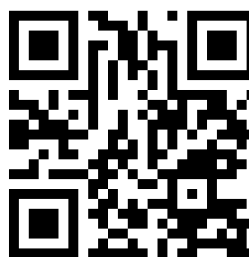

## Details for this sketch:

- A: 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- B: 3/8 x 4-3/4"
- C: 7/8 x 5-1/4"
- D: 3/8 x 4-3/4"
- E: Any shape of your choice

The flowers represent a focal image of your choice.

## You are Amazing Card Sketch #9



### Measurements

- **Basic Gray Cardstock or Pecan Pie Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Hybrid Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - Hybrid Leaves are the three main leaves that the folder will cut and emboss.
  - stamp and die cut TWO of the largest leaf and one of the maple shape leaf using the Changing Leaves Bundle
- **Embossed and Fussy Cut Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - These are the leaves that are left in the scrap after you cut and emboss save those scraps and cut these leaves with scissors.
  - fussy cut one of the long pointy leaf using the Changing Leaves Hybrid Embossing Folder and Paper Snips
- **Die Cut Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - These are the leaves that are made with the dies only.
  - die cut the skeleton leaf using the Changing Leaves Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the larger oblong label using the Changing Leaves Dies
- **Designer Series Paper**
  - TWO - 3/8 x 4-3/4"
  - 7/8 x 5-1/4"
- **Silver & White 3/8" Sheer Ribbon**
  - about 12"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base using a Bone Folder. Emboss the front of the card base using the Changing Leaves Hybrid Embossing Folder without the leaf die.
2. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to rough up the edges and curl the corners of the card front and the designer paper .
3. Use a blending brush to ink the embossed leaves and the roughed up edges of the card front. While you're at it, also blend ink on the edges of the designer paper. If your doing the Basic Gray card, blend with Memento ink. If you are doing the Pecan Pie card, blend with Pecan Pie ink.
4. Adhere the designer paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
5. If you are doing the Pecan Pie card, color the ribbon using a Dark Petal Pink Stampin' Blend Marker. Allow the ribbon time to dry.
6. Adhere the leaves using Multipurpose liquid glue on the stems then, layer by layer, further secure using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Stamp the sentiment on the white oblong using either Gorgeous Grape or Cajun Craze ink.
8. Cut the ribbon in half so you have TWO 12" pieces of ribbon. Stack the ribbon up one piece on top of the other with the silver edges out, then make a big loopy double bow with it. Adhere the bow to the sentiment using a Mini Glue Dot then staple through the center of the bow twice using a Mini Stapler. Pop the sentiment on to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Embellish with Adhesive Backed Sparkle Gems.

## Couldn't Do It Without You



### Measurements

- **Basic Gray Cardstock or Pecan Pie Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Hybrid Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - Hybrid Leaves are the three main leaves that the folder will cut and emboss.
  - stamp and die cut the all three leaves using the Changing Leaves Bundle
- **Embossed and Fussy Cut Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - These are the leaves that are left in the scrap after you cut and emboss save those scraps and cut these leaves with scissors.
  - fussy cut two embossed leaves using the Changing Leaves Hybrid Embossing Folder and Paper Snips
- **Die Cut Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - These are the leaves that are made with the dies only.
  - die cut one of the small three leaf sprig using the Changing Leaves Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the stitched circle for the sentiment using the Changing Leaves Dies
- **Designer Series Paper**
  - 3/8 x 3-3/4"
  - 1/2 x 3-1/4"
- **Silver & White 3/8" Sheer Ribbon**
  - about 12"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base using a Bone Folder. Emboss the front of the card base using the Changing Leaves Hybrid Embossing Folder without the leaf die. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to rough up the edges and curl the corners of the card front and the designer paper .
2. Use a blending brush to ink the embossed leaves and the roughed up edges of the card front. While you're at it, also blend ink on the edges of the designer paper. If your doing the Basic Gray card, blend with Memento ink. If you are doing the Pecan Pie card, blend with Pecan Pie ink.
3. If you are doing the Pecan Pie card, color the ribbon using a Dark Petal Pink Stampin' Blend Marker. Allow the ribbon time to dry.
4. Adhere the colored die or fussy cut leaves to the card directly on top of the corresponding embossed leaf on the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the designer paper using the same adhesive.
5. Towards the bottom of the white circle, stamp the sentiment using either Gorgeous Grape or Cajun Craze ink.
6. Cut the ribbon in half so you have TWO 12" pieces of ribbon. Stack the ribbon up one piece on top of the other with the silver edges out, then make a big loopy double bow with it. Adhere the small three leaf sprig in the center of the bow with a Mini Glue Dot. Adhere the bow to the sentiment circle using another Mini Glue Dot then staple through the center of the bow twice using a Mini Stapler. Pop the sentiment on to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Embellish with Adhesive Backed Sparkle Gems.

## A Little Note



### Measurements

- **Basic Gray Cardstock or Pecan Pie Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
  - 3-3/4 x 5"
- **Hybrid Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - Hybrid Leaves are the three main leaves that the folder will cut and emboss.
  - stamp and die cut the all three leaves using the Changing Leaves Bundle
- **Die Cut Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - These are the leaves that are made with the dies only.
  - die cut the small three leaf sprig and the skeleton leaf using the Changing Leaves Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the larger oblong label using the Changing Leaves Dies
- **Designer Series Paper**
  - 3-3/4 x 5"
  - 3/8 x 4-1/4"
  - 1/2 x 4"
- **Silver & White 3/8" Sheer Ribbon**
  - about 12"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base using a Bone Folder. Emboss the 3-3/4 x 5" cardstock panel using the Changing Leaves Hybrid Embossing Folder without the leaf die. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to rough up the edges and curl the corners of the embossed piece and the designer paper .
2. Use a blending brush to ink the embossed leaves and the roughed up edges of the card front. While you're at it, also blend ink on the edges of the designer paper. If your doing the Basic Gray card, blend with Memento ink. If you are doing the Pecan Pie card, blend with Pecan Pie ink.
3. Adhere the 3-3/4 x 5" piece of designer paper to the card front followed by the embossed cardstock panel using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. If you are doing the Pecan Pie card, color the ribbon using a Dark Petal Pink Stampin' Blend Marker. Allow the ribbon time to dry.
5. Adhere the leaves using Multipurpose liquid glue on the stems then, layer by layer, further secure using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals. Reserve the small three leaf sprig, add this leaf after the sentiment.
6. Adhere the strips of designer paper using liquid glue.
7. Stamp the sentiment on the white oblong using either Gorgeous Grape or Cajun Craze ink.
8. Cut the ribbon in half so you have TWO 12" pieces of ribbon. Stack the ribbon up one piece on top of the other with the silver edges out, then make a big loopy double bow with it. Adhere the bow to the back of the sentiment using a Mini Glue Dot. Pop the sentiment on to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Tuck the small three leaf sprig behind the sentiment and secure it with a combination of Mini Glue Dot and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Embellish with Adhesive Backed Sparkle Gems.

## Large Clear Bag Card



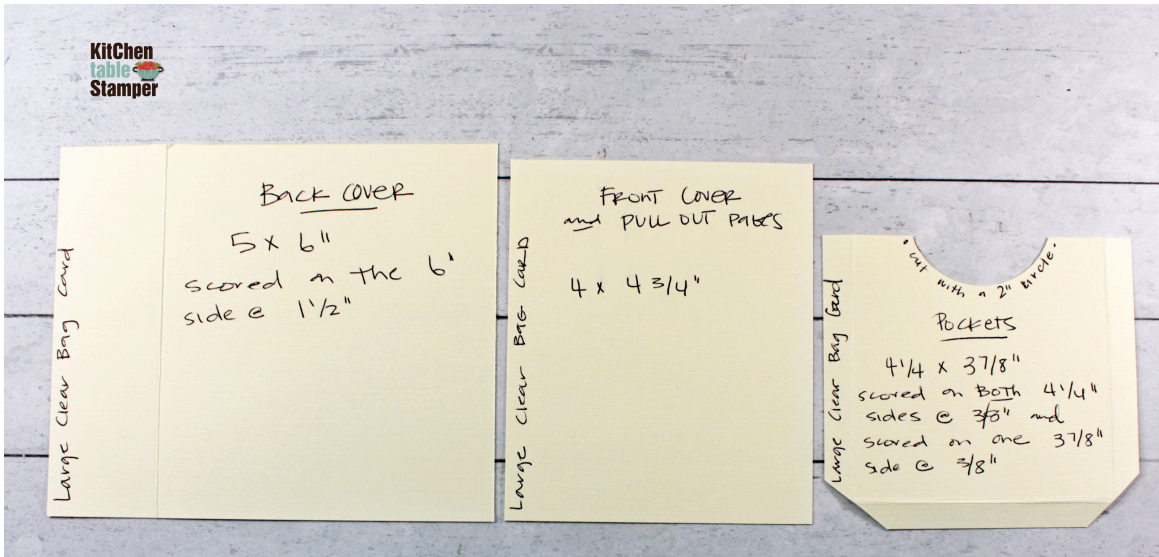
### Measurements

- **Basic Gray Cardstock**
  - THREE 4 x 4-3/4" - front cover and TWO pull out pockets
- **Designer Series Paper**
  - 5 X 6" scored on the 6" side at 1-1/2" - back cover
  - TWO 4-1/4 x 3-7/8", scored on BOTH 4-1/4" sides at 3/8" and scored on ONE 3-7/8" side at 3/8" - pockets
  - TWO 3-3/4 x 4-3/4" - inside panels
  - TWO 1 X 4-3/4" - inside panels
- **Hybrid Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - Hybrid Leaves are the three main leaves that the folder will cut and emboss.
  - stamp and die cut the largest leaf, TWO of the triple pointy leaf and THREE of the maple shape leaf using the Changing Leaves Bundle
- **Embossed and Fussy Cut Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - These are the leaves that are left in the scrap after you cut and emboss save those scraps and cut these leaves with scissors.
  - fussy cut one embossed leaf using the Changing Leaves Hybrid Embossing Folder and Paper Snips
- **Die Cut Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - These are the leaves that are made with the dies only.
  - cut TWO skeleton leaves and a small three leaf sprig using the Changing Leaves Bundle
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the larger oblong label using the Changing Leaves Dies
  - scrap for die cutting a 3-1/4 X 4-1/2" postage stamp using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Pumpkin Pie Cardstock**
  - scrap for punching or die cutting TWO tabs using the Keeping Tabs Punch or Dies
- **Silver & White 3/8" Sheer Ribbon**
  - about 12"

# Instructions

1. Prepare the inside pockets by burnishing and folding on the score lines and trimming according to the template photo below. Add Tear & Tape Adhesive on the sides and bottom. Do NOT remove the release paper on the pockets yet.
2. Emboss the THREE Basic Gray 4 x 4-3/4" panels using the Changing Leaves Hybrid Embossing Folder without the leaf die. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to rough up the edges and curl the corners of the panels.
3. Use a blending brush and Memento ink, blend ink on the edges of the embossed panels and all the pieces of designer paper.
4. Fold the large bag in half and burnish with a Bone Folder. Cut the bag on the open end so that it measures 4-1/4" from the fold. Place a strip of Tear & Tape to the inner right side of the fold. Remove the release paper. Close the bag. Reinforce the tape by stapling three times along the edge of the Tear & Tape.
5. Score, fold and burnish the designer paper for the back cover of the card using a Bone Folder. Place the Tear & Tape to the left and right of the score line, as well as, on the end of the short panel of the designer paper.
6. Insert the clear bag card inside the back cover piece securing with the Tear & Tape Adhesive. Fold the spine of the card about 1/4" to the front and then the back. Burnish with the Bone Folder. Add more Tear & Tape Adhesive to the back of the clear bag card and attach to the back cover.
7. Adhere one of the embossed Basic Gray panels to the front cover of the clear bag card using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
8. Adhere a pocket and Pumpkin Pie tab to each of the remaining embossed Basic Gray panels. Adhere the tab with Multipurpose Liquid Glue and adhere the pocket by releasing the Tear & Tape Adhesive that's already there. Staple the tabs using a Mini Attacher, if you desire.
9. Adhere the leaves to the front cover using Multipurpose liquid glue on the stems then, layer by layer, further secure using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Stamp the sentiment on the right side of the white oblong using Gorgeous Grape ink. Trim the left side using a Paper Trimmer.
11. Cut the ribbon in half so you have TWO 12" pieces of ribbon. Stack the ribbon up one piece on top of the other with the silver edges out, then make a big loopy double bow with it. Adhere the bow to the back of the sentiment using a Mini Glue Dot. Pop the sentiment on to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. On one of the 3-3/4 x 4-3/4" pieces of designer paper, adhere the white postage stamp horizontally using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Trim the right edge to line up with the designer paper. Adhere the 1" strip of designer paper to the right side of this piece. Adhere the other 1" strip to the left side of the matching piece of designer paper.
13. Stamp the sentiment on the white postage stamp piece using Gorgeous Grape ink. Adhere these panels to the inside of the clear bag card using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
14. Adhere the rest of the leaves on the inside of the card and the pockets as desired using liquid glue. Place the pockets in their sections of the card.
15. Embellish with Adhesive Backed Sparkle Gems.

## Small Clear Bag Card



### Measurements

- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
  - THREE 3 x 3-13/16" - front cover and TWO pull out pockets
- **Designer Series Paper**
  - 4-1/16 x 4-1/4" scored on the 4-1/4" side at 3/4" - back cover
  - TWO 3-1/2 x 3-3/8", scored on BOTH 3-1/2" sides at 3/8" and scored on ONE 3-3/8" side at 3/8" for the pockets
  - TWO 2-3/4 X 3-3/4" - inside panels
  - TWO 7/8 X 2-3/4" - inside panels
- **Hybrid Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - Hybrid Leaves are the three main leaves that the folder will cut and emboss.
  - stamp and die cut the largest leaf, TWO of the triple pointy leaf and the maple shape leaf using the Changing Leaves Bundle
- **Die Cut Leaves in Colors of Your Choice** - These are the leaves that are made with the dies only.
  - cut TWO skeleton leaves and TWO small three leaf sprig using the Changing Leaves Bundle
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the larger oblong label using the Changing Leaves Dies
  - scrap for die cutting a 2 X 2-3/4" postage stamp using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
  - scrap for punching or die cutting TWO tabs using the Keeping Tabs Punch or Dies
- **Silver & White 3/8" Sheer Ribbon**
  - about 12"

# Instructions

1. Prepare the inside pockets by burnishing and folding on the score lines and trimming according to the template photo below. Add Tear & Tape Adhesive on the sides and bottom. Do NOT remove the release paper on the pockets yet.
2. Color the ribbon using a Dark Petal Pink Stampin' Blend Marker. Allow the ribbon time to dry.
3. Emboss the THREE Pecan Pie 3 x 3-13/16" panels using the Changing Leaves Hybrid Embossing Folder without the leaf die. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to rough up the edges and curl the corners of the panels.
4. Use a blending brush and Pecan Pie ink, blend ink on the edges of the embossed panels and all the pieces of designer paper.
5. Fold the small bag in half and burnish with a Bone Folder. Cut the bag on the open end so that it measures 3-1/4" from the fold. Place a strip of Tear & Tape to the inner right side of the fold. Remove the release paper. Close the bag. Reinforce the tape by stapling three times along the edge of the Tear & Tape.
6. Score, fold and burnish the designer paper for the back cover of the card using a Bone Folder. Place the Tear & Tape to the left and right of the score line, as well as, on the end of the short panel of the designer paper.
7. Insert the clear bag card inside the back cover piece securing with the Tear & Tape Adhesive. Fold the spine of the card about 1/4" to the front and then the back. Burnish with the Bone Folder. Add more Tear & Tape Adhesive to the back of the clear bag card and attach to the back cover.
8. Adhere one of the embossed Pecan Pie panels to the front cover of the clear bag card using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
9. Adhere a pocket and Petal Pink tab to each of the remaining embossed Pecan Pie panels. Adhere the tab with Multipurpose Liquid Glue and adhere the pocket by releasing the Tear & Tape Adhesive that's already there. Staple the tabs using a Mini Attacher, if you desire.
10. Adhere the leaves to the front cover using Multipurpose liquid glue on the stems then, layer by layer, further secure using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. Stamp the sentiment on the right side of the white oblong using Cajun Craze ink. Trim the left side using a Paper Trimmer.
12. Cut the ribbon in half so you have TWO 12" pieces of ribbon. Stack the ribbon up one piece on top of the other with the silver edges out, then make a big loopy double bow with it. Adhere the bow to the sentiment using a Mini Glue Dot. Adhere the small leaf sprig to the ribbon using a Glue Dot. Staple through the ribbon twice if desired.
13. Pop the sentiment on to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
14. Adhere the 7/8 x 2-3/4" strips of designer series paper to the 2-3/4 x 3-3/4" inside panels then adhere them to the inside of the card.
15. Stamp the sentiment on the white postage stamp piece using Cajun Craze ink and embellish with some leaves. Staple through the rectangle to further secure the leaves if desired. Adhere the postage rectangle inside of the clear bag card using liquid glue.
16. Adhere the rest of the leaves on the pockets as desired using liquid glue. Place the pockets in their sections of the card.
17. Embellish with Adhesive Backed Sparkle Gems.
