Stamp a Stack Tip

You are welcome to make just one of these cards, but they are a one sheet wonder style Stamp a Stack. If you are making the Ocean Friends Stamp a Stack as designed, choose THREE designer papers. Cut TWO of them according to Wonder Recipe #26 and ONE according to Wonder Recipe #25. Whichever pattern you use for recipe #25, you will need TWO additional 3/4 x 1-1/2" pieces. The Wonder Recipe makes TWO of the first two designs and FOUR of the third design.

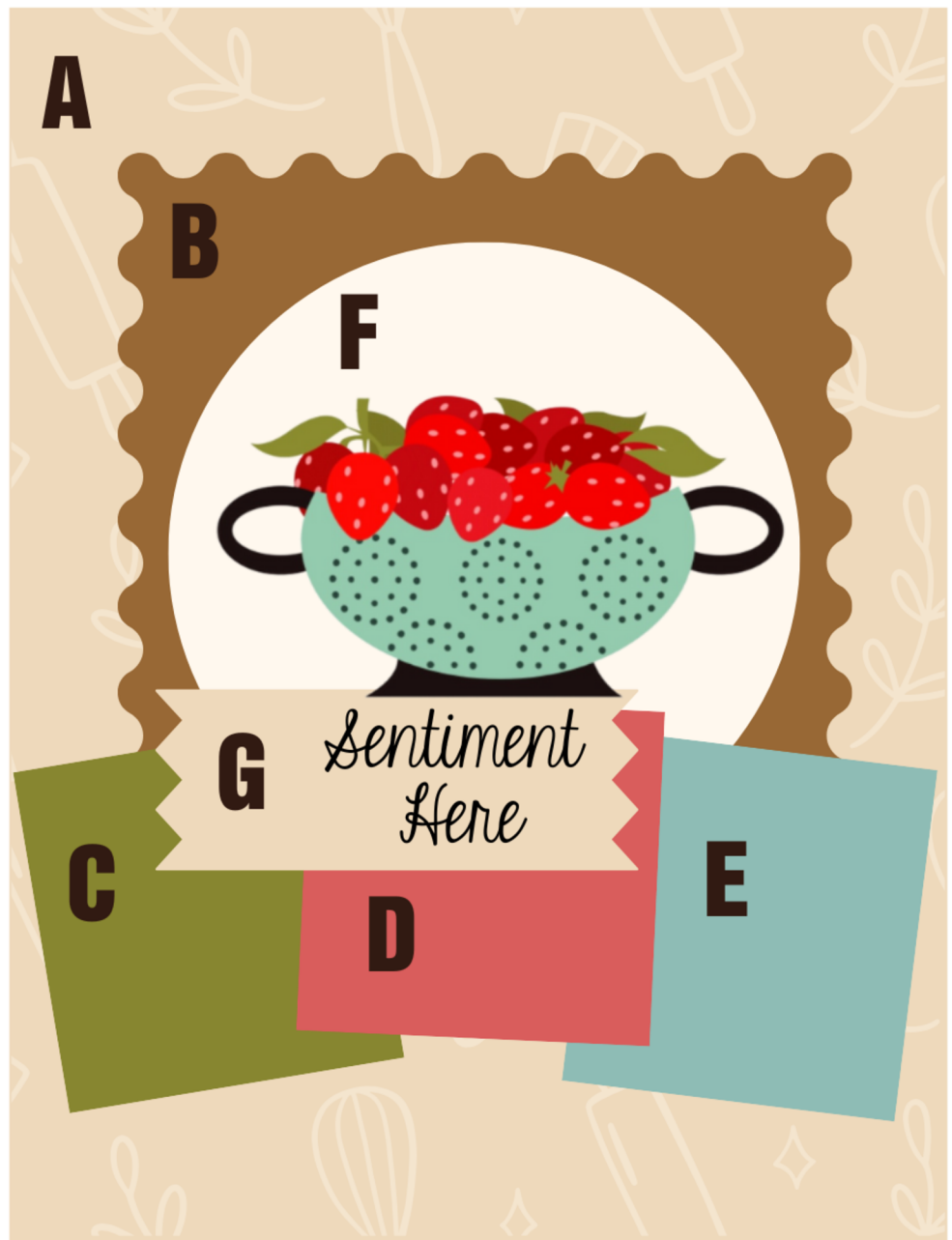

Measurements

- **Night of Navy Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Misty Moonlight Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the coral using the Ocean Friends Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 3/4 x 1-7/8" postage stamp using Perennial Postage Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the crab using the Ocean Friends Bundle
- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 2-3/4" wonky circle using the Around It All Dies
- **Cajun Craze Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a sea star using the Ocean Friends Dies
- **Pretty in Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the seaweed using the Ocean Friends Dies
- **Everyday Skies Designer Series Paper**
 - 3 x 3"
 - THREE 1-1/2 x 1-1/2"
- **Night of Navy & Gold Ribbon**
 - about 12"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Night of Navy cardstock. Emboss the card front using the Soft Waves Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Cut the coral in half as indicated on the die cutting guide at the end of this pdf. Adhere the half coral to the beige wonky circle then stamp the bubbles using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
4. Make a faux bow by folding the ribbon back forth then adhere the ribbon to the back of the circle using Tear & Tape Adhesive. Adhere the circle to the card using more Tear & Tape Adhesive.
5. Stamp the sentiment on the white postage stamp using Versamark ink. Carefully heat emboss using Wow! gold embossing powder and the tools in the Embossing Additions Tools Kit.
6. Stamp the crab on Basic White cardstock using full strength Cajun Craze ink for the outline of the crab and second generation Cajun Craze ink to fill. Die cut.
7. Draw in the crab's eyes using the Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker.
8. Adhere the seaweed, crab and the sentiment using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Adhere the sea star using a Mini Glue Dot.
10. Embellish using the Antique Pearls.

Measurements

- **Night of Navy Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Misty Moonlight Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the seaweed using the Ocean Friends Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 3/4 x 2-1/8", postage stamp using Grow with Love Dies, cut in half horizontally, save the second half for the next card
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the crab using the Ocean Friends Bundle
- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 2 x 2-3/4" postage stamp using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Cajun Craze Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the coral using the Ocean Friends Dies
- **Pretty in Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a sea star using the Ocean Friends Dies
- **Everyday Skies Designer Series Paper**
 - TWO 1-1/2 x 3"
 - 1-1/2 x 1-1/2", cut in half, save the second half for the next card
- **Night of Navy & Gold Ribbon**
 - about 10"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Night of Navy cardstock. Emboss the card front using the Soft Waves Embossing Folder.
2. Cut some chicken lips on one end of the 3/4 x 1-1/2" designer paper. Adhere it to one of the 1-1/2 x 3" designer papers as shown.
3. Pierce across the designer paper banner using the Take Your Pick Tool. Make several holes across the top of the banner starting before the banner and ending after. Make two rows of piercing then use a Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker to make a line across connecting the holes.
4. Adhere the designer paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
5. Cut the coral in half as indicated on the die cutting guide at the end of this pdf. Adhere the half coral to the beige postage rectangle then stamp the bubbles using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
6. Fold the ribbon in half and adhere to the back of the postage rectangle using Tear & Tape Adhesive. Adhere the postage rectangle to the card using more Tear & Tape Adhesive.
7. Stamp the sentiment on the white Grow with Love label using Versamark ink. Carefully heat emboss using Wow! gold embossing powder and the tools in the Embossing Additions Tools Kit.
8. Stamp the crab on Basic White cardstock using full strength Night of Navy ink for the outline of the crab and second generation Night of Navy ink to fill. Die cut.
9. Draw in the crab's eyes using the Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker.
10. Adhere the seaweed, crab and the sentiment using Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. Adhere the sea star using a Mini Glue Dot.
12. Embellish using the Antique Pearls.





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Hello, Friend



Measurements

- **Night of Navy Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Misty Moonlight or Cajun Craze Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the coral and sea star using the Ocean Friends Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting long slim banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the lobster using the Ocean Friends Bundle
- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the larger rectangle label using the Grow with Love Dies
- **Everyday Skies Designer Series Paper**
 - 3 x 3"
 - 1-1/2 x 3"
 - 1-1/2 x 1-1/2", cut in half, save the second half for the next card
- **Night of Navy & Gold Ribbon**
 - about 10"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Night of Navy cardstock. Emboss the card front using the Soft Waves Embossing Folder.
2. Cut some chicken lips on one end of the 3/4 x 1-1/2" designer paper. Adhere it to one of the 3 x 3" designer papers as shown.
3. Pierce across the designer paper banner using the Take Your Pick Tool. Make several holes across the top of the banner starting before the banner and ending after. Make two rows of piercing then use a Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker to make a line across connecting the holes.
4. Adhere the designer paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
5. Cut the coral in half as indicated on the die cutting guide at the end of this pdf. Adhere the half coral to the beige rectangle then stamp the bubbles using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
6. Fold the ribbon in half and adhere to the back of the rectangle using Tear & Tape Adhesive. Adhere the rectangle to the card using more Tear & Tape Adhesive.
7. Stamp the sentiment on the white banner stamp using Versamark ink. Carefully heat emboss using Wow! gold embossing powder and the tools in the Embossing Additions Tools Kit.
8. Stamp the lobster on Basic White cardstock using your choice of full strength Night of Navy or Cajun Craze ink for the outline of the crab and second generation of the same ink to fill. Die cut.
9. Draw in the lobster's eyes using the Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker.
10. Adhere the lobster and the sentiment using Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. Adhere the sea star using a Mini Glue Dot.
12. Embellish using the Antique Pearls.
