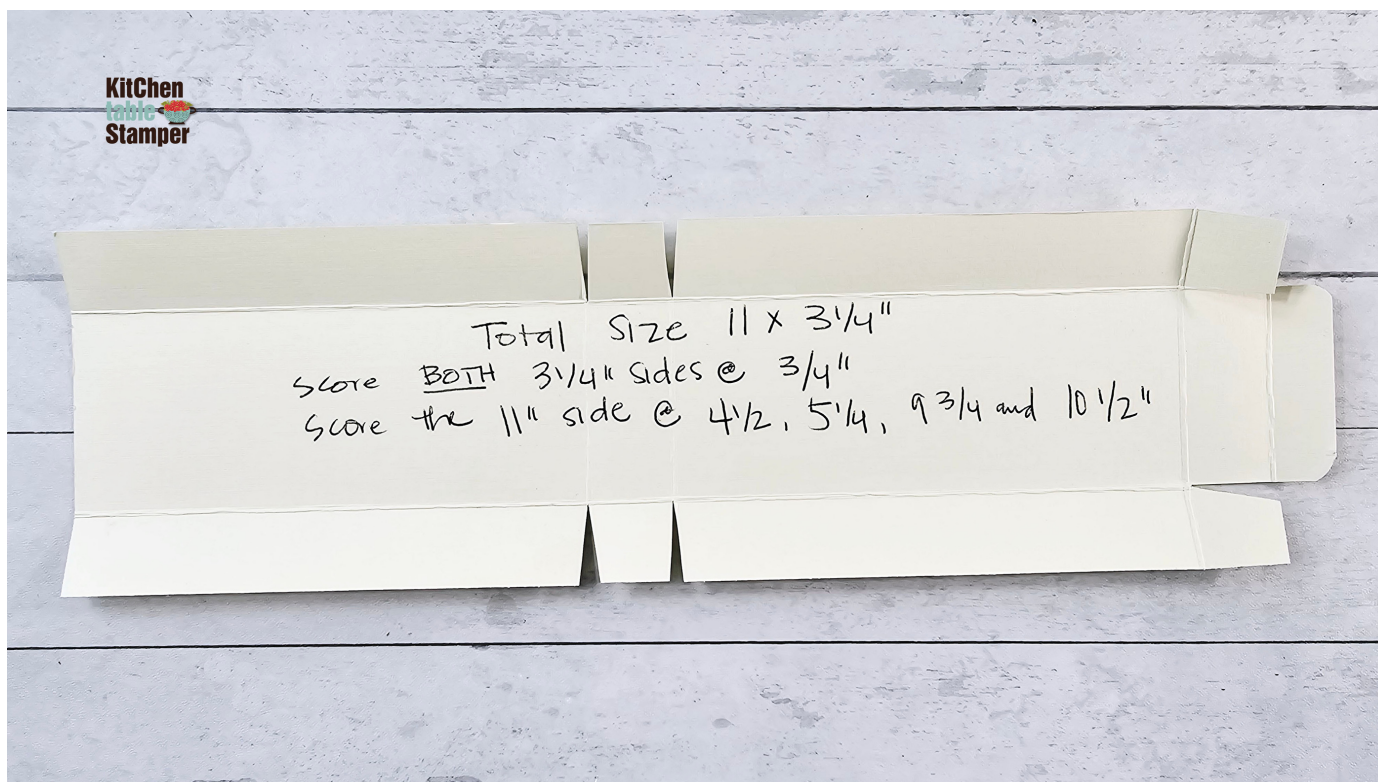

Measurements

- **Strawberry Slush Cardstock**
 - 11 x 3-1/4"
 - scored on BOTH 3-1/4" sides at 3/4"
 - scored on the 11" side at 4-1/2, 5-1/4, 9-3/4 and 10-1/2"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and fussy the pencil and backpack using the School Days Stamp Set
- **On The Go Designer Series Paper**
 - TWO 4-1/4 x 1-1/2"
 - TWO 4-1/4 x 1/2"
 - tags of your choice fussy cut from the designer paper
- **Black & Very Vanilla Large Check Ribbon**
 - about 15"



Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Strawberry Slush Cardstock using a Bone Folder. Trim according to the template. Round the corners on the tuck flap.
2. Adhere the designer series paper to box, punch a little thumb notch in the front using a 1/2" circle punch and assemble using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
3. Stamp the greeting on the oblong shape with Memento ink then punch a 1/8" hole in the end of the oblong to make a tag.
4. Stamp the pencil three times, once in each using Crushed Curry, Crumb Cake and Strawberry Slush ink. Cut the parts and reassemble to make a multicolor pencil.
5. Stamp the backpack three times, once in each using Azure Afternoon, Shy Shamrock and Strawberry Slush ink. Cut the parts and reassemble to make a multicolor backpack.
6. Cut your choice of tag or tags from the designer paper and then glue them together layered. Punch a hole in the tags.
7. Wrap the box with ribbon, tie and then thread both ends through the tags. Separate the ribbon then thread the greeting tag on one of the ends. Tie a bow. TIP: A dental floss threader makes this so easy. Secure the tag to the box using a Stampin' Dimensional.
8. Adhere the pencil and backpack to the box using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Embellish with Transparent Adhesive-Backed Dots.
