## Stamp a Stack Tip

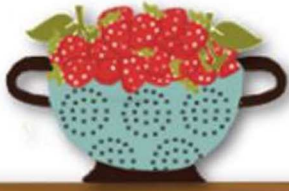

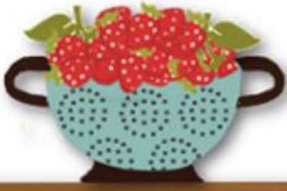

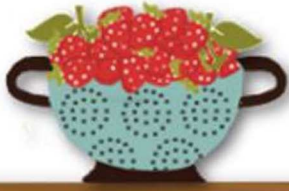

## Wishing You All The Best

### Cool People Exclusive Card Sketch #16



### Measurements

- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
  - 3-3/4 x 5"
  - scrap for die cutting the 2 x 2-3/4" postage stamp using the Perennial Postage Dies
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the flowers using the Delightful Wishes Bundle
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the word "wishing" using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Daffodil Delight Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a small flower using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Crushed Curry Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a small flower center image using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
  - scrap for punching a leaf using the Bough Punch
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - 5/16 x 2-5/8"

## Measurements - Cont.

- **Floral Delight Designer Series Paper**
  - 2 x 3-3/4" or 2-1/2 x 4", you can cut the piece from Wonder Recipe #24 down or leave it larger. I left it.
  - 2 x 2-1/4"
- **Basic White 1/4" Ribbon**
  - about 8-1/2"
- **Linen Thread**
  - about 12"

## Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base. Emboss the Basic White panel using the Cute Crochet Embossing Folder. Use your Bone Folder to curl the corners, then adhere the embossed panel to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
2. Adhere the designer paper to the card using liquid glue.
3. Fold the ribbon in half, then adhere it to the card front using Tear & Tape Adhesive. Wrap the Linen Thread around the folded end of the ribbon and make a big loopy bow.
4. Stamp the branch and leaves on the white postage stamp rectangle using Pecan Pie and Old Olive ink. Stamp the sentiment on the strip of Crumb Cake cardstock using Pecan Pie ink. Stamp the flower image on a scrap of Basic White cardstock using Daffodil Delight ink then stamp the details of the flowers using Crushed Curry ink. Die cut.
5. Adhere the postage stamp to the card using liquid glue followed by the sentiment strip and the die cut word "wishing". Adhere the die cut flowers and Old Olive leaf using Stampin' Dimensionals and Mini Glue Dots.
6. Embellish using the Tiny Bee Trinkets and the Iridescent Faceted Gems.

## Wishing You a Happy Birthday



### Measurements

- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
  - 3-3/4 x 5"
  - scrap for die cutting the 2 x 2-3/16" arch using the Everyday Arches Dies
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the flowers using the Delightful Wishes Bundle
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the word "wishing" using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Daffodil Delight Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a small flower using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Crushed Curry Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a small flower center image using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
  - scrap for punching a leaf using the Bough Punch
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - 5/16 x 3-5/16"

## Measurements - Cont.

- **Floral Delight Designer Series Paper**
  - 2 x 3-3/4"
  - 1-1/8 x 4"
  - 1 x 3-3/4"
- **Basic White 1/4" Ribbon**
  - about 10-1/2"
- **Linen Thread**
  - about 12"

## Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base. Emboss the Basic White panel using the Cute Crochet Embossing Folder. Use your Bone Folder to curl the corners, then adhere the embossed panel to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
2. Adhere the designer paper to the card using liquid glue.
3. Fold the ribbon in half, then adhere it to the card front using Tear & Tape Adhesive. Wrap the Linen Thread around the folded end of the ribbon and make a big loopy bow.
4. Stamp the branch and leaves on the white arch using Pecan Pie and Old Olive ink. Stamp the sentiment on the strip of Crumb Cake cardstock using Pecan Pie ink. Stamp the flower image on a scrap of Basic White cardstock using Daffodil Delight ink then stamp the details of the flowers using Crushed Curry ink. Die cut.
5. Adhere the arch to the card using liquid glue followed by the sentiment strip and the die cut word "wishing". Adhere the die cut florals and punched out Old Olive leaf using Stampin' Dimensionals and Mini Glue Dots.
6. Embellish using the Tiny Bee Trinkets and the Iridescent Faceted Gems.

## Lots of Love



### Measurements

- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
  - 3-3/4 x 5"
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the branch using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Daffodil Delight Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the three sizes of flowers using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Crushed Curry Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the three sizes of flower details using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting TWO large leaves and THREE small leaves using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Mossy Meadow Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting TWO large leaf details and THREE small leaf details using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - 5/16 x 1-3/4"

## Measurements - Cont.

- **Floral Delight Designer Series Paper**
  - 1 x 3-3/4"
  - 1 x 2-1/4"
  - 1-1/8 x 4"
- **Basic White 1/4" Ribbon**
  - about 7-1/2"
- **Linen Thread**
  - about 12"

## Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base. Emboss the Basic White panel using the Cute Crochet Embossing Folder. Use your Bone Folder to curl the corners, then adhere the embossed panel to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
2. Adhere the designer paper to the card, followed by the Pecan Pie branch using liquid glue.
3. Assemble the flowers and leaves by adhering the details to the flower or leaf using liquid glue. If you do not love liquid glue, try one of the little squeeze bottles that I use OR put adhesive sheet on the Crushed Curry and Mossy Meadow before you die cut to make the details pick and stick.
4. Stamp the sentiment on the strip of Crumb Cake cardstock using Pecan Pie ink.
5. Make a faux bow with the white ribbon, then wrap the Linen Thread around the center of the ribbon and make a big loopy bow. Adhere it to the back of the sentiment strip using a Mini Glue Dot.
6. Adhere the sentiment strip followed by the flowers and leaves using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Embellish using the Tiny Bee Trinkets and the Iridescent Faceted Gems.
