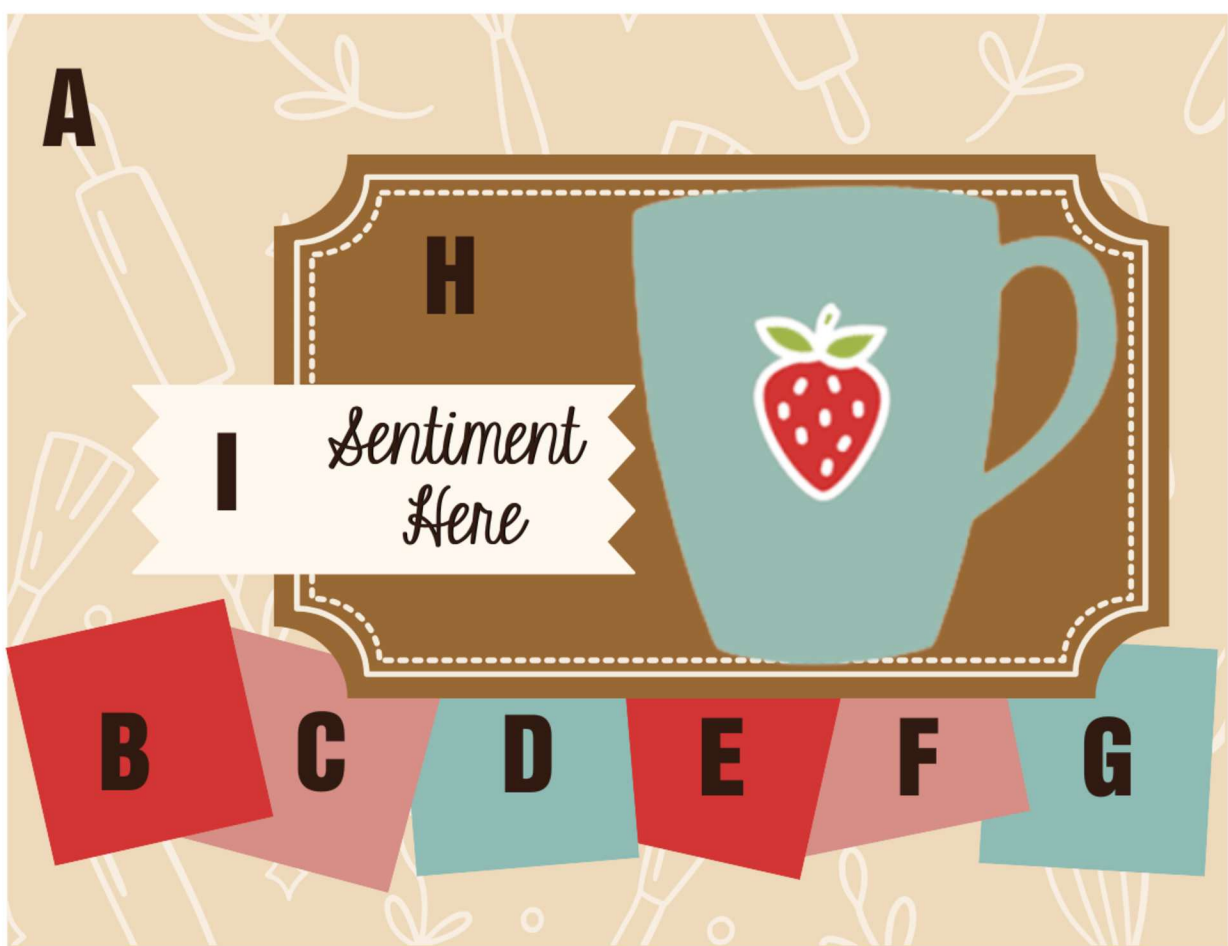

### *Cool People Exclusive Card Sketch #14*



### *Measurements*

- **Lost Lagoon Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
  - scrap for stamping and punching or fussy cutting the the mushrooms and ground using the Terrific Toadstool Bundle
  - scrap for die cutting the small ragged rectangle banner using the Grow With Love Dies
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the large rectangle label using the Grow With Love Dies
- **Calypso Coral Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a flower using the Heart Shaped Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting leaves using the Heart Shaped Dies
- **Timeless Plaid Designer Series Paper**
  - SIX - 1 x 1"
- **Linen Thread**
  - about 12"
- **Pretty Peacock & Gold Metallic Ribbon**
  - about 5"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Lost Lagoon card base. Emboss the card front using the Plaster Painting 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Stamp the text element on the large rectangle label using Crumb Cake ink.
3. Adhere the designer paper, followed by the large rectangle label using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the sentiment on the right side of the vanilla label using Pretty Peacock ink.
5. On a scrap of Very Vanilla cardstock, stamp the smaller mushroom top using Cajun Craze ink, stamp the smaller stem using Early Espresso ink and stamp the larger mushroom top using Pretty Peacock ink. Punch. On the same scrap of vanilla cardstock, stamp the larger mushroom stem using Early Espresso ink and stamp the ground using Old Olive ink. Fussy cut.
6. Assemble the mushrooms using liquid glue. A fine tip squeeze bottle and Silicone Craft Sheet makes this easy and tidy. Apply Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the mushrooms.
7. Adhere the ground and the sentiment to the card using liquid glue. Adhere the assembled mushrooms to the card.
8. Fold the ribbon in half, tie a big loopy bow with the Linen Thread and adhere it to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Shape the flower and adhere the leaves using Mini Glue Dots. Adhere the flower to the ribbon and twine loop using more glue dots.
10. Embellish using the Iridescent Foil Gems.

## Poppin' Up to Say Hi



### Measurements

- **Lost Lagoon Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
  - scrap for stamping and punching or fussy cutting the mushrooms and ground using the Terrific Toadstool Bundle
  - scrap for die cutting the larger ragged rectangle banner using the Grow With Love Dies
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the wonky circle using the Around It All Dies
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a flower using the Heart Shaped Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting leaves using the Heart Shaped Dies
- **Timeless Plaid Designer Series Paper** - varies by card use the Wonder Recipe pieces as is or trim if desired
  - 1-1/4 x 4"
  - 1 x 4"
- **Linen Thread**
  - about 12"
- **Pretty Peacock and Gold Metallic Ribbon**
  - about 5"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Lost Lagoon card base. Emboss the card front using the Plaster Painting 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Stamp the text element on the wonky circle using Crumb Cake ink.
3. Adhere the designer paper, followed by the wonky circle using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the sentiment on the right side of the vanilla label using Pretty Peacock ink.
5. On a scrap of Very Vanilla cardstock, stamp the larger stem using Early Espresso ink and stamp the larger mushroom top using Cajun Craze ink. Punch. On the same scrap of vanilla cardstock, stamp the smaller mushroom top using Lost Lagoon ink, stamp the smaller mushroom stem using Early Espresso ink and stamp the ground using Old Olive ink. Fussy cut.
6. Assemble the larger mushroom using liquid glue. A fine tip squeeze bottle and Silicone Craft Sheet makes this easy and tidy. Apply Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the mushroom pieces.
7. Adhere the ground and the sentiment to the card using liquid glue. Adhere the larger assembled mushroom and smaller mushroom pieces to the card.
8. Fold the ribbon in half, tie a big loopy bow with the Linen Thread and adhere it to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Shape the flower and adhere the leaves using Mini Glue Dots. Adhere the flower to the ribbon and twine loop using more glue dots.
10. Embellish using the Iridescent Foil Gems.

## Just a Little Thank You



### Measurements

- **Lost Lagoon Cardstock**
  - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
  - scrap for stamping and punching or fussy cutting the mushrooms and ground using the Terrific Toadstool Bundle
  - scrap for die cutting the 2-7/16 x 1/2" banner using the Something Fancy Dies
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the 2-5/16" square using the Stylish Shape Dies
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a flower using the Heart Shaped Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting leaves using the Heart Shaped Dies
- **Timeless Plaid Designer Series Paper**
  - THREE - 1 x 3-1/4"
- **Linen Thread**
  - about 12"
- **Pretty Peacock and Gold Metallic Ribbon**
  - about 5"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Lost Lagoon card base. Emboss the card front using the Plaster Painting 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Stamp the text element on the square using Crumb Cake ink.
3. Adhere the designer paper, followed by the square using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the sentiment on the right side of the vanilla banner using Pretty Peacock ink.
5. On a scrap of Very Vanilla cardstock, stamp the medium mushroom top using Calypso Coral ink, stamp the medium stem using Early Espresso ink and stamp the larger mushroom top using Pretty Peacock ink. Punch. On the same scrap of vanilla cardstock, stamp the smallest mushroom top using Lost Lagoon ink, stamp the large and smallest mushroom stems using Early Espresso ink and stamp the ground using Old Olive ink. Fussy cut.
6. Assemble the large and medium mushrooms using liquid glue. A fine tip squeeze bottle and Silicone Craft Sheet makes this easy and tidy. Apply Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the mushrooms and mushroom pieces.
7. Adhere the ground and the sentiment to the card using liquid glue. Adhere the larger assembled mushrooms and smallest mushroom pieces to the card.
8. Fold the ribbon in half, tie a big loopy bow with the Linen Thread and adhere it to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Shape the flower and adhere the leaves using Mini Glue Dots. Adhere the flower to the ribbon and twine loop using more glue dots.
10. Embellish using the Iridescent Foil Gems.

## Poppin' Up to Say Hi



### Measurements

- **Lost Lagoon Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
  - scrap for stamping and punching or fussy cutting the mushrooms and ground using the Terrific Toadstool Bundle
  - scrap for die cutting the dog tag shape label using the Unbounded Love Dies
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the fourth from the smallest arch using the Everyday Arches Dies
- **Calypso Coral Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a flower using the Heart Shaped Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting leaves using the Heart Shaped Dies
- **Timeless Plaid Designer Series Paper**
  - 2-3/4 x 3"
  - TWO - 1-3/8 x 3"
- **Linen Thread**
  - about 12"
- **Pretty Peacock and Gold Metallic Ribbon**
  - about 9"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Lost Lagoon card base. Emboss the card front using the Plaster Painting 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Stamp the text element on the arch using Crumb Cake ink.
3. Adhere the designer paper, followed by the arch using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the sentiment on the right side of the vanilla label using Pretty Peacock ink.
5. On a scrap of Very Vanilla cardstock, stamp the smaller mushroom top using Pretty Peacock ink, stamp the smaller stem using Early Espresso ink and stamp the larger mushroom top using Calypso Coral ink. Punch. On the same scrap of vanilla cardstock, stamp the larger mushroom stem using Early Espresso ink and stamp the ground using Old Olive ink. Fussy cut.
6. Assemble the mushrooms using liquid glue. A fine tip squeeze bottle and Silicone Craft Sheet makes this easy and tidy. Apply Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the mushrooms.
7. Fold the ribbon in half, tie a big loopy bow with the Linen Thread and adhere it to the back of the sentiment using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
8. Shape the flower and adhere the leaves using Mini Glue Dots. Adhere the flower to the ribbon and twine loop using more glue dots.
9. Adhere the ground and the sentiment to the card using a combination of liquid glue and Tear & Tape. Adhere the assembled mushrooms to the card.
10. Embellish using the Iridescent Foil Gems.



# Stamping and Coloring Guide

## Mushrooms Pieces to Punch

- These are the pieces that you'll need to stamp and punch.
- You can stamp them in your choice of color and
- Be sure to stamp them a grid pattern or cut strips before stamping for easy punching.



## Mushrooms Pieces to Fussy Cut

- Stamp quantity noted in your choice of colors and fussy cut.
