You are welcome to make just one of each of these cards, but they are a one sheet wonder style Stamp a Stack. If you are making the Filled with Cheer Stamp a Stack as designed, choose THREE designer papers and cut one according to Wonder Recipe #14, one according to Wonder Recipe #32 and the last one according to Wonder Recipe #33. The Wonder Recipes makes TWO of the first THREE designs and ONE of the last design.

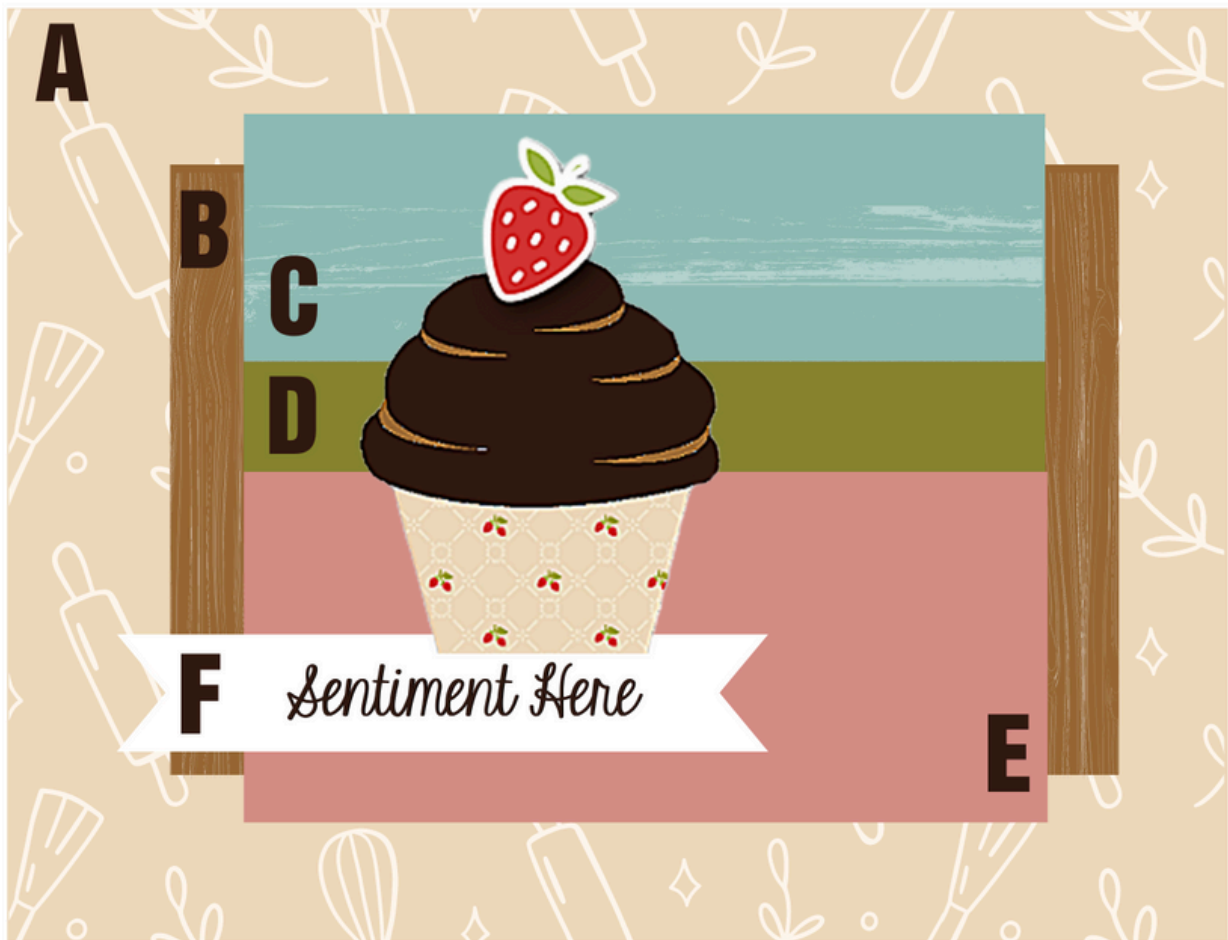

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A Warm Hello Card Sketch #8



Measurements

- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a wagon, TWO tires, the handle, string of lights and a heart using the Filled with Cheer Stamp Set and the Filled with Fun Bundle
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the snowman using the Filled with Cheer Stamp Set
 - scrap for die cutting the smallest postage rectangle using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Mossy Meadow Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the wooden wagon railing using the Filled with Fun Dies
- **Iconic Celebrations Designer Series Paper**
 - 1-1/2x 4"
 - 2 X 4"
 - 1/2 x 4"
- **Linen Thread**
 - TWO about 8"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Crumb Cake card base. Emboss the card front using the Dashing Designs 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Cut the Meadow Moss wooden rails down the middle to separate. Adhere designer paper to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Leave a little room at the top and bottom edges so you can slide the wooden rail die cut under the designer paper. Adhere the decorative wooden die cut piece to the card using the same adhesive.
3. Stamp the wagon, tires, string of lights, and snowman on a scrap of Basic White using Tuxedo Black ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Stamp the heart using Cherry Cobbler ink. Stamp the handle using Pebble Path ink. Die cut or fussy cut.
4. Stamp the sentiment on the postage label using Pecan Pie ink.
5. Adhere the snowman image and the handle to the back of the wagon, then to the card front using liquid glue. Adhere the sentiment to the card front using the same adhesive. Adhere the string of lights to the wagon, followed by the heart and the tires using Stampin' Dimensionals or Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Using Linen Thread, make TWO small bows and adhere them to the ends of the string of lights using liquid glue.
7. Embellish using Pecan Pie & Clear Ribbonded Adhesive-Backed Dots.





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A Warm Hello



Measurements

- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a wagon, TWO tires, the handle, the string of lights and a heart using the Filled with Cheer Stamp Set and the Filled with Fun Bundle
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the snowman using the Filled with Cheer Stamp Set
 - scrap for die cutting the label using the Unbounded Love Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting FOUR wooden wagon railing using the Filled with Fun Dies
- **Iconic Celebrations Designer Series Paper**
 - 3 X 4"
 - 1-1/2 x 4"
 - 1/2 x 4"
- **Linen Thread**
 - TWO about 8"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Crumb Cake card base. Emboss the card front using the Dashing Designs 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Cut one of the Pecan Pie wooden rails down the middle to separate. Adhere the to the other THREE whole wooden rails to the card front using liquid glue. Once you have the vertical parts of your fence how you like it, then trim the separated rails and adhere them to the card making the horizontal boards of the fence.
4. Stamp the string of lights and the snowman on a scrap of Basic White using Tuxedo Black ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Stamp the heart using Cherry Cobbler ink. Stamp the handle using Pebble Path ink. Die cut or fussy cut.
5. Stamp the sentiment on the left side of the label using Pecan Pie ink. Glue the label on to the card, then trim the excess off of the right side.
6. Adhere the snowman image, the string of lights to the fence, the heart and the tires using Stampin' Dimensionals or Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Using the Linen Thread, make TWO small bows and adhere them to the ends of the string of lights using liquid glue.
8. Embellish using Pecan Pie & Clear Ribboned Adhesive-Backed Dots.





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Sending Cheer



Measurements

- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a wagon, TWO tires, the handle, the string of lights and a heart using the Filled with Cheer Stamp Set and the Filled with Fun Bundle
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the presents using the Filled with Cheer Stamp Set
 - scrap for die cutting the long thin banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
- **Cherry Cobbler Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the wooden wagon railing using the Filled with Fun Dies
- **Mossy Meadow Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the wooden wagon railing using the Filled with Fun Dies
- **Iconic Celebrations Designer Series Paper**
 - THREE 1 X 4" pieces
- **Linen Thread**
 - TWO about 8"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Crumb Cake card base. Emboss the card front using the Dashing Designs 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Cut the Meadow Moss and Cherry Cobbler wooden rails down the middle to separate. Adhere designer paper to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Leave a little room at the right and left edges so you can slide the wooden rail die cut under the designer paper. Adhere the decorative wooden die cut piece to the card using the same adhesive.
3. Stamp the wagon, tires, string of lights and the presents on a scrap of Basic White using Tuxedo Black ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Stamp the heart using Cherry Cobbler ink. Stamp the handle using Pebble Path ink. Die cut and fussy cut.
4. Stamp the sentiment on the right side of the long, thin banner using Pecan Pie ink. Glue the banner on to the card, then trim the excess off of the left side.
5. Adhere the presents and the handle to the back of the wagon, then to the card using liquid glue, followed by the heart, string of lights, and the tires using Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Using the Linen Thread, make TWO small bows and adhere them to the ends of the string of lights using liquid glue.
7. Embellish using Pecan Pie & Clear Ribboned Adhesive-Backed Dots.





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Loads of Christmas Cheer



Measurements

- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a wagon, TWO tires, the handle, the string of lights and a heart using the Filled with Cheer Stamp Set and the Filled with Fun Bundle
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the presents using the Filled with Cheer Stamp Set
 - scrap for die cutting the long and thin banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
- **Iconic Celebrations Designer Series Paper**
 - THREE 2 x 2" pieces
- **Linen Thread**
 - TWO about 8"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Crumb Cake Card base. Emboss the card front using the Dashing Designs 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the wagon, tires, string of lights and the presents on a scrap of Basic White using Tuxedo Black ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Stamp the heart using Cherry Cobbler ink. Stamp the handle using Pebble Path ink. Die cut and fussy cut.
4. Adhere the presents and the handle to the back of the wagon, then to the card front using liquid glue.
5. Stamp the sentiment on the right side of the long, thin banner using Pecan Pie ink. Glue the banner on to the card, then trim the excess off of the left side.
6. Pop the heart, string of lights and the tires on the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Using the Linen Thread, make TWO small bows and adhere them to the ends of the string of lights using liquid glue.
8. Embellish using Pecan Pie & Clear Ribboned Adhesive-Backed Dots.
