## Measurements

- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
- 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- 5-1/4 x 4, scored on the 5-1/4" side at 2"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
- scrap for die cutting a 2-3/4" circle using the Deckled Circle Dies
- scrap for die cutting a the largest banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
- 3/8 x 3-1/4"
- scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the Merry Christmas greeting using the Merry & Bright Stamp Set
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
- scrap for stamping and fussy cutting THREE pinecones using the Precious Pinecones Stamp Set
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
- scrap for stamping and fussy cutting ONE large bough and THREE small boughs using the Precious Pinecones Stamp Set
- **Real Red Cardstock**
- scrap for stamping and fussy cutting TWO bows using the Precious Pinecones Stamp Set
- **Joy of Christmas Designer Series Paper - patterns of your choice**
- 4 x 5-1/4"
- 3 x 3-3/4"
- 1-3/4 x 3-3/4"
- 2-1/2 x 4"
- 3/4 x 3-3/4"



# Instructions

1. Fold and burnish the Early Espresso Cardstock panels using a Bone Folder.
2. Find the center across the 4" side of the 2-1/2 x 4" piece of designer series paper and then punch a partial circle thumb notch.
3. Adhere the inside white liner and all the designer series paper using liquid glue. Glue the small card to the front of the standard size card. Adhere the deckled circle to the front of the small card being careful not to glue the card closed.
4. Stamp three pinecones using Early Espresso ink on Pecan Pie Cardstock. Stamp one large bough and three small boughs using Old Olive ink on Old Olive Cardstock. Stamp two bows using Cherry Cobbler ink on Real Red Cardstock. Fussy cut.
5. Stamp the sentiments using Real Red ink. Adhere the inside sentiment using liquid glue.
6. Adhere the pinecones outside using a combination of liquid and dimensional adhesive. Adhere the boughs using liquid glue. Adhere the bow inside using liquid glue and the bow outside with a dimensional. Adhere the inside, inside sentiment using liquid glue.
7. Embellish with Neutral Adhesive Backed Sequins.
