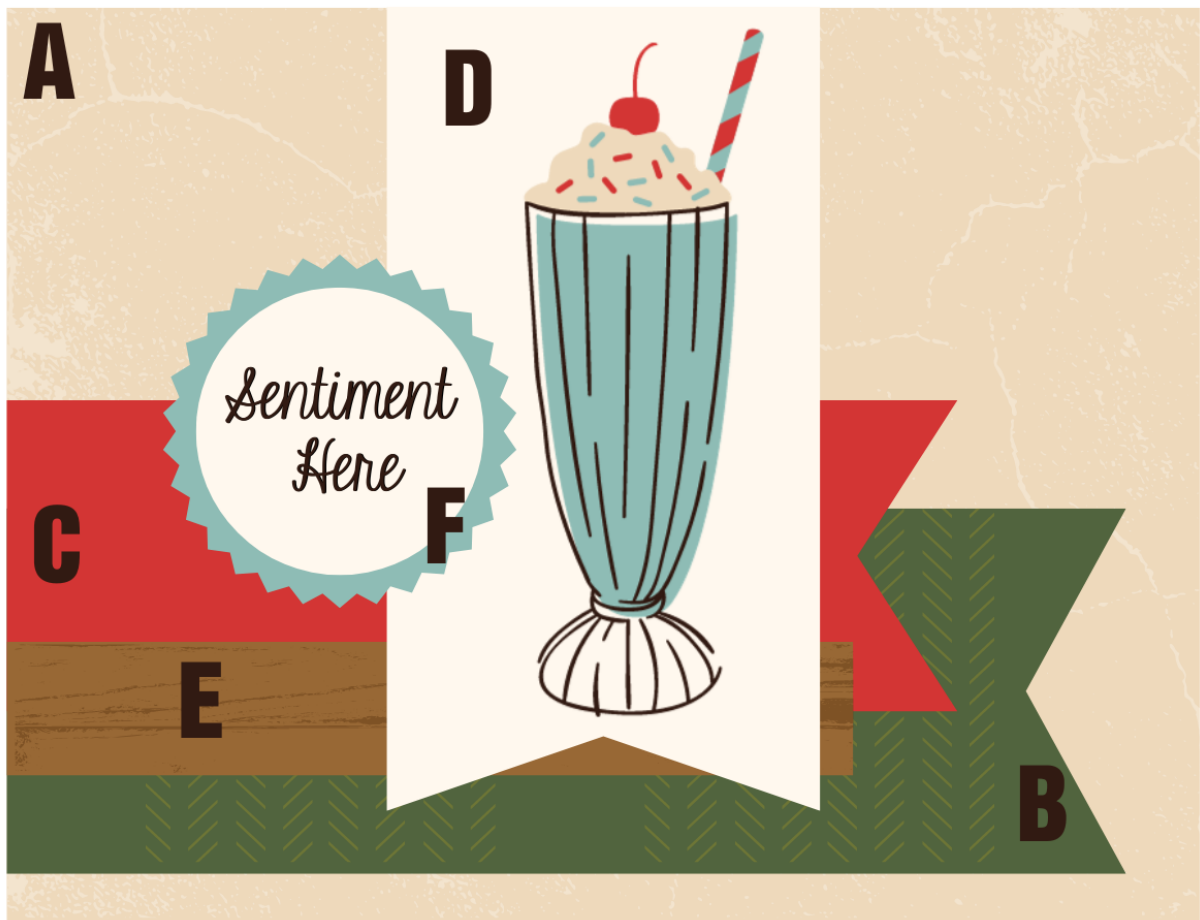

## You're the Most Awesome Cool People Card Sketch #4



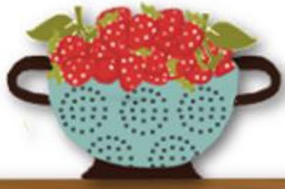
### Measurements

- **Gray Granite Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - 7/8 x 2-3/4" with chicken lips on each side
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the measuring tape, paint brush and hammer using the Trusty Tools Bundle
- **Trusty Toolbox Designer Series Paper**
  - 2 x 4" with chicken lips on the bottom
  - 2 x 5-1/4" with chicken lips on the right side
  - 1-1/2 x 4-7/8" with chicken lips on the right side
  - 7/8 x 4-1/2" ruler
- **Gold 1/8" Faux Leather Trim**
  - about 10"

# Instructions

1. Score the card base and burnish with a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front with the Metal Plate 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer series paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the 7/8 x 2-3/4" white banner using Poppy Parade ink.
4. Stamp the measuring tape, paintbrush and hammer on the scrap of white cardstock using Memento ink. Do any two step stamping using your choice of Crushed Curry, Lost Lagoon, Poppy Parade or Copper Clay ink. Color the remaining areas that can not be two step stamped using Stampin' Blend Markers. Die cut.
5. Adhere the tools to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Fold the leather trim in half and make a knot on the loop end. Adhere it to the back of the sentiment banner using Mini Glue Dots. Adhere the banner and faux leather trim to the card front using dimensional adhesive.
7. Embellish with Cork Rounds.

## Happy Father's Day

### *Wonder Recipes #12 & #20*

**CARD CLUB TIP:** You are making TWO of the following design, and THREE of the next two designs. Begin by cutting TWO 6 x 6" patterns of designer series paper according to Wonder Recipe #20 and ONE pattern for modified Wonder Recipe #12. The measurements below are for ONE card.



### *Measurements*

- **Gray Granite Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
  - scrap for die cutting the drill details using the Trusty Tools Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the banner using the Hearts & Hugs Dies
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting a wrench and a hammer using the Trusty Tools Bundle
  - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the word "DAD" using the Trusty Tools Stamp Set

## Measurements

- **Lost Lagoon Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the drill details using the Trusty Tools Dies
- **Crushed Curry Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the drill details using the Trusty Tools Dies
- **Copper Clay Cardstock**
  - 2-7/16 x 3-13/16" for die cutting the pegboard using the Trusty Tools Dies
- **Trusty Toolbox Designer Series Paper**
  - with the modified Wonder Recipe #12, cut the 3 x 4" piece into:
    - 3 x 3"
    - 1 x 3"
  - 3/8 x 4" ruler pattern
  - 2-3/8" circle
- **Gold 1/8" Faux Leather Trim**
  - about 7"

## Instructions

1. Score the card base and burnish with a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front with the Metal Plate 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer series paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the banner using Lost Lagoon ink.
4. Stamp the hammer and the wrench on the scrap of white cardstock using Memento ink. Do any two step stamping using your choice of Crushed Curry, Lost Lagoon, Poppy Parade or Copper Clay ink. Color the remaining areas that can not be two step stamped using Stampin' Blend Markers. Die cut.
5. Die cut the pegboard and drill pieces. Cut the pegboard down to 1-1/8 x 2-7/16". Save the remaining pegboard piece for making additional cards.
6. Outline the drill pieces by running the edges along the brush tip of the Black Stampin' Write Marker. Assemble the tools using liquid glue. Use the bullet tip of the same marker to draw some details. Refer to the designer series paper for inspiration.
7. Adhere the tools to the card front with liquid glue.
8. Adhere the sentiment banner to the pegboard using liquid glue. Make a knot on each end of the leather trim and adhere it to the back of the pegboard using Mini Glue Dots, then adhere the completed piece to the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Pop "Dad" up on dimensionals and adhere it to the card.
10. Embellish with Cork Rounds.

## You're the Most Awesome

### Wonder Recipe #20



### Measurements

- **Gray Granite Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - 7/8 x 2-3/4" with chicken lips on each side
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the pencil, measuring tape, paint brush, wrench and hammer using the Trusty Tools Bundle
- **Copper Clay Cardstock**
  - 2-7/16 x 3-13/16" for die cutting the pegboard using the Trusty Tools Dies
- **Trusty Toolbox Designer Series Paper**
  - TWO 2 x 4"
  - 13/16 x 4-1/4" ruler pattern
- **Gold 1/8" Faux Leather Trim**
  - about 6"

# Instructions

1. Score the card base and burnish with a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front with the Metal Plate 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer series paper and die cut pegboard to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the 7/8 x 2-3/4" white banner using Poppy Parade ink.
4. Stamp the pencil, measuring tape, paint brush, wrench and hammer on the scrap of white cardstock using Memento ink. Do any two step stamping using your choice of Crushed Curry, Lost Lagoon, Poppy Parade or Copper Clay ink. Color the remaining areas that can not be two step stamped using Stampin' Blend Markers. Die cut.
5. Adhere the paintbrush, wrench and hammer to the using liquid glue.
6. Adhere the measuring tape to the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Make a knot on each end of the leather trim. Adhere it to the back of the sentiment banner using Mini Glue Dots. Adhere the banner to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Embellish with Cork Rounds.

## Thank You

*Wonder Recipe #12 & #20*



### *Measurements*

- **Gray Granite Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the smallest clipped corner rectangle using the Countryside Corners Dies
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the measuring tape, paint brush, wrench and hammer using the Trusty Tools Bundle
- **Copper Clay Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the toolbox using the Trusty Tools Dies
- **Trusty Toolbox Designer Series Paper**
  - THREE 2 x 2"
  - 1/2 X 3" ruler pattern
- **Gold 1/8" Faux Leather Trim**
- about 8"

# Instructions

1. Score the card base and burnish with a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front with the Metal Plate 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the THREE 2 X 2" pieces of designer series paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the clipped corner rectangle using Poppy Parade ink.
4. Stamp the measuring tape, paint brush, wrench and hammer on the scrap of white cardstock using Memento ink. Do any two step stamping using your choice of Crushed Curry, Lost Lagoon, Poppy Parade or Copper Clay ink. Color the remaining areas that can not be two step stamped using Stampin' Blend Markers. Die cut.
5. Emboss tool box and handle pieces using the Timber 3D Embossing Folder. Outline it by running the edges along the brush tip of the Black Stampin' Write Marker.
6. Adhere the paint brush, wrench and hammer to the back of the toolbox using Tear & Tape Adhesive or liquid glue.
7. Adhere the tool box to the card using liquid glue.
8. Adhere the measuring tape to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Adhere the ruler to the card front with liquid glue.
10. Fold the leather trim in half and make a knot on the loop end. Adhere it to the back of the sentiment banner using Mini Glue Dots. Adhere the banner and faux leather trim to the card front using dimensional adhesive.
11. Embellish with Cork Rounds.
