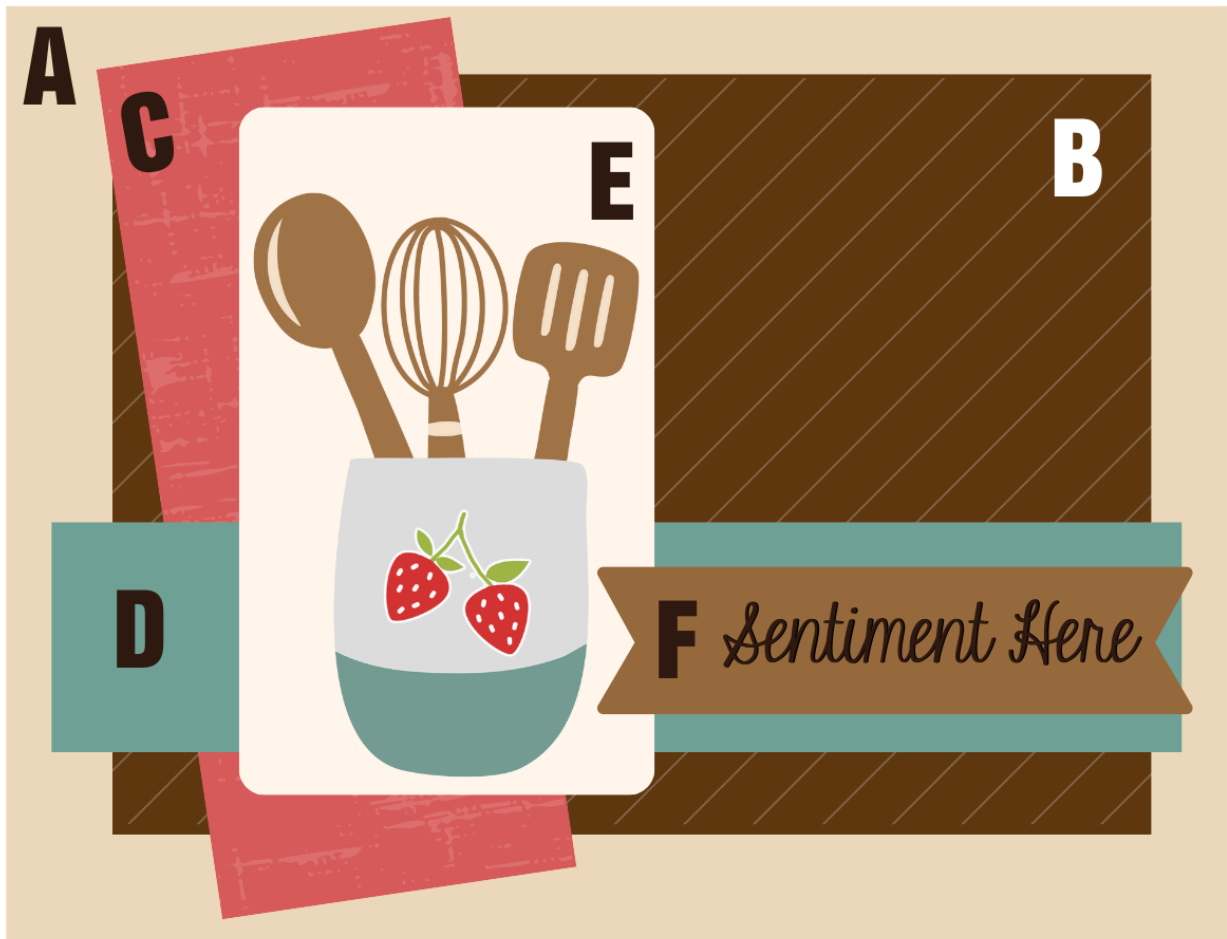

Short Cut Card Sketch #20

- A: 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- B: 4-3/4 x 3-1/2"
- C: 4 x 1-1/2"
- D: 5-1/4 x 1"
- E: 3-1/2 x 2-1/4"
- F: Any shape of your choice

Cool People Exclusive Card Sketch #20



Measurements

- **Basic Gray Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic Black Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO fences and bats using the Spooky Halloween Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 9/16 x 2-1/4"
- **Crushed Curry Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a circle using a 1-3/4" Circle Punch
- **Spooky Sweet Designer Series Paper**
 - 4-3/4 x 3-1/2"
 - 4 x 1-1/2"
 - 5-1/4 x 1"
 - hippo and candy corn die cuts
- **Petunia Pop Bordered Ribbon**
 - about 9"
- **Black & Very Vanilla Large Check Ribbon**
 - about 6"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Basic Gray card base. Emboss the card front using the Exposed Brick Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the greeting on the left side of the 9/16" piece of white using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
4. Adhere the the moon, TWO fences, and the TWO bats, followed by the sentiment, using liquid glue. Adhere the hippo to the card front using Black Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Cut both ribbons in half lengthwise. Fold the Petunia Pop ribbon in thirds. Tie the gingham ribbon around the folded Petunia Pop ribbon and make a knot in the middle to secure. Adhere to the card using a Mini Glue Dot. Place an additional Mini Glue Dot on top of the ribbon and adhere the candy corn.
6. Embellish using the Holographic Resin Dots.

Short Cut Card Sketch #22



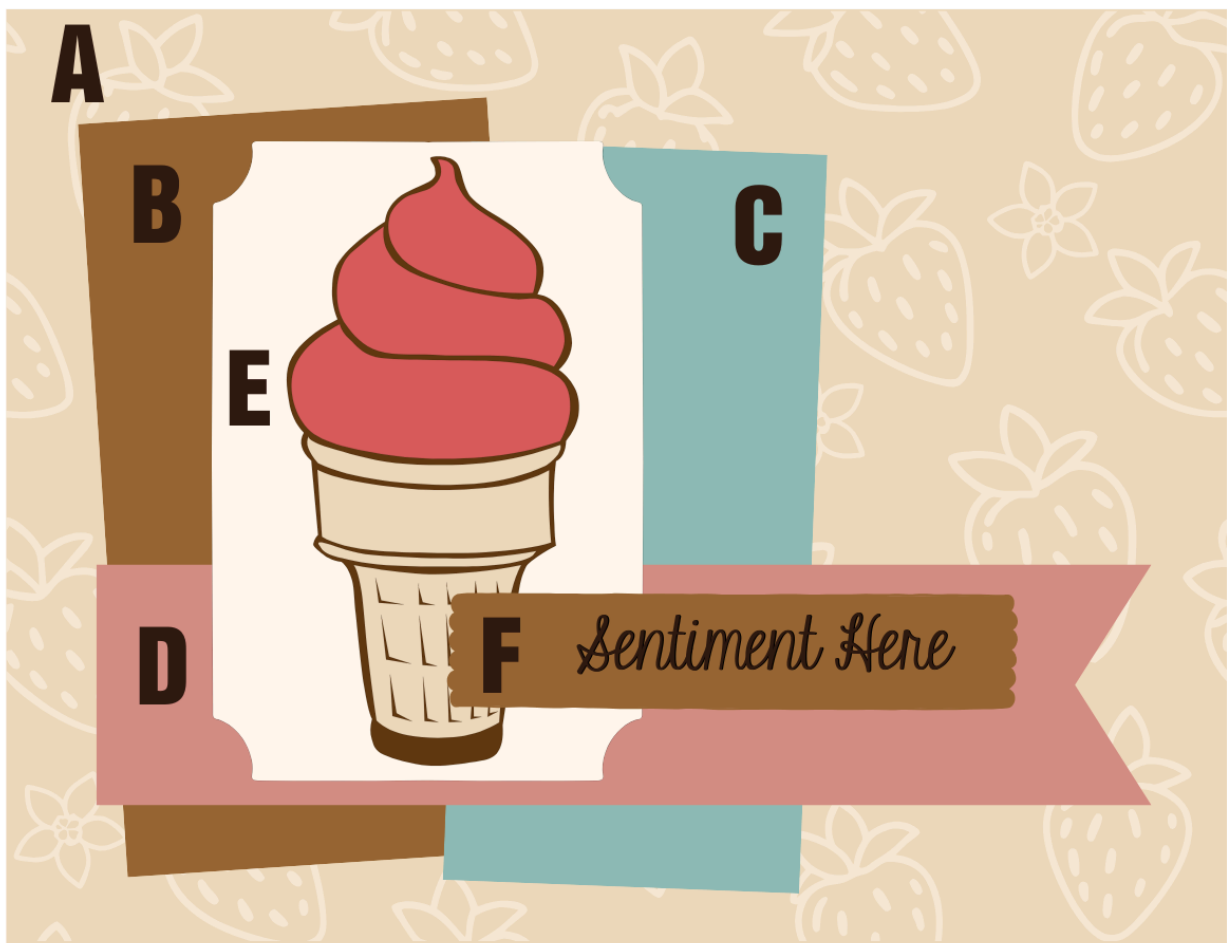
Measurements

- **Basic Gray Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic Black Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO fences and the bat tag topper using the Spooky Halloween Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping the sentiment, then cut ransom note style
- **Crushed Curry Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a crescent moon using a 1-3/4" Circle Punch
- **Spooky Sweet Designer Series Paper**
 - 2 x 5-1/4"
 - 1-1/2 x 4-1/4"
 - 3/4 x 4-1/4"
 - scrap for cutting the flamingo and tag plus a candy corn die cut
- **Petunia Pop Bordered Ribbon**
 - about 9"
- **Black & Very Vanilla Large Check Ribbon**
 - about 6"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Basic Gray card base. Emboss the card front using the Exposed Brick Embossing Folder.
2. Fold the bat tag topper over the top edge of the tag. Glue it to the tag using liquid glue.
3. Adhere the designer paper and tag to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the greeting on the scrap of white using Tuxedo Black Memento ink then cut the rows apart. Adhere it to the card using liquid glue.
5. Adhere the TWO fences to the card using liquid glue.
6. Adhere the flamingo and the moon to the card using Black Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Cut both ribbons in half lengthwise. Fold the Petunia Pop ribbon in thirds. Tie the gingham ribbon around the folded Petunia Pop ribbon and make a knot in the middle to secure. Adhere to the card using a Mini Glue Dot. Place an additional Mini Glue Dot on top of the ribbon and adhere the candy corn.
8. Embellish using the Holographic Resin Dots.

Short Cut Card Sketch #21



Measurements

- **Basic Gray Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic Black Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the haunted house using the Spooky Halloween Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 7/16 x 4-3/8"
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the dog using the Spooky Halloween Bundle
- **Crushed Curry Cardstock**
 - scrap for backing the Basic Black haunted house die cut
- **Spooky Sweet Designer Series Paper**
 - 3-3/4 x 2"
 - 3-3/4 x 1-1/2"
 - 4-7/8 x 1-1/4"
 - candy corn die cut
- **Petunia Pop Bordered Ribbon**
 - about 9"
- **Black & Very Vanilla Large Check Ribbon**
 - about 6"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Basic Gray card base. Emboss the card front using the Exposed Brick Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the greeting on the right side of the 7/16" strip of white using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Adhere the sentiment using the same adhesive.
4. Stamp the dog on a scrap of white using the same ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
5. Adhere the black haunted house to the scrap of Crushed Curry using liquid glue. Trim to remove the excess cardstock, then pop it on the card using Black Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Adhere the dog to the card using more dimensional adhesive.
7. Cut both ribbons in half lengthwise. Fold the Petunia Pop ribbon in thirds. Tie the gingham ribbon around the folded Petunia Pop ribbon and make a knot in the middle to secure. Adhere to the card using a Mini Glue Dot. Place an additional Mini Glue Dot on top of the ribbon and adhere the candy corn.
8. Embellish using the Holographic Resin Dots.
