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## Rosette Ornament & Bag



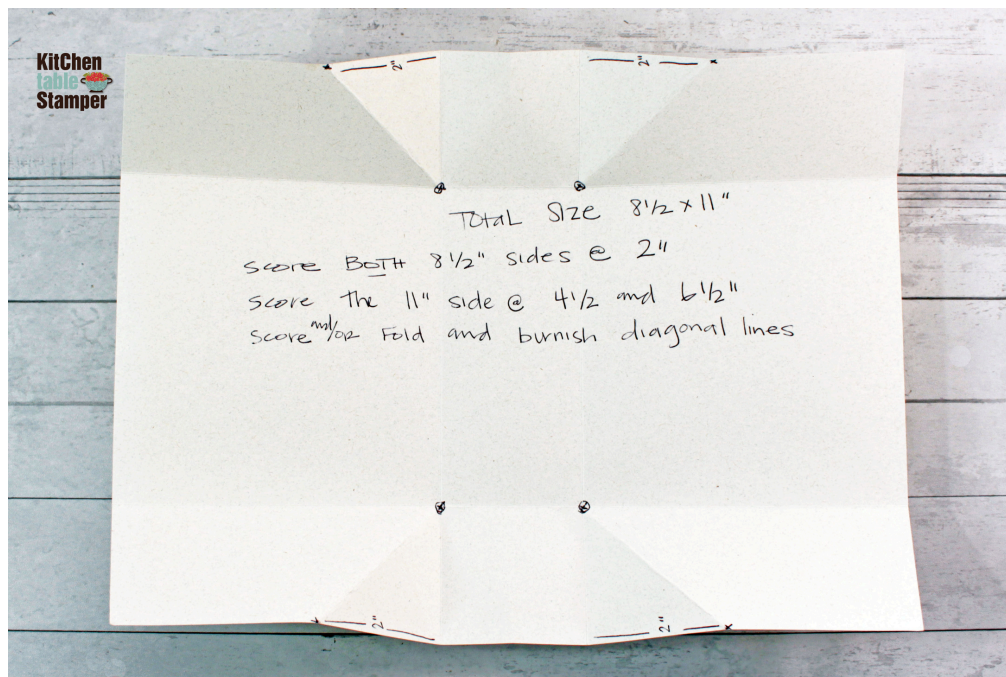

- One Of A Kind Bundle - 164078
- Round We Go Dies - 163729
- Merriest Trees Dies - 162047
- Sentimental Christmas 12" X 12" Designer Series Paper - 164209
- Shaded Spruce Cardstock - 146981
- Garden Green Cardstock - 102584
- Real Red Cardstock - 102482
- Berry Burst, Old Olive & White 12" X 12" Glimmer Specialty Paper - 163769
- Basic White Cardstock - 159276
- Shaded Spruce Stampin' Pad - 147088
- Shaded Spruce 1/2" Satin & Sheer Ribbon - 164224
- Gold Twisted Thread - 164603
- Real Red & White Adhesive-Backed Peppermints - 164050

# Measurements

- **Shaded Spruce Cardstock**
  - 8-1/2 x 11"
    - scored on both 8-1/2" sides at 2"
    - scored on the 11" side at 4-1/2 and 6-1/2"
  - scrap for die cutting TWO tags using the Merriest Trees Dies
  - scraps for die cutting TWO pinking edge circles an asterisk and one embossed detail circle using the Round We Go Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a 1-3/8" pierced circle using the Everyday Details Dies
- **Garden Green Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting TWO asterisks using the Round We Go Dies
- **Real Red Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting an asterisk using the Round We Go Dies
- **Sentimental Christmas Designer Series Paper**
  - TWO 4-1/4" squares
- **White Glimmer Paper**
  - scrap to die cut a snowflake using the One of a Kind Dies
- **Shaded Spruce Satin & Sheer Ribbon**
  - about 15"
- **Gold Braided Thread**
  - about 10"

# Instructions

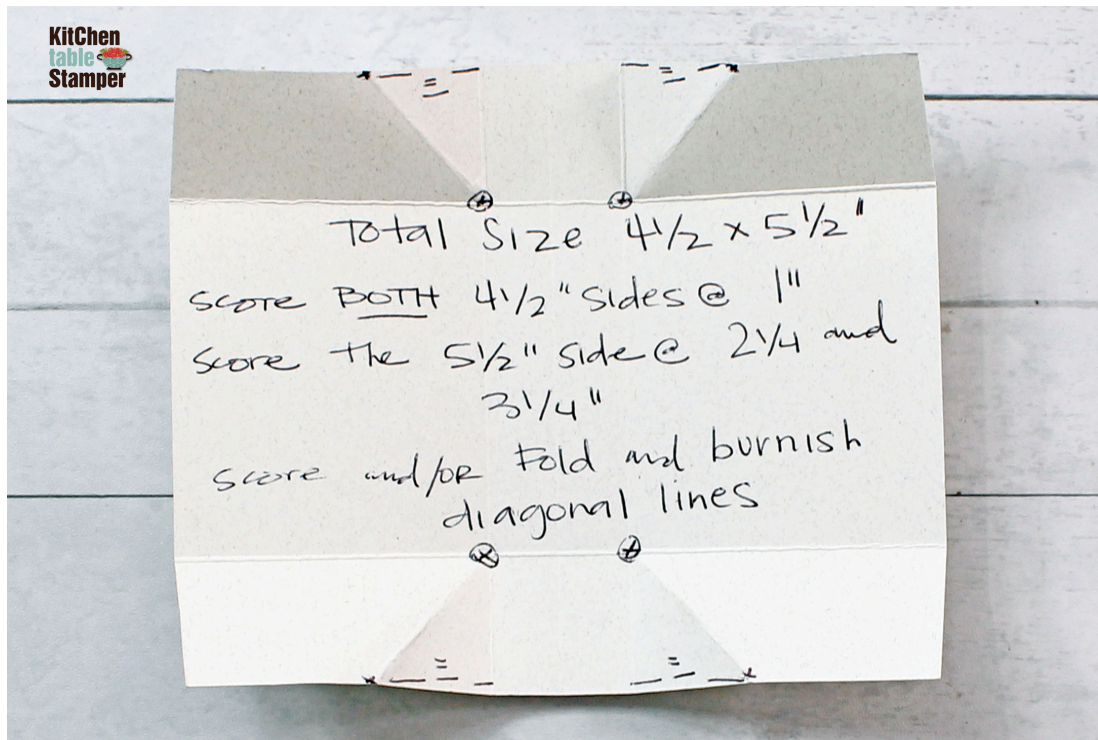
1. Score, fold and burnish the Shaded Spruce cardstock with a Bone Folder. Adhere the flaps inside and form the box.
2. Adhere the tags to the inside using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
3. Adhere the designer paper to the front and back of the box.
4. Fold the rosette die cuts accordion style then glue them together end to end. Form the rosette. Glue one of the pinking circles to each side to secure. TIP: Use liquid glue then put a large stamp block on to hold everything in place until it's dry and set.
5. Glue the Real Red and Garden Green asterisks together using liquid glue. Glue the second Garden Green and Shaded Spruce asterisks together with the same glue. Adhere one pair to each side of the rosette using Stampin Dimensionals.
6. Stamp the sentiment on the circle using Shaded Spruce ink than adhere it to the back side of the ornament using Liquid Glue.
7. Adhere the glimmer snowflake to the front of the ornament using liquid glue and embellish with a Red & White Peppermint.
8. Punch a 1/8" circle cunch in the top of the ornament, thread with gold thread and tie a thread knot.
9. Fill the box with treats, thread ribbon through the tags tuck the gold tread ornament hanger in the ribbon and then tie to close.
