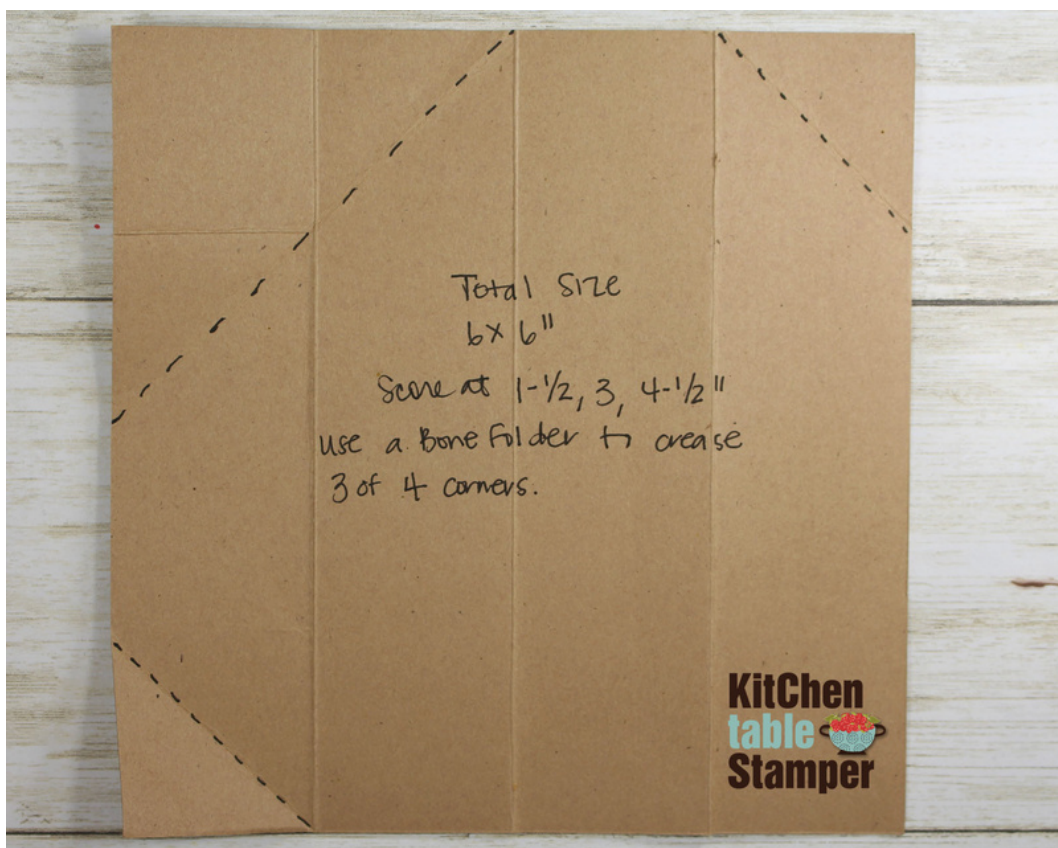

Measurements

- **Take to the Sky Designer Series Paper**
 - 6 x 6" scored at 1-1/2, 3, and 4-1/2"
 - 1 x 3-1/2" with chicken lips on both ends
- **Smoky Slate Cardstock**
 - scrap to punch a hexagon using the Heartfelt Hexagon Punch
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap to stamp and die cut the medium airplane using the Adventurous Sky Bundle
- **Night of Navy Cardstock**
 - scrap to die cut a tag reinforcer using the Merriest Trees Dies
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 24"



Instructions

1. Score the designer paper according to the measurements above, then use a Bone Folder to crease three out of four corners. See template photo above.
2. Seal the bottom with Multipurpose Liquid Glue, then run through a sewing machine to seal the bottom if you want too.
3. Adhere the 1 x 3-1/2" strip of designer paper with chicken lips to the front of the pen pocket using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the clouds and the sentiment on the Smoky Slate hexagon with Night of Navy ink. Color the clouds with the Basic White colored pencil from the Watercolor Pencils Assortment 1.
5. Fold and adhere the Night of Navy tag reinforcer to the top of the hexagon with liquid glue. Punch a 1/8" hole through the label.
6. Fold the Linen Thread in half, then thread it through the holes of the rectangle. Make two large knots to hold it in place. Cut the thread and continue to make several additional knots up to the top of the Linen Thread.
7. Stamp the medium airplane with Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Water color the plane with the ink and a water painter. When dry, die cut the plane.
8. Adhere the plane to the hexagon tag, then to the pen pocket with Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Using a Mini Glue Dot embellish with an Industrial Trinket.
10. Place the pen in the pocket.
