## Let's Chat - Hello Card



### *Measurements*

- **Pool Party Cardstock**
  - THREE 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the THREE of the third largest label using the Countryside Corners Dies
  - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting THREE of the telephone receiver, sound and hearts
- **Sunny Days Designer Series Paper**
  - 3 x 4", I cut mine down into THREE 1 x 4" pieces
  - TWO - 2-1/4 x 4" pieces, I cut mine down to THREE 3/4 x 4" pieces
- **Black & White 1/4" Gingham Ribbon**
  - about 9"
- **Linen Thread**
  - about 10"

## Instructions

1. Score and burnish the Pool Party Cardstock. Stamp the plaid background image using the Versa Mark ink pad.
2. Adhere the designer paper to the card front with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. On the label, stamp the telephone base, wire and the sentiment using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. On the scrap of Basic White cardstock, stamp the telephone receiver using the same ink. Stamp the sound with Crushed Curry ink and the heart with Sweet Sorbet ink.
4. Fussy cut the telephone receiver, sound and heart then pop them on the label using Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Fold the gingham ribbon in half and tie a loopy bow of Linen Tread at the looped end. Adhere the ribbon to the back of the label, then adhere the label to the card front.
6. Embellish with Adhesive Backed Sparkle Gems.
