



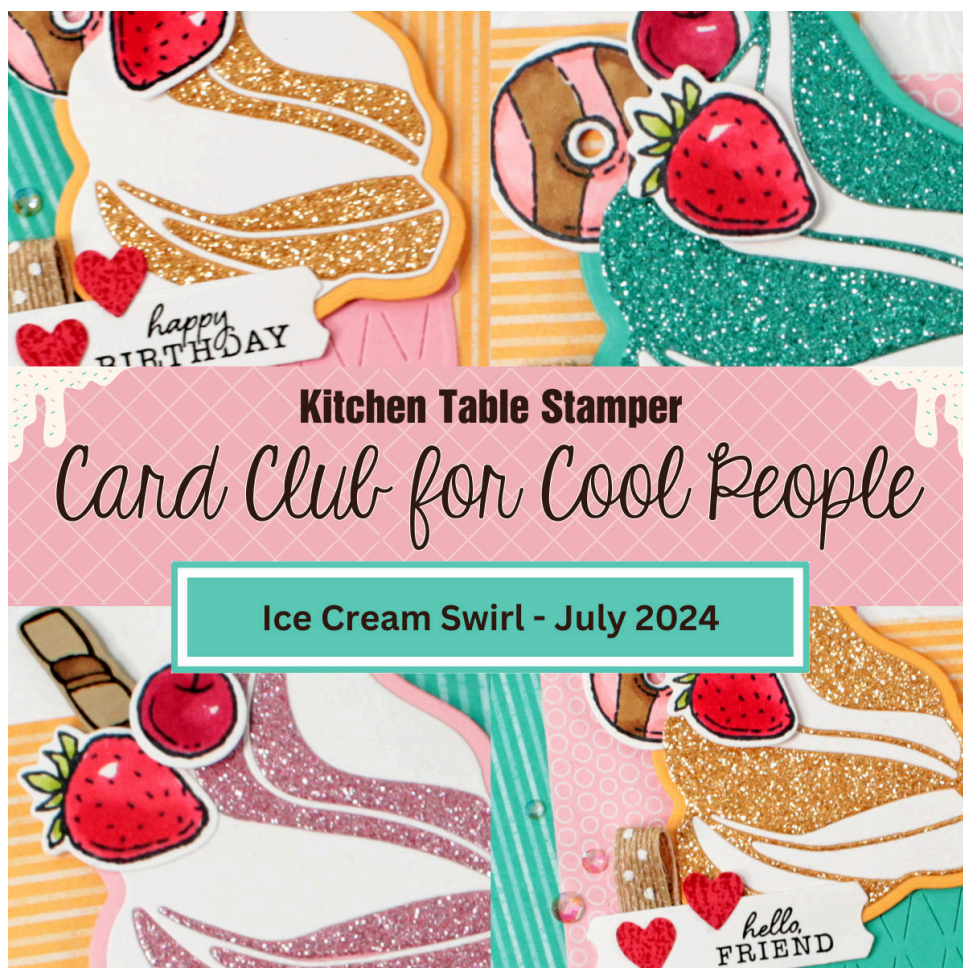

Card Sketch #7



Measurements

- **Thick Basic White Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 4 x 5-1/4"
 - scrap for stamping and/or die cutting the ice cream swirl, a donut and a strawberry using the Ice Cream Swirl Bundle
 - scrap for die cutting the ticket banner using the Unbounded Love Dies
- **Peach Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the ice cream base using the Ice Cream Swirl Dies
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the cookie using the Ice Cream Swirl Bundle
- **Sweet Sorbet Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching TWO small hearts using the Bee Builder Punch
- **Summer Splash Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the ice cream cone with texture using the Ice Cream Swirl Dies
- **In Color Glimmer Paper**
 - scrap for die cutting the ice cream swirl using the Ice Cream Swirl Dies
- **Polka Dot Trim**
 - about 1"

Measurements - Cont.

- **In Color Designer Series Paper**
 - THREE 1/2 x 5-1/4" strips, one of each color

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Thick Basic White card base. Emboss the 4 x 5-1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock using the Painted Texture Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the embossed panel to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the strips of designer paper using the same adhesive.
3. Adhere the gimmer paper ice cream swirl to the Peach Pie ice cream base using liquid glue. Reserve the negative pieces. We'll use them in the final card design.
4. Fill in the ice cream swirl spaces with the negative pieces from the Basic White ice cream swirl. Reserve the swirl. We'll use it in the final card design.
5. Stamp the donut, cookie and strawberry using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut. Adhere these images to the ice cream swirl using a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to trim the Summer Splash ice cream cone, making it a cup. Adhere the ice cream cup to the card using liquid glue, followed by the decorated ice cream swirl using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Stamp the sentiment from the Keeping Tabs Stamp Set on the white ticket banner using Early Espresso ink.
8. Cut an angle on the left side of the trim and adhere it to the ticket banner using Tear & Tape Adhesive. Then, adhere the ticket banner to the card with a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Stamp the textured image of your choice from the Of Art & Texture Stamp Set on the Sweet Sorbet hearts using Sweet Sorbet ink. Adhere to the card front using liquid glue.
10. Embellish with Iridescent Rhinestones Basic Jewels.

Measurements

- **Thick Basic White Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 4 x 5-1/4"
 - scrap for stamping and/or die cutting the ice cream swirl, a donut, cherry and a strawberry using the Ice Cream Swirl Bundle
 - scrap for die cutting the ticket banner using the Unbounded Love Dies
- **Pretty in Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the ice cream base using the Ice Cream Swirl Dies
- **Sweet Sorbet Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching TWO small hearts using the Bee Builder Punch
- **Peach Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the ice cream cone with texture using the Ice Cream Swirl Dies
- **In Color Glimmer Paper**
 - scrap for die cutting the ice cream swirl using the Ice Cream Swirl Dies
- **Polka Dot Trim**
 - about 3-1/2"

Measurements - Cont.

- **In Color Designer Series Paper**
 - 1-1/4 x 3"
 - 1-1/2 x 3"
 - 2-1/2 x 3"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Thick Basic White card base. Emboss the 4 x 5-1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock using the Painted Texture Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the embossed panel to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the designer paper using the same adhesive.
3. Adhere the gimmer paper ice cream swirl to the Pretty in Pink ice cream base using liquid glue. Reserve the negative pieces. We'll use them in the next card design.
4. Fill in the ice cream swirl spaces with the negative pieces from the Basic White ice cream swirl. Reserve the swirl. We'll use it in the next card design.
5. Stamp the donut, cherry and strawberry using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut. Adhere these images to the ice cream swirl using a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to trim the ice cream cone, making it a cup. Adhere the ice cream cup to the card front using liquid glue, followed by the decorated ice cream swirl using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Stamp the sentiment from the Keeping Tabs Stamp Set on the white ticket banner using Early Espresso ink.
8. Fold the trim in half and cut an angle on the ends of the trim. Adhere the ribbon to the ticket banner using Tear & Tape Adhesive. Then, adhere the ticket banner to the card with a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Stamp the textured image of your choice from the Of Art & Texture Stamp Set on the Sweet Sorbet hearts using Sweet Sorbet ink. Adhere to the card using liquid glue.
10. Embellish with Iridescent Rhinestones Basic Jewels.

Measurements

- **Thick Basic White Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 4 x 5-1/4"
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the cherry and a strawberry using the Ice Cream Swirl Bundle **plus** the reserved ice cream swirl pieces from the previous card
 - scrap for die cutting the flag banner using the Nested Essentials Dies
- **Pretty in Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the ice cream base using the Ice Cream Swirl Dies
- **Sweet Sorbet Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching ONE large heart and ONE small heart using the Bee Builder Punch
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and/or die cutting the ice cream cone with texture and cookie using the Ice Cream Swirl Bundle
- **In Color Glimmer Paper**
 - the reserved ice cream swirl pieces from the previous card
- **Polka Dot Trim**
 - about 3-1/2"
 - about 10"

Measurements - Cont.

- **In Color Designer Series Paper**
 - 1-1/2 x 3"
 - 2-1/2 x 3"
 - scrap for die cutting the wrapper using the Ice Cream Swirl Dies

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Thick Basic White card base. Emboss the 4 x 5-1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock using the Painted Texture Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the embossed panel to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the designer paper using the same adhesive.
3. Adhere the reserved Basic White ice cream swirl to the Pretty in Pink ice cream base using liquid glue.
4. Fill in the ice cream swirl spaces with the reserved negative pieces from the glimmer ice cream swirl.
5. Stamp the donut, cookie and strawberry using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut. Adhere these images to the ice cream swirl using a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Adhere the Pretty in Pink wrapper on the cone using liquid glue, then adhere the cone to the card using the same adhesive. Pop the decorated ice cream swirl on the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Stamp the sentiment from the Keeping Tabs Stamp Set on the white flag banner using Early Espresso ink. Punch a 1/8" circle in the end of the banner making it a tag.
8. Cut an angle on the right side of the polka dot trim, then adhere the trim to the card front with Tear & Tape Adhesive.
9. Stamp the textured image of your choice from the Of Art & Texture Stamp Set on the Sweet Sorbet hearts using Sweet Sorbet ink. Adhere to the card front using Mini Glue Dots for the large heart and liquid glue for the small heart.
10. Separate one strand off of the 10" trim. Thread the strand through the hole in the tag and make a bow. Adhere the tag to card using a Mini Glue Dot.
11. Embellish with Iridescent Rhinestones Basic Jewels.

Measurements

- **Thick Basic White Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 4 x 5-1/4"
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a donut and a strawberry using the Ice Cream Swirl Bundle **plus** the reserved ice cream swirl piece from the first card
 - scrap for die cutting the ticket banner using the Unbounded Love Dies
- **Peach Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the ice cream base using the Ice Cream Swirl Dies
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the cookie using the Ice Cream Swirl Dies
- **Sweet Sorbet Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching TWO small hearts using the Bee Builder Punch
- **Pretty in Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the ice cream cone with texture using the Ice Cream Swirl Dies
- **In Color Glimmer Paper**
 - the reserved ice cream swirl pieces from the first card
- **Polka Dot Trim**
 - about 3-1/2"

Measurements - Cont.

- **In Color Designer Series Paper**
 - 1-3/4 x 3" piece
 - 1-1/2 x 3" piece
 - 1-1/2 x 3" piece

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Thick Basic White card base. Emboss the 4 x 5-1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock using the Painted Texture Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the embossed panel to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the designer paper using the same adhesive.
3. Adhere the reserved Basic White ice cream swirl to the Peach Pie ice cream base using liquid glue.
4. Fill in the ice cream swirl spaces with the reserved negative pieces from the glimmer ice cream swirl.
5. Stamp the donut, cookie and strawberry using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut. Adhere these images to the ice cream swirl using a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to trim the Pretty in Pink ice cream cone, making it a cup. Adhere the ice cream cup to the card using liquid glue, followed by the decorated ice cream swirl using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Stamp the sentiment from the Keeping Tabs Stamp Set on the white ticket banner using Early Espresso ink.
8. Fold the trim in half and cut an angle on the ends of the trim. Adhere the ribbon to the ticket banner using Tear & Tape Adhesive. Then, adhere the banner to the card with a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Stamp the textured image of your choice from the Of Art & Texture Stamp Set on the Sweet Sorbet hearts using Sweet Sorbet ink. Adhere to the card front using liquid glue.
10. Embellish with Iridescent Rhinestones Basic Jewels.
