## Trucking Along Four for One Card Set



### Measurements

- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - FOUR - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
  - FOUR - 4 x 5-1/4"
  - scrap to die cut FOUR 1-9/16 x 3-5/16" tags using the Tailor Made Tags Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap to stamp and fussy cut TWO clouds and the flower image using the Trucking Along Stamp Set
  - scrap to stamp and punch the truck using the Trucking Along Bundle
- **Crushed Curry Cardstock**
  - FOUR - 1-3/8" Circles
- **One Horse Open Sleigh Designer Series Paper**
  - FOUR - 3-3/4 x 5", patterns of your choice
  - scrap to die cut FOUR 1-9/16 x 3-5/16" tags using the Tailor Made Tags Dies
- **Linen Thread**
  - FOUR - double bows about 22" each

# Instructions

1. Cut your designer series paper.
  - a. Mark the left edge of your two lightest designer series papers at 2 and 3". Then mark the right edges at 1 and 4".
  - b. Place two papers stacked on your paper trimmer. Line up the 2" mark on the left and the 1" mark on the right, on the cutting track of your trimmer and cut.
  - c. Line up the 3" mark on the left and the 4" mark the right on the cutting track of your trimmer and cut.
  - d. Repeat for the second stack of two sheets.
2. Your paper will look like the photo above when you are done. Adhere three pieces to each of the Early Espresso cardstock card fronts, then adhere the card front to the Crumb Cake card base using liquid glue.
3. Stamp the dots from the Quiet Meadow Stamp Set on the designer paper tag with Early Espresso ink. Adhere the designer paper tag to the Early Espresso tag using the same glue. Thread the holes of the tag with the Linen Thread and make a double bow.
4. Stamp the sentiment with Early Espresso ink on the Crushed Curry circle. Place a Stampin' Dimensional on the upper left section of the tag and place the sentiment circle on the tag.
5. On a scrap of Basic White cardstock, stamp the truck using Early Espresso ink. Fill in the tires with the same ink. Fill in the truck with Cherry Cobbler ink. Punch using the Truck Builder Punch.
6. On another scrap of Basic White Cardstock, stamp the flowers using Early Espresso ink. Fill in the flowers with Crushed Curry ink. Fill in the leaves with a Light Old Olive Stampin' Blend. Adhere the flower image to the back of the truck using liquid glue.
7. On another scrap of Basic White Cardstock, stamp the clouds using Early Espresso ink.
8. Adhere the truck to the tag piece using Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the clouds to the tag using liquid glue. Adhere the completed tag piece to the card using liquid glue.
