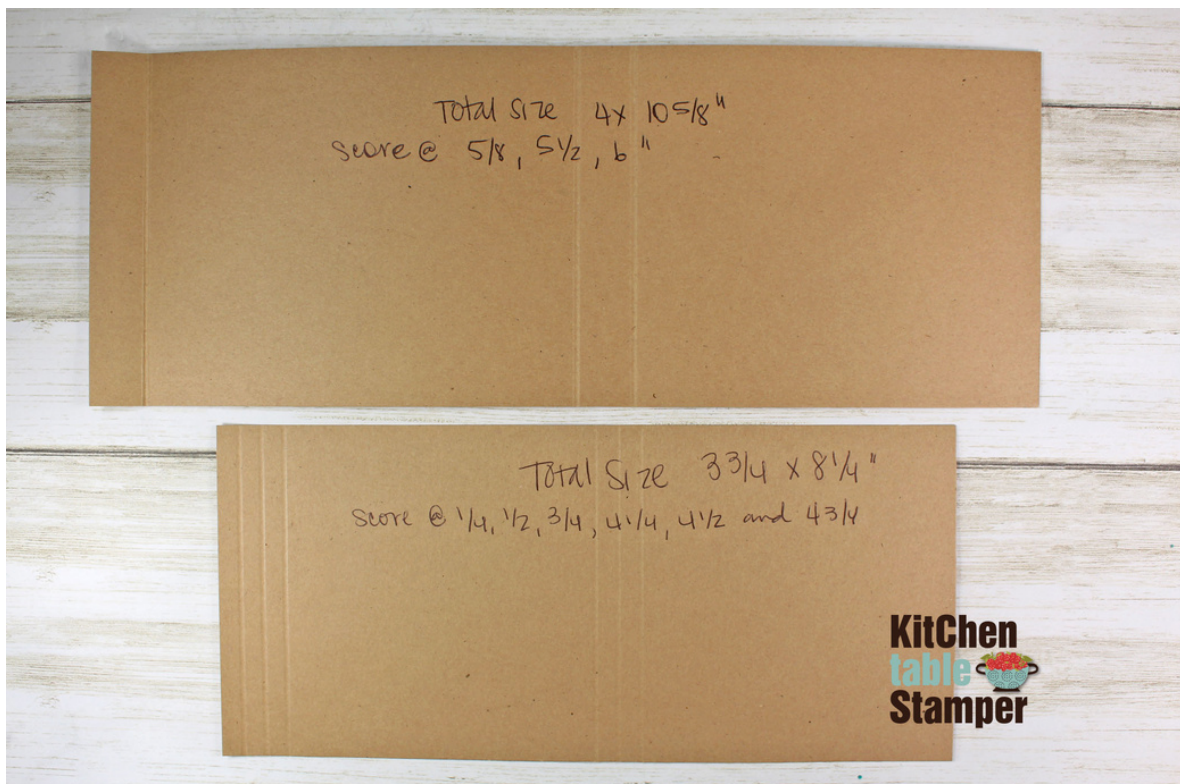

Measurements

- **Night of Navy Cardstock**
 - 4 x 10-5/8", scored at 5/8, 5-1/2 and 6"
 - 3-3/4 x 8-1/4", scored at 1/4, 1/2, 3/4, 4-1/4, 4-1/2 and 4-3/4"
 - scrap for die cutting the details of the airplane using the Adventurous Sky Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting three different size clouds using the Adventurous Sky Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the smallest postage square using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Boho Blue Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the base of the airplane using the Adventurous Sky Dies
- **Smoky Slate Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the propeller using the Adventurous Sky Dies
- **Take to the Sky Designer Series Paper**
 - 2 x 4-1/4"
 - TWO 2 x 4" tag element
 - one of the 3 x 4" pieces cut down to 3 x 3-1/4" for the inside of the matchbook cover
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 8"



Instructions

1. Cut and score the matchbook pieces according to the template photo above. Burnish the score lines with a Bone Folder. Assemble the matchbook using Tear & Tape Adhesive and staples.
2. Punch a hole in the tags using a 1/8" hole punch then thread the tag with the Linen Thread and tie a knot in the end
3. Adhere the designer series paper and tags to the wrapper and the inside pocket with Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Then secure the twine to the matchbook with a Mini Glue Dot
4. Assemble the airplane using liquid glue, then adhere it to the front of the matchbook with Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Stamp the sentiments on the large cloud and the postage stamp using Night of Navy ink.
6. Adhere the small clouds to the front of the matchbook cover, the postage stamp to the inside pocket, and the large cloud to the bottom flap, all with Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Use a Mini Glue Dot to embellish with an Industrial Trinket
