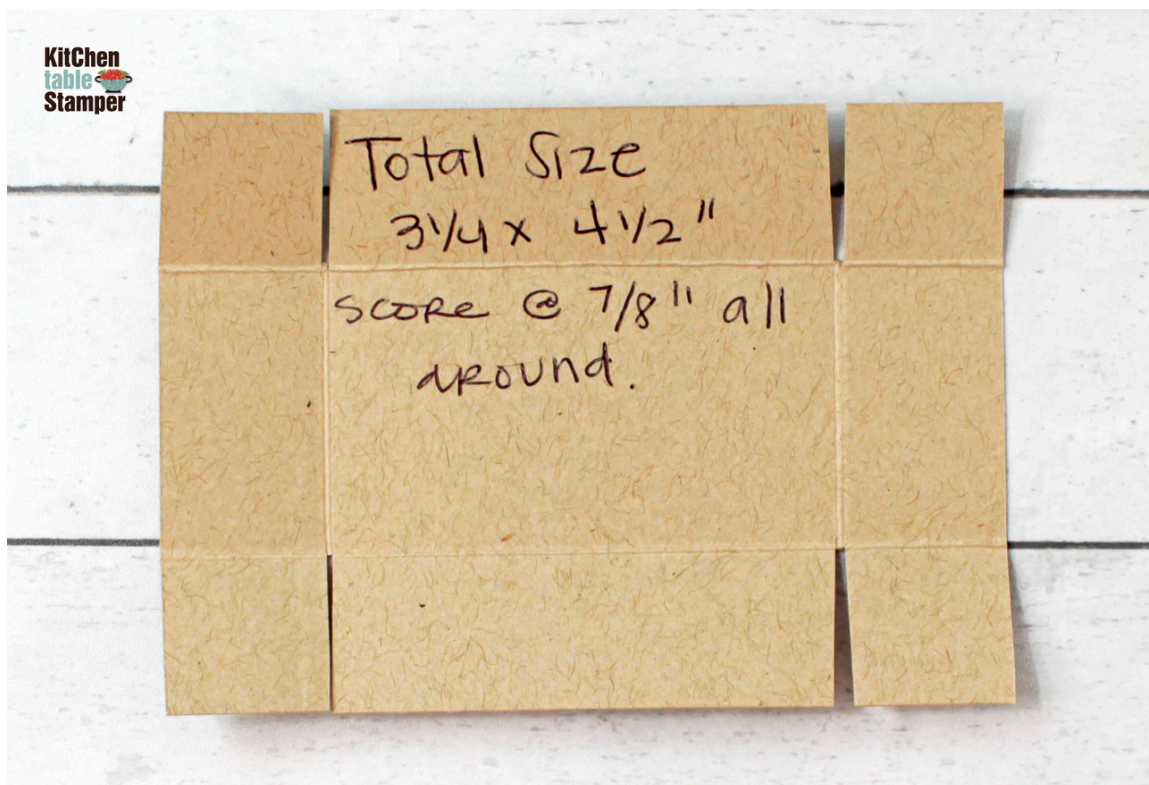

## Measurements

- **Thick Basic White Cardstock**
  - 3-1/4 x 4-1/2", scored at 7/8" on all four sides
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting TWO wagons, FOUR tires, the handle, the flowers and THREE banners using the Filled with Fun Bundle
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting TWO of the wooden wagon railing using the Filled with Fun Dies
- **Baker's Twine THREE Color Pack - Balmy Blue**
  - TWO about 8"

## Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Thick Basic White cardstock then trim according to the template photo above. Assemble the box with the tabs outside. I know that this sounds backwards, but the wagon images will hide the tabs. No tabs will show inside the box or outside the box.
2. Stamp the wagon using Azure Afternoon ink, the wheels and handle using Night of Navy ink, the banners using Bubble Bath, Lemon Lime Twist and Berry Burst inks and the flowers using Tuxedo Black Memento ink on scraps of Basic White cardstock. Color the flowers using Stampin' Blends, then die cut all the images.
3. Adhere the wooden railings to the wagons. Adhere the handle to the back of one of the wagons then glue one wagon to each side of the treat box. Glue two wheels on each side of the treat box. Set aside and let the glue dry for a little bit.
4. Choose one of the banners to be the base layer. Cut the other two banners apart to liberate the flags. Glue the single flags to the base layer to create an alternating color pattern. Pop the banner on the wagon using Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Make TWO small bows using the Balmy Blue Baker's Twine then adhere them at each end of the banner using liquid glue.
6. Embellish using Basic Gray and Smoky Slate Pearls.
