.

Using these photos and this method should leave you will plenty of Basic White Cardstock and teach you some tips for the best use with our favorite "paper waster" punch.
