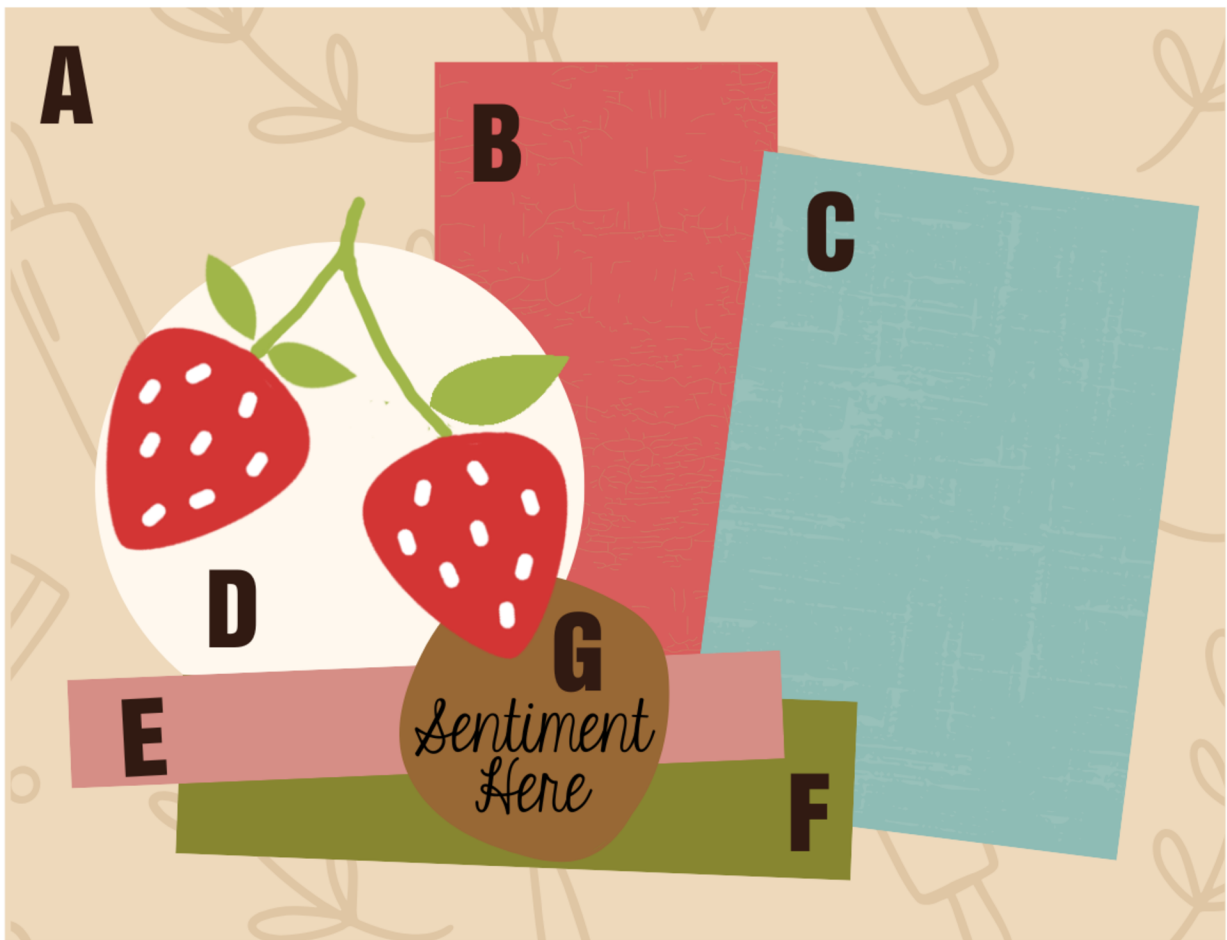
Measurements

- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the sentiment piece of your choice using the More Messages Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the turtle, hat, TWO birds and other images of your choice using the Turtle-y Awesome Bundle
- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the largest banner using the Nested Essentials Dies
- **Sweet Sorbet Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching TWO flowers using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Garden Green Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching leaves using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the hat using the Turtle-y Awesome Dies
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the hat brim using the Turtle-y Awesome Dies
- **Turtle-y Cute Designer Series Paper**
 - 1-1/2 x 3"
 - 1-1/2 x 3"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Crumb Cake Cardstock using a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Turtle Textures Embossing Folder.
2. Stamp the leaf background on the Pool Party banner using Versa Mark ink.
3. Adhere the designer paper, followed by the Pool Party banner to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the greeting on the Basic White sentiment piece using Shaded Spruce ink.
5. Stamp the turtle, birds and doo dads of your choice using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
6. Die cut and assemble the sun hat using liquid glue.
7. Adhere the images to the card using a combination of liquid glue and dimensionals.
8. Shape the flowers using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat. Assemble the flower using Mini Glue Dots. Adhere the assembled flower and leaves to the card using the same adhesive.
9. Cut both stitched edges off of the ribbon. Make a bow from each of the cut edges and adhere a bow to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
10. Embellish using the Shades of Green Hexagons.

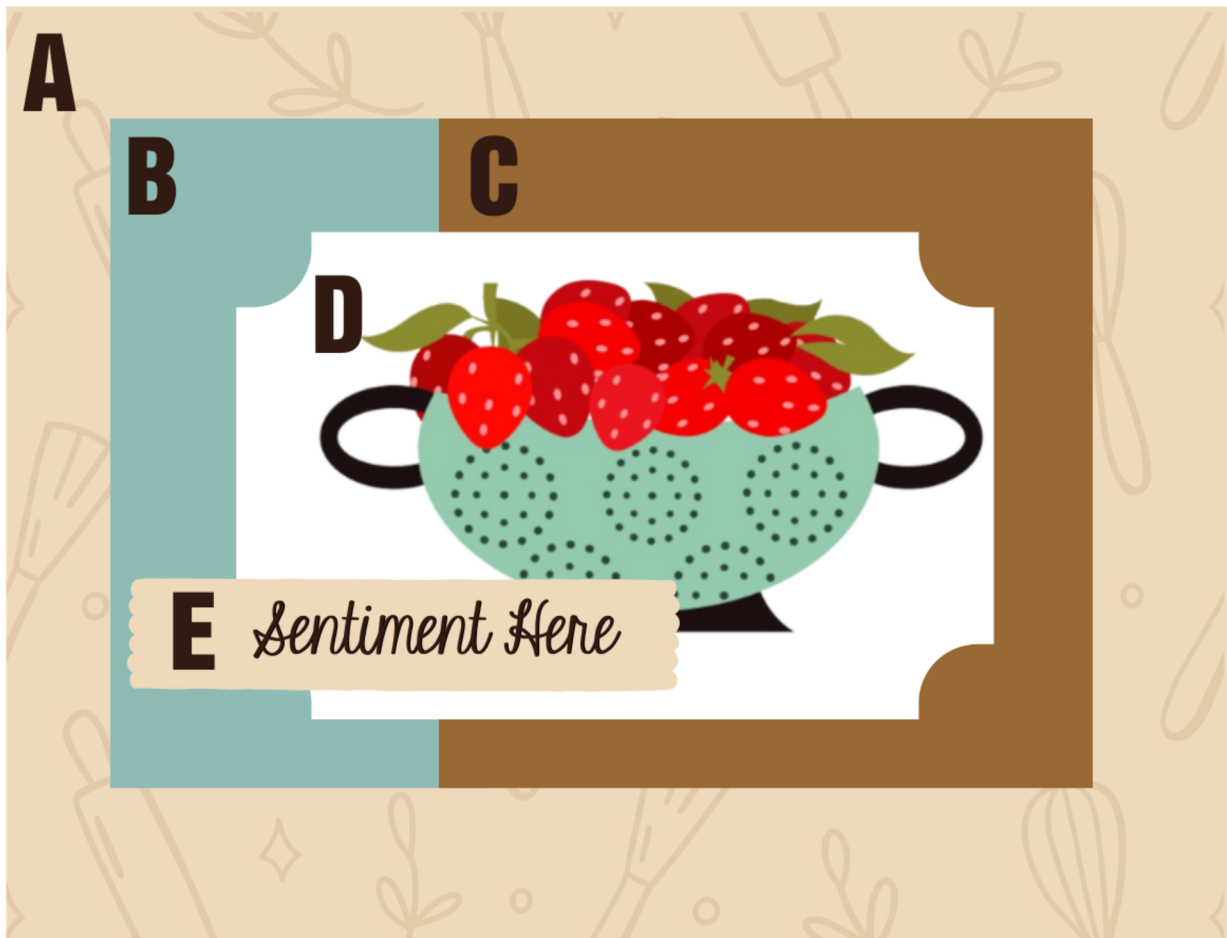
Measurements

- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the sentiment piece of your choice using the More Messages Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the turtle, a hat, TWO birds and other images of your choice using the Turtle-y Awesome Bundle
- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a circle using the 2-3/8" Circle Punch
- **Sweet Sorbet Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching TWO flowers using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Garden Green Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching leaves using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the hat using the Turtle-y Awesome Dies
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the hat brim using the Turtle-y Awesome Dies
- **Shaded Spruce Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the apron using the Turtle-y Awesome Dies
- **Copper Foil**
- scrap for die cutting the garden pail using the Turtle-y Awesome Dies
- **Turtle-y Cute Designer Series Paper**
 - 2 x 3"
 - 1-1/2 x 3"
 - 3/4 x 3"
 - 1/2 x 3"
- **Ribbon**
 - about 10"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Crumb Cake Cardstock using a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Turtle Textures Embossing Folder.
2. Stamp the leaf background on the Pool Party circle using Versa Mark ink.
3. Adhere the designer paper, followed by the Pool Party circle to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the greeting on the Basic White sentiment piece using Shaded Spruce ink.
5. Stamp the turtle, birds and doo dads of your choice using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
6. Die cut the apron, watering can and sun hat then assemble using liquid glue.
7. Adhere the images using a combination of liquid glue and dimensionals.
8. Shape the flowers using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat. Assemble the flower using Mini Glue Dots. Adhere the assembled flower and leaves to the card using the same adhesive.
9. Cut both stitched edges off of the ribbon. Make a bow from each of the cut edges then adhere a bow to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
10. Embellish using the Shades of Green Hexagons.

Measurements

- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the sentiment piece of your choice using the More Messages Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the turtle and TWO birds using the Turtle-y Awesome Bundle
- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 2 x 2-3/4" postage stamp using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Sweet Sorbet Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching TWO flowers using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Garden Green Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching leaves using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the hat using the Turtle-y Awesome Dies
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the hat brim using the Turtle-y Awesome Dies
- **Shaded Spruce Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the apron using the Turtle-y Awesome Dies
- **Copper Foil**
 - scrap for die cutting the garden pail using the Turtle-y Awesome Dies

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Crumb Cake Cardstock using a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Turtle Textures Embossing Folder.
2. Stamp the leaf background on the Pool Party postage stamp using Versa Mark ink.
3. Adhere the designer paper, followed by the Pool Party postage stamp to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the greeting on the Basic White sentiment piece using Shaded Spruce ink.
5. Stamp the turtle, hat, birds and doo dads of your choice using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
6. Die cut the watering can and sun hat then assemble using liquid glue.
7. Adhere the images using a combination of liquid glue and dimensionals.
8. Shape the flowers using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat. Assemble the flower using Mini Glue Dots. Adhere the assembled flower and leaves to the card using the same adhesive.
9. Cut both stitched edges off of the ribbon. Make a bow from each of the cut edges then adhere a bow to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
10. Embellish using the Shades of Green Hexagons.
