- Autumn Leaves Stamp Set - 162179
- Autumn Leaves Dies - 162185
- Pecan Pie Cardstock - 161717
- Very Vanilla Cardstock - 101650
- Early Espresso Stampin' Pad - 147114
- Cajun Craze Stampin' Pad - 147085
- Crushed Curry Stampin' Pad - 147087
- Cherry Cobbler Stampin' Pad - 147083
- Pecan Pie 3/8" Center Stripe Ribbon - 162744
- Adhesive-Backed Textured Dots - 163338
- Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine - 149653
- Simply Scored Scoring Tool - 122334
- Paper Trimmer - 152392
- Paper Snips Scissors - 103579
- Bone Folder - 102300
- Take Your Pick - 144107
- Tear & Tape Adhesive - 154031

Measurements

- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
 - 4 x 5-1/4"
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the leaves using the Autumn Leaves Bundle
 - scrap for die cutting the rectangle label using the Autumn Leaves Dies
- **Pecan Pie Center Stripe Ribbon**
 - about 11"

Instructions

1. Score and fold the Pecan Pie card base. Burnish with a Bone folder.
2. Stamp the leaves on the Very Vanilla panel in your choice of color. First stamp three leaves in second generation ink, stamp off on scratch paper first, then stamp three more leaves in full strength ink. Stamp the vanes on the leaves with full strength Early Espresso ink.
3. Adhere the stamped vanilla panel to the card base using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp four leaves, two of each shape, in the colors of your choice. Stamp the vanes on the leaves in Early Espresso. Die cut the leaves.
5. Stamp the greeting on rectangle label using the same ink.
6. Glue the leaves to the back of the sentiment label. Set aside to dry a little bit.
7. Fold the Pecan Pie stripe ribbon in half and add a strip of Tear & Tape Adhesive to the back of the folded ribbon. Adhere the ribbon to the card.
8. Pop the leafy sentiment piece up on Stampin' Dimensionals and then adhere it to the card.
9. Embellish with Textured Adhesive Backed Dots.
