A: 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"

B: 3-1/4 x 4-3/8"

C: 3 x 4-1/8"

D: 3/4 x 3"

Cool People Card Sketch #2



Measurements

- **Blueberry Bushel Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 1-7/8 x 3-1/4" dotted rectangle using the Everyday Details Dies
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the blueberries
- **Granny Apple Green**
 - scrap for die cutting the label using the Lovely & Sweet Dies
- **Delightful Floral Designer Series Paper**
 - 3-1/4 x 4-3/8"
 - 3 x 4-1/8"
 - 3/4 x 3"
- **1/8" Metallic Woven Ribbon**
 - about 36"

Instructions

1. Score the Blueberry Bushel card base and burnish with a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front with the Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the 3/4 x 3" piece of designer paper to the 3 x 4-1/8" piece using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Fold the ribbon in half, wrap it around the 3 x 4-1/8" piece of designer paper and tie a double bow. Adhere this panel and the bigger piece of designer paper to the card, as shown, using liquid glue.
4. Stamp the sentiment from the Blueberry Bunches Stamp Set on the dotted rectangle with Blueberry Bushel ink.
5. Stamp the blueberries with Tuxedo Black Memento Ink. Watercolor the blueberries with Blueberry Bushel ink and the leaves with a combination of Granny Apple Green and Lemon Lime Twist ink, then fussy cut.
6. Adhere the blueberries to the dotted rectangle using a combination of liquid glue and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Cut the Granny Apple Green label in half. Then adhere the dotted rectangle and half label to the card front using a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Embellish with Rustic Metallic Adhesive-Backed Dots.

Wonder Recipe #14

CARD CLUB TIP: You are making TWO each of the following two designs, and one more design in addition. Begin by cutting TWO 6 x 6" pieces of designer series paper, patterns of your choice, according to Wonder Recipe #14 shown above. The measurements below are for ONE card.



Measurements

- **Blueberry Bushel Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 2-7/16" dotted circle using the Everyday Details Dies
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the blueberries
 - scrap for die cutting the 7/16 x 1-9/16" banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
- **Granny Apple Green**
 - scrap for die cutting the leaves using the Notes of Nature Dies
- **Vellum Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a small flower using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Delightful Floral Designer Series Paper**
 - 3 x 4"
 - 1 x 4"
- **1/8" Metallic Woven Ribbon**
 - about 20"

Instructions

1. Score the Blueberry Bushel card base and burnish with a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front with the Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper and the dotted circle to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the Basic White banner with Blueberry Bushel ink. I got this little 'HELLO' from the Gorgeously Made Stamp Set.
4. Stamp the blueberries with Tuxedo Black Memento Ink. Watercolor the blueberries with Blueberry Bushel ink and the leaves with a combination of Granny Apple Green and Lemon Lime Twist ink, then fussy cut.
5. Adhere the blueberries to the card front with a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Make a double bow with the Starry Sky ribbon, put it on a Mini Glue Dot, then pick up the die cut leaves with the same Mini Glue dot. You can use the one Mini Glue Dot to attach both pieces or feel free to add a little liquid glue to the leaves if you want them stuck tighter.
7. Pop the sentiment banner on the card over the bow using a Mini Glue Dot on the back left and a Mini Stampin' Dimensional on the back right.
8. Press the vellum flower into the Stampin' Pierce Mat using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool to shape it. Then adhere the flower to the card with a glue dot.
9. Embellish with Rustic Metallic Adhesive-Backed Dots.

Measurements

- **Blueberry Bushel Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 2 x 3-1/4" label with the Thoughtful Expressions Dies
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the blueberries
- **Granny Apple Green**
 - scrap for die cutting the vine using the Notes of Nature Dies
- **Vellum Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a small and a medium flower using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Delightful Floral Designer Series Paper**
 - 3 x 4"
 - 1 x 4"
- **1/8" Metallic Woven Ribbon**
 - about 20"

Instructions

1. Score the Blueberry Bushel card base and burnish with a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front with the Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Stamp the sentiment from the Blueberry Bunches Stamp Set on the Basic White label with Blueberry Bushel ink.
3. Adhere the designer paper and the Basic White label to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the blueberries with Tuxedo Black Memento Ink. Watercolor the blueberries with Blueberry Bushel ink and the leaves with a combination of Granny Apple Green and Lemon Lime Twist ink, then fussy cut.
5. Adhere the blueberries to the card front with a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Cut the die cut Granny Apple Green vine in half and then adhere one half to the card under the blueberries using liquid glue.
7. Make a double bow with the Starry Sky ribbon then adhere it to the card front with a Mini Glue Dot.
8. Press the small and medium vellum flowers into the Stampin' Pierce Mat using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool to shape them. Layer the flowers, adhering them together and then to the card with glue dots.
9. Embellish with Rustic Metallic Adhesive-Backed Dots.

Measurements

- **Blueberry Bushel Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the second largest stitched swoopy circle with the Thoughtful Expressions Dies
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the blueberries
- **Granny Apple Green**
 - scrap for die cutting the leaves using the Lovely & Sweet Dies
- **Vellum Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a small and a medium flower using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Delightful Floral Designer Series Paper**
 - TWO 2 x 2"
 - 3/4 X 5"
- **1/8" Metallic Woven Ribbon**
 - about 20"

Instructions

1. Score the Blueberry Bushel card base and burnish with a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front with the Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Cut the remaining 2 x 2" pieces of designer paper pieces in half making 1 x 2" pieces. Adhere these 1 x 2" pieces side by side, in two rows, with a small gap in-between the pieces and between the rows. See the photo below. Don't worry all the gaps will get covered up.
3. Adhere the 3/4 x 5" strip to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. This strip covers the gap between the rows.
4. Stamp the sentiment from the Blueberry Bunches Stamp Set on the Basic White stitched swoopy circle with Blueberry Bushel ink. Adhere the swoopy circle to the card using liquid glue, this covers the gap between the 1 x 2" pieces of designer paper.
5. Stamp the blueberries with Tuxedo Black Memento Ink. Watercolor the blueberries with Blueberry Bushel ink and the leaves with a combination of Granny Apple Green and Lemon Lime Twist ink, then fussy cut.
6. Adhere the blueberries to the card front with a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Make a double bow with the Starry Sky ribbon, put it on a Mini Glue Dot, then pick up the die cut leaves with the same Mini Glue dot. You can use the one Mini Glue Dot to attach both pieces or feel free to add a little liquid glue to the leaves if you want them stuck tighter.
8. Press the small and medium vellum flowers into the Stampin' Pierce Mat using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool to shape them. Layer the flowers, adhering them together and then to the card with glue dots.
9. Embellish with Rustic Metallic Adhesive-Backed Dots.
