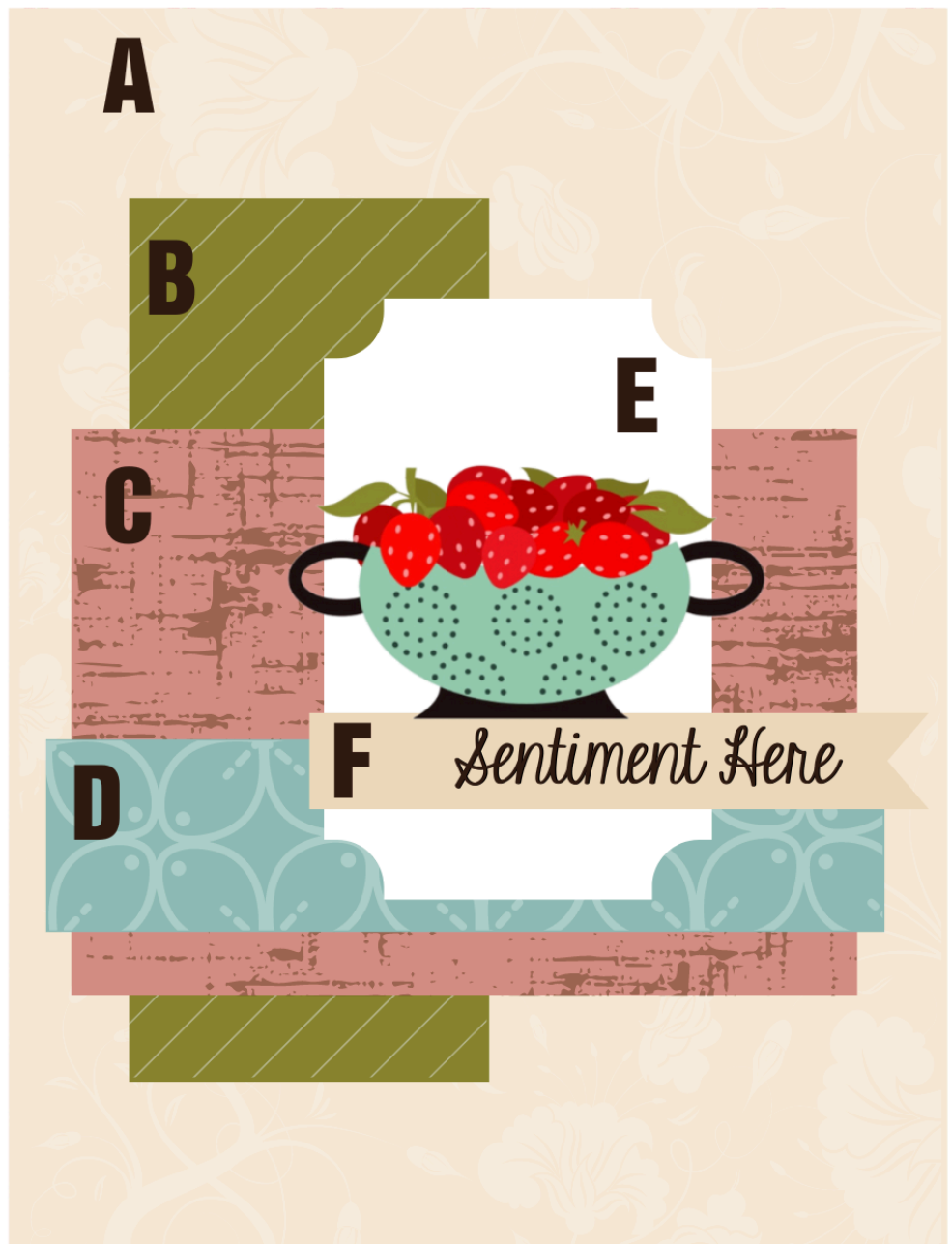

E: Any shape of your choice

F: Any shape of your choice

Card Sketch #6



Measurements

- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the smaller scalloped tag using the Something Fancy Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the long thin banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the pea, ONE leaf and TWO sprout images using the Sweet Peas Stamp Set
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and punching ONE medium and THREE small flowers using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Flowering Zinnias Designer Series Paper**
 - 1-3/4 x 4"
 - 2-1/2 x 3-1/2"
 - 1 x 3-3/4"
- **Basic Beige 3/8" Bordered Ribbon**
 - about 10"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Basic Beige card using your Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Cute Crochet 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the splatter image from the Irresistible Blooms Stamp Set on the scalloped tag using Basic Beige ink. Stamp the sentiment on the banner using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Adhere the tag to the card followed by the banner using liquid glue.
4. Stamp the Petal Pink flowers using Petal Pink ink and a stamp of your choice from the Of Art and Texture Stamp Set. Shape the flowers using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat.
5. Stamp the leaf and peapod images on white cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Fussy cut.
6. Adhere the pea, flowers and leaves using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Make a bow using the beige ribbon and adhere it to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
8. Embellish with Transparent Adhesive-Backed Dots.

Measurements

- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the second largest dotted square using the Stylish Shapes Dies
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting TWO single peas, the peapod, ONE leaf and ONE sprout using the Sweet Peas Stamp Set
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and punching ONE small flower using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Flowering Zinnias Designer Series Paper**
 - 1 x 3-3/4"
 - 2 x 3-3/4"
 - 1 x 2" with chicken lips
- **Basic Beige 3/8" Bordered Ribbon**
 - about 10"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Basic Beige card using your Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Cute Crochet 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the Granny Apple Green and Petal Pink designer papers to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the splatter image from the Irresistible Blooms Stamp Set on the square using Basic Beige ink. Stamp the sentiment in the lower left corner using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Adhere the square, followed by the Lemon Lime Twist designer paper to the card front using liquid glue.
4. Stamp the Petal Pink flowers using Petal Pink ink and a stamp of your choice from the Of Art and Texture Stamp Set. Shape the flowers using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat.
5. Stamp the leaves, peas and peapod images on the white cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Fussy cut.
6. Adhere the peas, peapod, flowers and leaves using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Make a bow using the beige ribbon and adhere it to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
8. Embellish with Transparent Adhesive-Backed Dots.

Measurements

- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the second largest stitched banner using the Nested Essentials Dies
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting THREEE peas and ONE large leaf using the Sweet Peas Stamp Set
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and punching out ONE medium flower and ONE small flower using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Flowering Zinnias Designer Series Paper**
 - 1 x 3-3/4"
 - 2 x 3-3/4"
 - Lemon Lime Twist: 1 x 2" with chicken lips on the bottom
- **Basic Beige 3/8" Bordered Ribbon**
 - about 10"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Basic Beige card using your Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Cute Crochet 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the Granny Apple Green and Petal Pink designer papers to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the splatter image from the Irresistible Blooms Stamp Set on the stitched banner using Basic Beige ink. Stamp the sentiment using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Adhere the greeting banner, followed by the Lemon Lime Twist designer paper to the card using liquid glue.
4. Stamp the Petal Pink flowers using Petal Pink ink and a stamp of your choice from the Of Art and Texture Stamp Set. Shape the flowers using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat.
5. On the white cardstock, stamp the leaf and peas using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Fussy cut.
6. Adhere the flowers, peas and leaves using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Make a bow using the beige ribbon and adhere it to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
8. Embellish with Transparent Adhesive-Backed Dots.

Measurements

- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 1 x 9/16 x 2-3/8" postage stamp using the Perennial Postage Dies
 - 1/2 x 3-3/4"
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the peapod, ONE leaf and ONE sprout using the Sweet Peas Stamp Set
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and punching THREE small flowers using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Flowering Zinnias Designer Series Paper**
 - THREE patterns each 2 x 2-1/4"
- **Basic Beige 3/8" Bordered Ribbon**
 - about 10"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Basic Beige card using your Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Cute Crochet 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the splatter image from the Irresistible Blooms Stamp Set on the postage stamp using Basic Beige ink. Stamp the sentiment on the 1/2" strip of white cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Adhere the postage stamp to the card front followed by the greeting using liquid glue.
4. Stamp the Petal Pink flowers using Petal Pink ink and a stamp of your choice from the Of Art and Texture Stamp Set. Shape the flowers using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat.
5. Stamp the leaves and peapod images on the white cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Fussy cut.
6. Adhere the peapod, heart, flowers and leaves using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Make a bow using the beige ribbon and adhere it to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
8. Embellish with Transparent Adhesive-Backed Dots.
