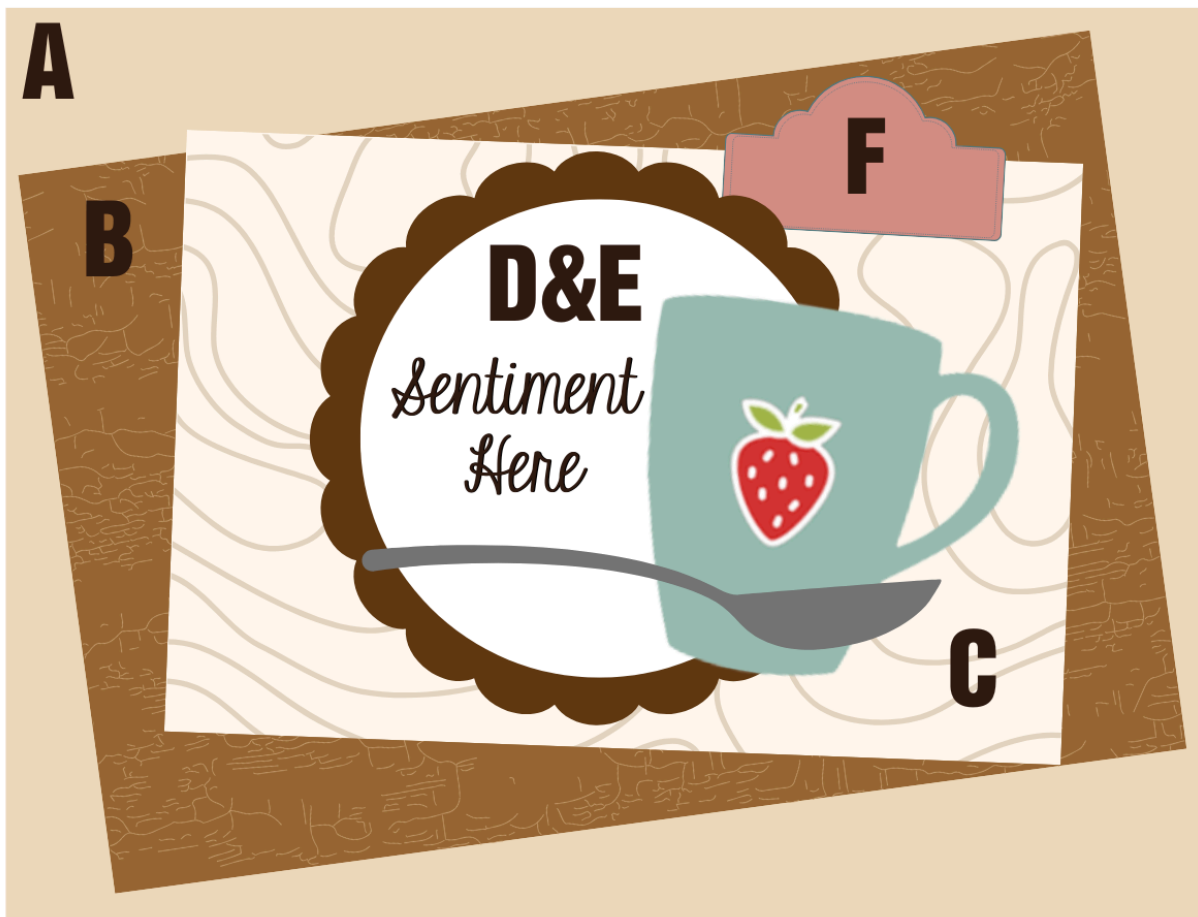

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Best Part of My Day - Horizontal Card

Wonder Recipe #7 and Card Sketch #5

CARD CLUB TIP: You are making TWO each of all of the designs. Begin by cutting THREE 6 x 6" pieces of designer series paper according to Modified Wonder Recipe #7. The measurements below are for ONE card.



Measurements

- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the large coffee cup using the Latte Love Bundle
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a 2-3/8" circle
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - 3-1/2 x 4-3/4"
 - scrap for die cutting the liquid for two small coffee cups using the Latte Love Dies
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the tab using the Lovely & Sweet Dies
 - scrap for die cutting two small coffee cups using the Latte Love Dies
- **Smoky Slate Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a spoon using the Latte Love Bundle
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the second largest swoopy circle using the Thoughtful Expressions Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the liquid for the largest coffee cup, the individual and group of coffee beans using the Latte Love Bundle
- **A Little Latte Designer Series Paper**
 - 3 x 4"

Measurements - Cont.

- **Pool Party 3/8" Grosgrain Ribbon**
 - about 12"
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 12"

Instructions

1. Score the Pool Party cardstock and burnish with a Bone Folder. Stamp the corners of the card front with the splatter stamps from the Latte Love Stamp Set using Early Espresso ink.
2. Staple the Petal Pink tab to the top right of the designer paper. Emboss the Early Espresso piece with the Timeworn Type 3D Embossing Folder. Adhere to the card front, followed by the designer paper, using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Fold the ribbon in half and adhere it to the card front with Tear & Tape Adhesive. Trim the edges on an angle. Wrap the Linen Thread around the folded side of the ribbon and make a big loopy bow.
4. Stamp the sentiment on the 2-3/8" circle with Early Espresso ink. Adhere it to the Pecan Pie swirly circle, then to the card using liquid glue.
5. Stamp the large coffee cup on the scrap of Pool Party cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut.
6. Stamp the coffee image for the large mug, three individual coffee beans and the group of coffee beans on the scrap of Pecan Pie cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut. Stamp the spoon image on the scrap of Smoky Slate cardstock. Die cut. With the scrap of Early Espresso cardstock and a scrap of Petal Pink Cardstock die cut the coffee and small cups.
7. Adhere the coffee to the inside of the coffee cups using liquid glue. Adhere the large coffee cup, the spoon and the individual coffee beans with liquid glue. Adhere the two small coffee cups with Mini Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the group of coffee beans to the ribbon using a Mini Glue Dot on the knot of the Linen Thread.
8. Embellish with the Adhesive-Backed Swirl Dots.





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Best Part of My Day - Vertical Card

Wonder Recipe #1 and Card Sketch #5



Measurements

- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - scrap for die cutting a small coffee cup using the Latte Love Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the largest bracket top tag using the Tailor Made Tags Dies
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - 3-1/2 x 4-3/4"
 - scrap for die cutting the the liquid for the small coffee cup and coffee pot liquid using the Latte Love Dies
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the top view large coffee cup using the Latte Love Bundle
- **Smoky Slate Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a spoon and die cutting a coffee pot handle using the Latte Love Bundle
- **Vellum Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a coffee pot using the Latte Love Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the coffee pot lid using the Latte Love Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the group of coffee beans and liquid for the top view large coffee cup using the Latte Love Bundle
- **A Little Latte Designer Series Paper**
 - 3 x 4"

Measurements - Cont.

- **Pool Party 3/8" Grosgrain Ribbon**
 - about 5-1/2"
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 12"

Instructions

1. Score the Pool Party cardstock and burnish with a Bone Folder. Stamp the corners of the card front with the splatter stamps from the Latte Love Stamp Set using Early Espresso ink.
2. Emboss the Early Espresso piece with the Timeworn Type 3D Embossing Folder. Adhere to the card front, followed by the designer paper, using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the top right of the tag with Early Espresso ink. Adhere it to the card using liquid glue.
4. Fold the ribbon in half and adhere it to the tag with Mini Glue Dots or Tear & Tape Adhesive. Trim the edges on an angle. Wrap the Linen Thread around the folded side of the ribbon and make a big loopy bow.
5. Stamp the top view coffee cup on the scrap of Petal Pink cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut.
6. Stamp the coffee image for the top view large mug and the group of coffee beans on the scrap of Pecan Pie cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut these images, as well as the lid for the coffee pot. With the scrap of Early Espresso cardstock die cut the coffee for the small cup and the coffee in the coffee pot. Die cut the small cup from a scrap of Pool Party Cardstock. Adhere the coffee to the inside of the cups with liquid glue.
7. Stamp the spoon image on the scrap of Smoky Slate cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut the spoon and the handle piece of the coffee pot. Also die cut the vellum for the coffee pot.
8. Assemble the coffee pot with liquid glue, then adhere that, the top view coffee cup, and the spoon. Adhere the small coffee cup with a Mini Stampin' Dimensional. Adhere the group of coffee beans to the Linen Thread with a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Embellish with the Adhesive-Backed Swirl Dots.





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Thanks So Much Card

Wonder Recipe #1



Measurements

- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the long skinny banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
 - scrap for die cutting a small coffee cup using the Latte Love Dies
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - 3-1/2 x 4-3/4"
 - scrap for die cutting the liquid for the small coffee cup and the French press using the Latte Love Dies
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the large coffee cup using the Latte Love Bundle
- **Smoky Slate Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a spoon and die cutting the French press using the Latte Love Bundle
- **Vellum Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the French press using the Latte Love Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the group of coffee beans and the liquid for the large coffee cup using the Latte Love Bundle
- **A Little Latte Designer Series Paper**
 - cut the remaining 3 x 4" piece down to:
 - 1-1/2 x 3"
 - 2-1/2 x 3"

Measurements - Cont.

- **Pool Party 3/8" Grosgrain Ribbon**
 - about 5-1/2"
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 12"

Instructions

1. Score the Pool Party cardstock and burnish with a Bone Folder. Stamp the corners of the card front with the splatter stamps from the Latte Love Stamp Set using Early Espresso ink.
2. Emboss the Early Espresso piece with the Timeworn Type 3D Embossing Folder. Adhere to the card front, followed by the designer paper, using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the banner with Early Espresso ink.
4. Stamp the large coffee cup on the scrap of Petal Pink cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut.
5. Stamp the coffee image for the large mug and the group of coffee beans on the scrap of Pecan Pie cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut these images, as well as the Early Espresso coffee for the small cup and the coffee in the French press and a small coffee cup from a scrap of Basic White Cardstock. Adhere to the inside of the coffee cups with liquid glue.
6. Stamp the spoon image on the scrap of Smoky Slate cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut this and the French press. Also die cut the vellum for the French press.
7. Assemble the French press with liquid glue, then adhere that, the large coffee cup, sentiment banner, and the spoon using liquid glue. Adhere the small cup with a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
8. Fold the ribbon in half and adhere it to the banner with Mini Glue Dots. Trim the edges on an angle. Wrap the Linen Thread around the folded side of the ribbon and make a big loopy bow. Adhere the group of coffee beans to the Linen Thread with a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Embellish with the Adhesive-Backed Swirl Dots.





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Hello There Card

Wonder Recipe #7



Measurements

- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the top view large coffee cup using the Latte Love Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the second smallest bracket top tag using the Tailor Made Tags Dies
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - 3-1/2 x 4-3/4"
 - scrap for die cutting the liquid for the small coffee cup and the liquid for the French press using the Latte Love Dies
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a small coffee cup using the Latte Love Dies
- **Smoky Slate Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a spoon and die cutting the French press using the Latte Love Dies
- **Vellum Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the French press from the Latte Love Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the group of coffee beans and the liquid for the large coffee cup using the Latte Love Bundle
- **A Little Latte Designer Series Paper**
 - THREE 2 x 3"

Measurements - Cont.

- **Pool Party 3/8" Grosgrain Ribbon**
 - about 5-1/2"
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 12"

Instructions

1. Score the Pool Party cardstock and burnish with a Bone Folder. Stamp the corners of the card front with the splatter stamps from the Latte Love Stamp Set using Early Espresso ink.
2. Emboss the Early Espresso piece with the Timeworn Type 3D Embossing Folder. Adhere to the card front, followed by the designer paper, using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the tag with Early Espresso ink. Adhere it to the designer paper with liquid glue.
4. Fold the ribbon in half and adhere it to the tag with Mini Glue Dots. Trim the edges on an angle. Wrap the Linen Thread around the folded side of the ribbon and make a big loopy bow.
5. Stamp the top view coffee cup on the scrap of Pool Party cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut.
6. Stamp the coffee image for the top view mug and the group of coffee beans on the scrap of Pecan Pie cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut these images, as well as the coffee that goes in the small cup and the French press from a scrap of Early Espresso Cardstock, the little coffee cup from a scrap of Petal Pink Cardstock and the French press from a scrap of Smokey Slate Cardstock.
7. Adhere to the inside of the coffee cups with liquid glue.
8. Assemble the French press with liquid glue, then adhere that and the large coffee cup with liquid glue. Adhere the small coffee cup with a Mini Stampin' Dimensional. Adhere the group of coffee beans to the Linen Thread with a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Embellish with the Adhesive-Backed Swirl Dots.
