Spa Tote

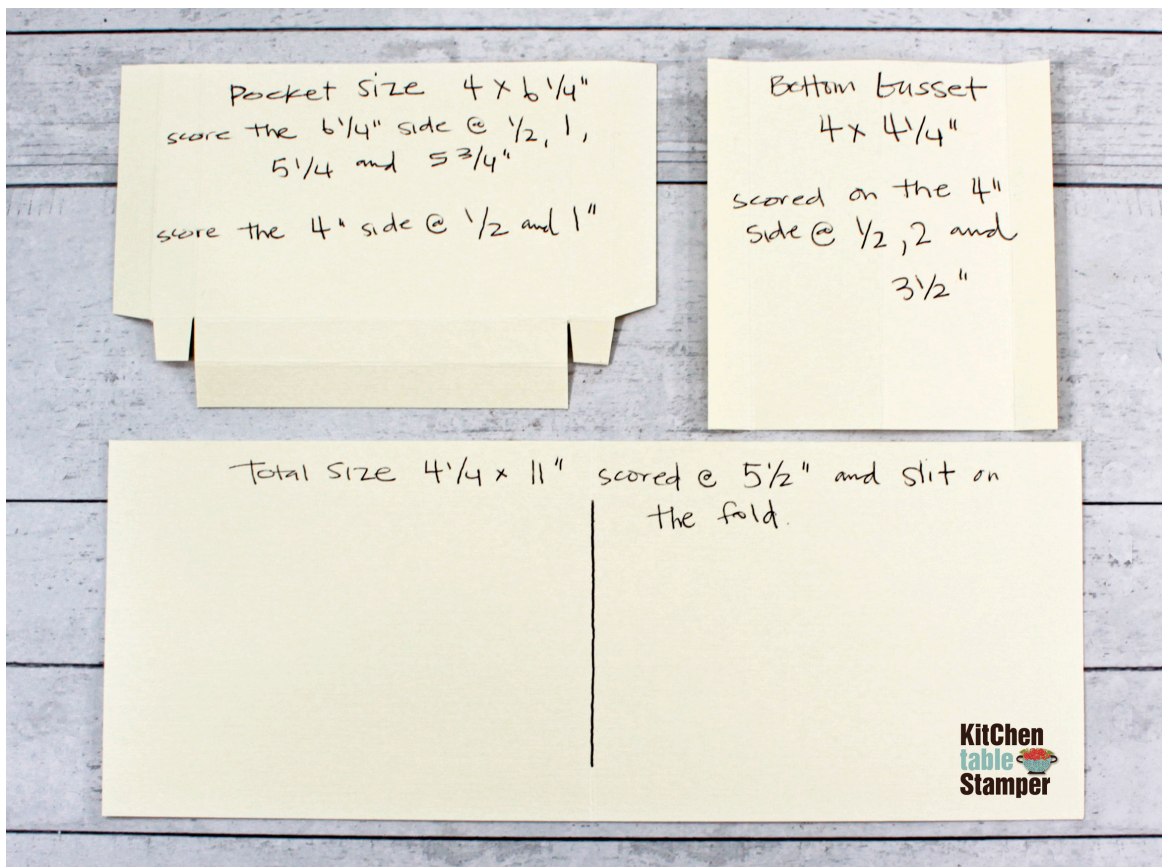

Measurements

- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - 4-1/4 x 11", scored at 5-1/2" on the 11" side
 - 4 x 4-1/4", scored at 1/2, 2 and 3-1/2" on the 4" side
 - 4 x 6-1/4"
 - scored on the 6-1/4" side at 1/2, 1, 5-1/4 and 5-3/4"
 - scored on the 4" side at 1/2 and 1"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO label frames using the Something Fancy Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting or punching TWO gingerbread, a tree, a candy cane and the gingerbread house using the bundles listed above
 - scrap for die cutting a hexagon tag using the Greetings of the Season Dies
- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a hexagon tag using the Greetings of the Season Dies
- **Sentimental Christmas Designer Series Paper**
 - 2 x 4"
 - 2-3/4 x 4"
- **Pretty in Pink Ribbon**
 - about 5"
 - about 9"



Instructions

1. Score, fold, burnish and trim the treat tote pieces according to the measurements using the template photo above for reference.
2. Die cut the handles of the tote using the largest and the smallest label from the Something Fancy Die Set. Tape the two dies together so that both cut outs will have exactly the same placement. Cut two matching label frames from Basic white cardstock. Glue the label frames back to back applying liquid glue to the top half of the frame. Leave the bottom half open, do not put adhesive on the bottom half of the handle. Add Tear & Tape Adhesive to the outside bottom of the handle on the front and the back.
3. Fold the 4-1/4 x 11" piece and dry fit the handle by laying it across the fold at the top approximately where you want the handle to be. Using a Frixion erasable pen, mark the right and left side of the handle on the card at the fold. These marks are your guide to cut a slit with the Paper Trimmer. Start your blade at one mark and stop at the other cutting along the fold.
4. Remove the Tear & Tape Adhesive from the front and back of the handle, then slide the handle into the slit. Burnish to help the adhesive take hold inside the card.
5. Adhere the designer paper to the front of the pocket. Assemble the pocket using Tear & Tape Adhesive. Wrap the shorter length of ribbon across the front of the pocket, around the sides and then tack it in the Tear & Tape Adhesive on the back tabs. Adhere the pocket to the front of the card using the same adhesive.
6. Fold the 4 x 4-1/4" easel support accordion style in a valley, mountain, then valley. Put Tear & Tape adhesive on the short ends, on both sides of the accordion, and then adhere inside the card to make a easel support. See the side view photo below.
7. Emboss the 4 x 5-1/4" Pecan Pie panel using the Country Blossoms Embossing Folder. Ink with Whisper White Craft ink brushing the ink pad directly on the paper. Adhere the embossed panel to the front of the tote inside the pocket.
8. Stamp TWO gingerbread men, a candy cane and gingerbread house using Memento Tuxedo Black ink then color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut and punch.
9. Stamp the tree using Garden Green ink. Die cut.
10. Cut the white hexagon tag in half and then cut a snowdrift freehand using paper snips. Glue the white snowdrift to the Pool Party tag creating a ground and sky scene. Stamp the sentiment in the upper left corner using Memento ink.
11. Pop the house, tree, candy cane and gingerbread guys on the tag using Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Thread the tag with the remaining piece of Pretty in Pink Ribbon and tie a big loopy bow. Adhere the tag to the pocket using more Stampin' Dimensionals.
13. Embellish with Lose Snowflake Embellishments using Multipurpose Liquid Glue to secure and the Take Your Pick Tool to place.
14. Add one Red & White Peppermint Embellishment to the gingerbread house.
