Measurements

- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Pumpkin Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the second smallest radiating stitched circle using the Spotlight on Nature Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the smallest label using the Something Fancy Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the carrot using the Market Goodness Bundle
- **To Market Designer Series Paper**
 - 2-3/4 x 3-3/4"
 - scrap for die cutting the largest stitched banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 8"

Instructions

1. Score the Pecan Pie card base and burnish with a Bone Folder.
2. Emboss the front of the card using the Timber 3D Embossing Folder. Lightly ink the embossed image using the White Craft Stampin' Ink Pad. Allow time to dry, then adhere the designer paper pieces using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the white label using Pecan Pie ink.
4. Adhere the Pumpkin Pie circle and the sentiment label to card using liquid glue.
5. Stamp the carrots on a scrap of white cardstock using Pumpkin Pie and Garden Green ink. Die cut, then pop the carrots on the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Tie a tiny bow with the Linen Thread then glue it on the carrots with a tiny drop of liquid glue.
7. Embellish with Transparent Adhesive-Backed Dots.
