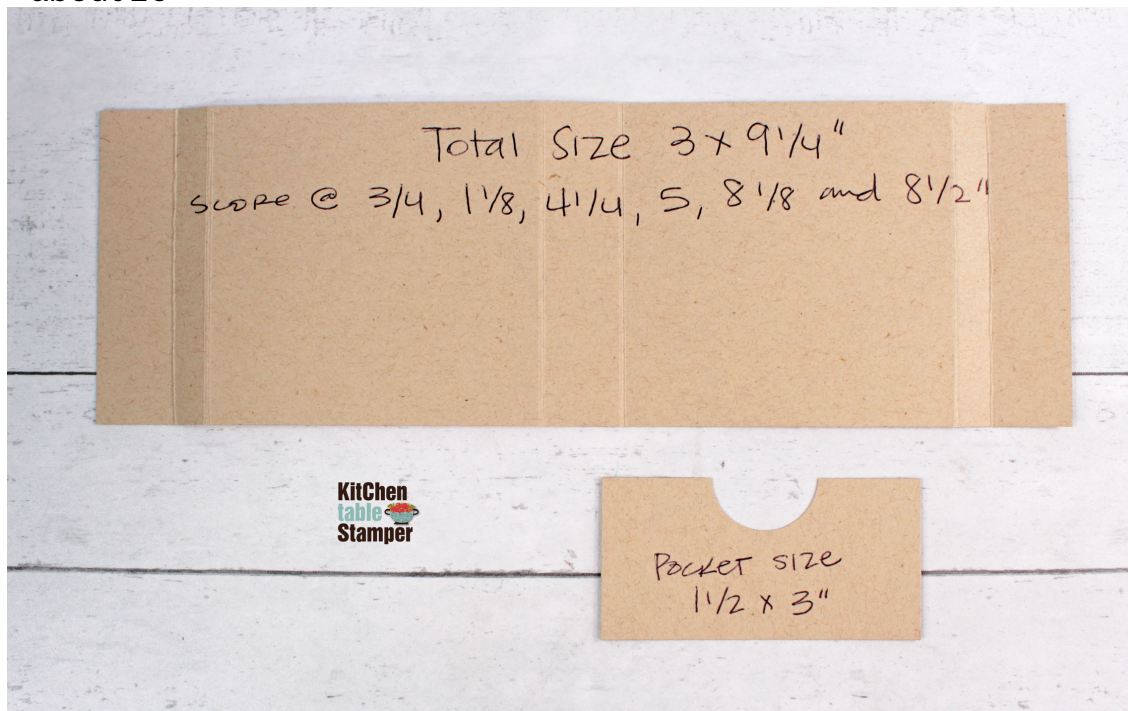

Measurements

- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - 3 x 9-1/4", scored at 3/4, 1-1/8, 4-1/4, 5, 8-1/8 & 8-1/2" on the 9-1/4" side
 - 1-1/2 x 3" with a 1" thumb notch in the top center
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a 2-1/2" circle using the Deckled Circles Dies
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the large and small poinsettia using the Modern Garden Stamp Set
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting a pinecone using the Precious Pinecones Stamp Set
- **Shaded Spruce Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting TWO leaves using the Precious Pinecones Stamp Set
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting TWO boughs using the Precious Pinecones Stamp Set
- **Gold Foil**
 - scrap for die cutting a leaf vein using the Autumn Leaves Dies
- **Joy of Christmas Designer Series Paper**
 - 2-3/4 x 2-7/8"
- **Gold & Vanilla 3/8" Satin Edged Ribbon**
 - about 20"



Instructions

1. Score and burnish with a Bone Folder. On one end of the wrapper, use a ruler and a pencil to mark the 3/4" sections at 5/8 & 2-3/8", or do 5/8" from each side. Use a **1/8" circle punch** to punch a hole on the marks.
2. Adhere the designer paper on the front cover of the tea & treat holder using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Place a thin line of liquid glue on the sides of the 1-1/2 x 3" piece of Early Espresso cardstock with the thumb notch and glue it inside the wrapper. Once dry, place the tea in the tea holder and use a couple Mini Glue Dots to hold down the treat on the other large section. Close the tea and treat holder, then thread the ribbon through the holes and make a big loopy bow to close.
4. Stamp the splatter from the Quiet Meadow Stamp Set on the Very Vanilla deckled circle using Early Espresso ink.
5. Stamp the pinecone on Pecan Pie cardstock with Early Espresso ink.
6. Stamp TWO leaves on Shaded Spruce cardstock using Shaded Spruce ink. Stamp TWO boughs on Old Olive cardstock using Old Olive ink. Fussy cut.
7. Stamp the poinsettia flowers on the Very Vanilla cardstock using Real Red ink for the floral part and Cherry Cobbler ink for the dots in the center on the smaller flower. Fussy cut.
8. Adhere the pinecone, leaves, gold foil leaf vein and poinsettia to the deckled circle using a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals. Then pop the circle on the front of the wrapper using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Embellish with the Neutrals Adhesive-Backed Sequins.
