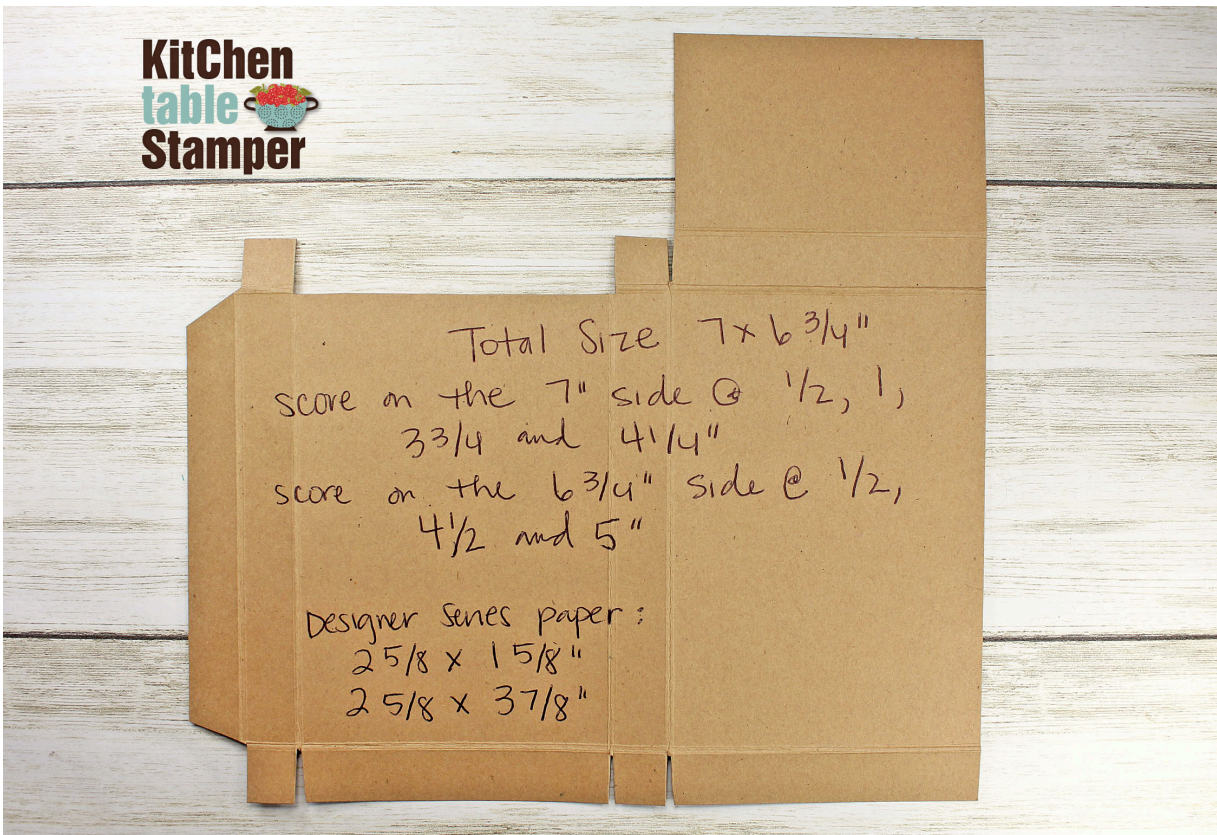

Measurements

- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - 7 x 6-3/4", scored at:
 - 7" side at 1/2, 1, 3-3/4, and 4-1/4"
 - Rotate quarter turn to the right and score on the 6-3/4" side at 1/2, 4-1/2 and 5"
 - scrap for die cutting the tag using the Greetings of the Seasons Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap to stamp and die cut the cup, whip cream, donut, two hearts and straw using the More Than Autumn Bundle
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the little tag using the Mini Envelope Pocket Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 2" deckled circle using the Deckled Circle Dies
- **Designer Series Paper**
 - 2-5/8 x 1-5/8"
 - 2-5/8 x 3-7/8"
 - scrap to punch a 2" circle
- **Pecan Pie Center Stripe Ribbon**
 - about 12"
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 10"



Instructions

1. Score, burnish with a Bone Folder, and trim the treat box according to the template photo and measurements above.
2. Adhere the larger piece of designer series paper to the front of the box. Round the bottom corners of the smaller designer series paper and the flap, then adhere the designer paper to the flap. Cut a notch with a 2" circle punch then assemble the box using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
3. Fill the box with your favorite Kit Kat flavor. I used these [chocolate donut flavor](#).
4. Pop the Early Espresso tag on to the box with dimensionals being careful not to glue the flap. The tag makes a tuck tab and holds the box closed.
5. Tread the Pecan Pie Stripe Ribbon through the Early Espresso tag and tie a big loopy bow.
6. Stamp the cup, whip cream, straw, donut and hearts on Basic White Cardstock using Memento ink. Color with Stampin' Blends and die cut. Stamp the sentiment on the little tag using Early Espresso ink.
7. Adhere the designer paper circle to the Pecan Pie deckled circle using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the circles to the box using dimensionals.
8. Assemble the coffee cup using liquid glue. Adhere the assembled cup, donut and one of the hearts using dimensionals. Adhere the second heart to the circle using a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Thread the tiny tag with Linen Thread then thread the Linen Thread though the hole in the Early Espresso tag. Tie a second loopy bow to secure the tag. Pop a Mini Stampin' Dimensional on the back of the tag to further secure the tag in place.
