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## A Good Friend is a Gift

*Cool People Exclusive Card Sketch #19*



### *Measurements*

- **Fresh Freesia Cardstock**
  - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the tag using the Greetings of the Seasons Dies
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the pears using the Perfectly Pears Bundle
- **Mossy Meadow Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the branch using the Perfectly Pears Dies
- **Blackberry Bliss Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the flowers using the Perfectly Pears Dies
- **Celebratory Sips Designer Series Paper**
  - 1-1/2 x 5"
  - 1-1/2 x 5
  - 1-1/4 x 4-1/2"
- **Fresh Freesia Faux Velvet Ribbon**
  - about 8"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Fresh Freesia card base. Emboss the card front using the Sunflowers 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the speckles and the sentiment on the white tag using Blackberry Bliss ink. Adhere it to the card using liquid glue.
4. Adhere the Mossy Meadow branch and bunch of Blackberry Bliss flowers using a combination of liquid glue and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Stamp the small pear image on white cardstock using Memento Tuxedo Black ink then color as follows:
  - a. Ink the small pear filler stamp using the Lemon Lime Twist ink pad, then use a dauber directly on the inked stamp to apply some Granny Apple Green ink to the shadow side of the pears. Stamp the filler image inside the lines to color the pears.
  - b. Color the stem with Pecan Pie Stamp & Write Marker.
  - c. Squeeze the Garden Green ink pad to press some ink onto the inside of the lid. Open the ink pad and use a blender pen to pick up this ink and color the leaves.
6. Die cut the pears and adhere them to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Make a bow using the faux velvet ribbon. Adhere to the card front using a Mini Glue Dot.
8. Adhere the little Blackberry Bliss flowers using liquid glue.
9. Embellish with Two-Tone Sparkle Gems.



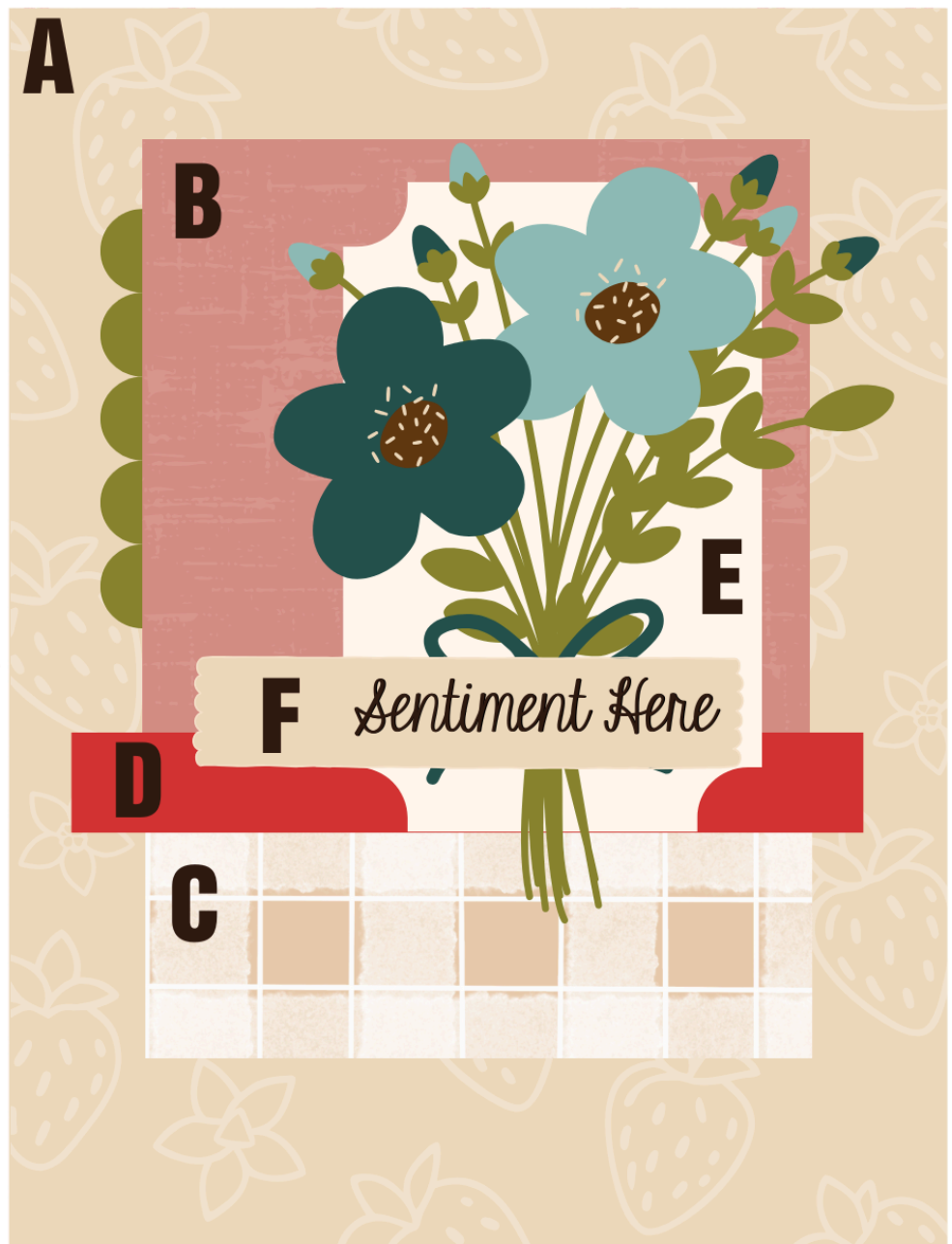

### Short Cut Card Sketch #23



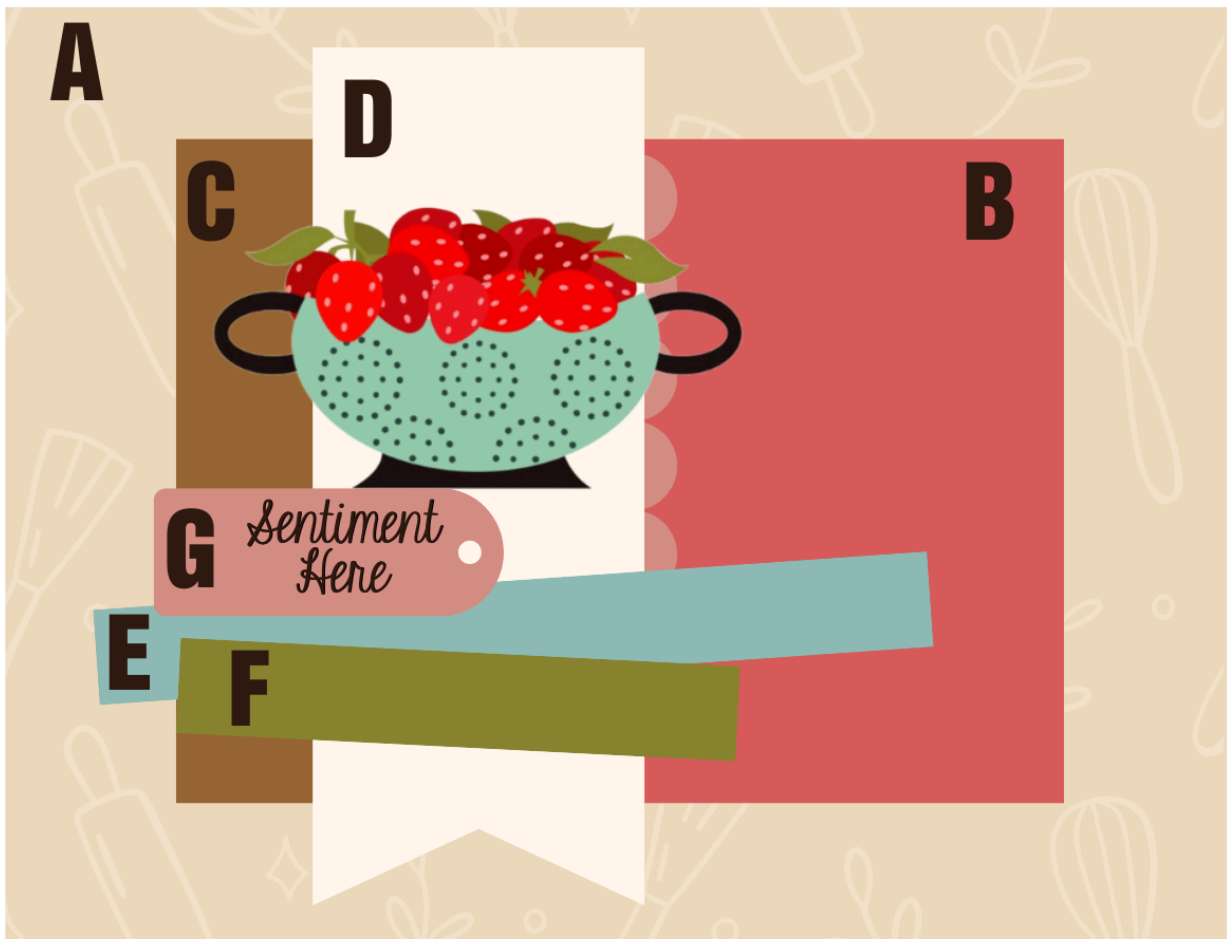
### Measurements

- **Fresh Freesia Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 X 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the 2 x 2-3/4" postage rectangle using the Perennial Postage Dies
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting a small tag, a pear, stem and leaves, and the flowers using the Perfectly Pears Bundle
- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the grid accent using the Perfectly Pears Dies
- **Blackberry Bliss Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the flowers using the Perfectly Pears Dies
- **Celebratory Sips Designer Series Paper**
  - 3 X 3"
  - 1-1/4 X 3"
  - 1/2 X 3-1/2"
- **Linen Thread - Optional**
  - 6 - 8"
- **Fresh Freesia Faux Velvet Ribbon**
  - about 8"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Fresh Freesia card base. Emboss the card front using the Sunflowers Embossing Folder.
2. Stamp the speckles on the white postage rectangle using Blackberry Bliss ink.
3. Adhere the designer paper to the card followed by the white postage rectangle using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Cut the Cloud Cover grid in half, tuck one half under the designer paper and adhere it using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
5. Stamp the greeting on a scrap of white cardstock using Blackberry Bliss ink. Die cut leaving space on the left side of the sentiment. Punch a hole on the left side of the tag using a 1/8" circle punch.
6. Stamp the large pear image on white cardstock using Memento Tuxedo Black ink, then color as follows:
  - a. Ink the large pear filler stamp using the Lemon Lime Twist ink pad, then use a dauber directly on the inked stamp to apply some Granny Apple Green ink to the shadow side of the pears.
  - b. Stamp the filler image inside the lines to color the pears.
7. Stamp the stem and leaves image on white cardstock using Memento Tuxedo Black ink, then color as follows:
  - a. Ink the large leaves filler stamp using the Granny Apple green ink pad, avoid the stem. Then use a dauber directly on the inked leaves to apply some Garden Green ink to the shadow side of the leaves.
  - b. Stamp the filler image inside the lines to color the leaves.
  - c. Color the stem with Pecan Pie Stamp & Write Marker.
8. Die cut the pear and stem and leaves then adhere them to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Stamp the flowers and flower centers on white cardstock using Blackberry Bliss ink. Squeeze the Fresh Freesia ink pad to press some ink onto the inside of the lid. Open the ink pad and use a blender pen to pick up this ink and color the flowers. Die cut.
10. Adhere the pear and the flowers to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. Make a bow using the faux velvet ribbon. Thread the tag with the Linen Thread, then make a thread knot around the ribbon bow. Adhere to the card front using Mini Glue Dots.
12. Adhere the Blackberry Bliss flowers using liquid glue.
13. Embellish with Two-Tone Sparkle Gems.

### Measurements

- **Fresh Freesia Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 X 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the 1-3/4 x 3-7/8" irregular hexagon using the Nested Essentials Dies
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the small tag, the flowers and the stem and leaves using the Perfectly Pears Bundle
- **Mossy Meadow Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the branch using the Perfectly Pears Dies
- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the grid accent using the Perfectly Pears Dies
- **Blackberry Bliss Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the flowers using the Perfectly Pears Dies
- **Celebratory Sips Designer Series Paper**
  - 3 X 3"
  - 1-1/2 X 3"
  - 1/2 x 4"
  - 1/2 X 2-1/2"
- **Linen Thread - Optional**
  - 6 - 8"
- **Fresh Freesia 1/8" Faux Velvet Ribbon**
  - about 8"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Fresh Freesia card base. Emboss the card front using the Sunflowers Embossing Folder.
2. Stamp the speckles on the irregular hexagon using Blackberry Bliss ink. Adhere the Cloud Cover grid to the back of the irregular hexagon using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Adhere the largest two pieces of designer paper, followed by the white irregular hexagon using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Adhere the 1/2" pieces of designer paper using the same glue.
5. Adhere the Mossy Meadow branch using a combination of liquid glue and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Stamp the greeting on a scrap of white cardstock using Blackberry Bliss ink. Die cut leaving space on the right side of the sentiment. Punch a hole on the right side of the tag using a 1/8" circle punch.
7. Stamp the flowers and flower centers on white cardstock using Blackberry Bliss ink. Squeeze the Fresh Freesia ink pad to press some ink onto the inside of the lid. Open the ink pad and use a blender pen to pick up this ink and color the flowers.
8. Stamp the stem and leaves image on white cardstock using Memento Tuxedo Black ink, then color as follows:
  - a. Ink the large leaves filler stamp using the Granny Apple green ink pad, avoid the stem. Then use a dauber directly on the inked leaves to apply some Garden Green ink to the shadow side of the leaves.
  - b. Stamp the filler image inside the lines to color the leaves.
  - c. Color the stem with Pecan Pie Stamp & Write Marker.
9. Die cut the flowers and the stem and leaves then adhere them to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Make a bow using the faux velvet ribbon. Thread the tag with the Linen Thread, then make a thread knot around the ribbon bow. Adhere to the card front using a Mini Glue Dot and Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
11. Adhere the Blackberry Bliss flowers using liquid glue.
12. Embellish with Two-Tone Sparkle Gems.
