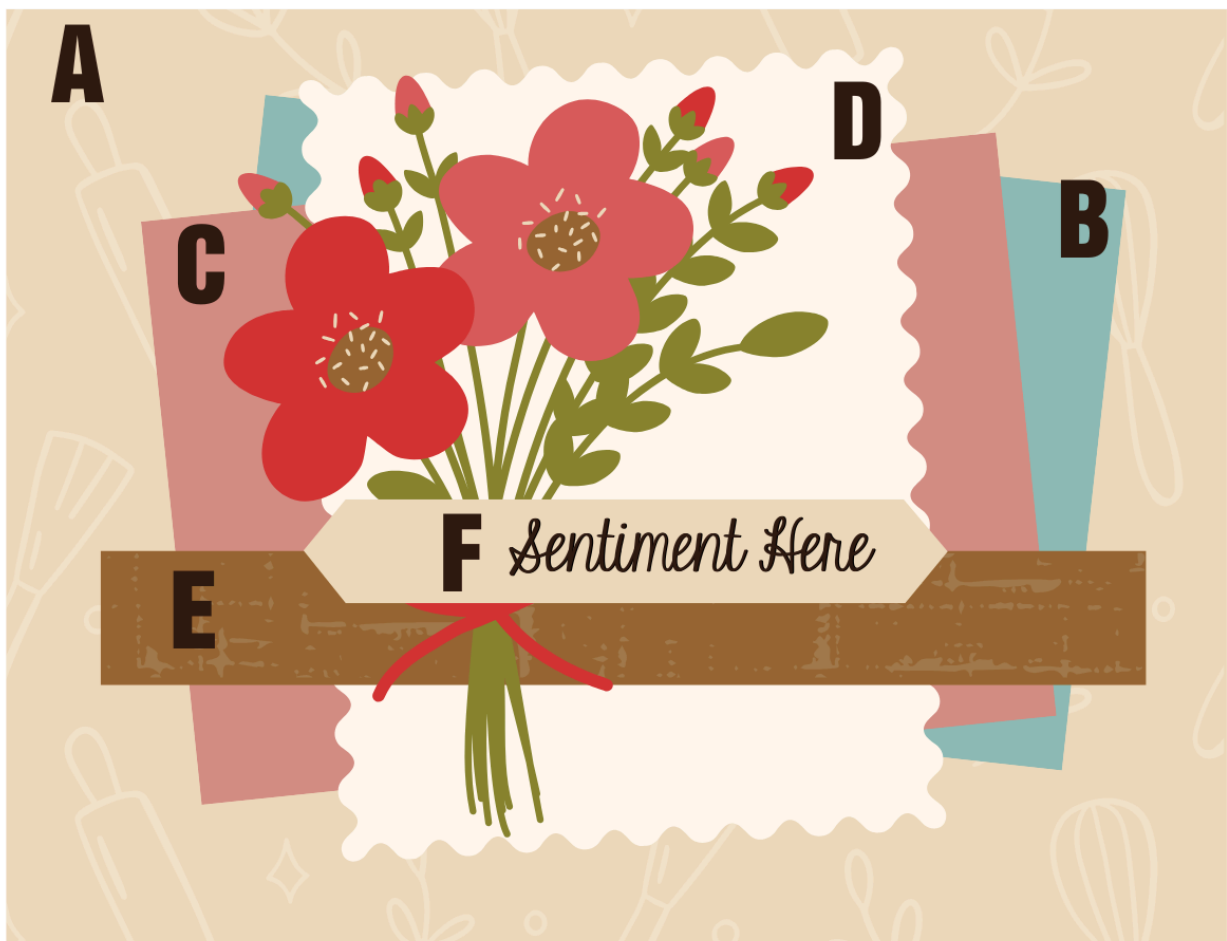

Short Cut Card Sketch #21

- A: 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- B: 3 x 4"
- C: 3 x 4"
- D: 2-3/4 x 3-3/4"
- E: 3/4 x 5"
- F: Any shape of your choice

Measurements

- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - scrap for die cutting the little key using the Tags to Go Dies
- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the large floral using the Charming Day Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the notebook paper using the Just a Note Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the label using the Something Fancy Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the sprig using the Charming Day Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the lock using the Tags to Go Dies
- **Beautiful Gallery Designer Series Paper**
 - 3 x 4"
 - 3 x 4"
 - 3/4 x 5"
- **Basic Beige Classic Ribbon**
 - about 9" cut in half lengthwise
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 12"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Cloud Cover card base using a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Distressed Tile Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper, followed by the notebook paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the greeting on the white label using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
4. Cut the Pecan Pie sprig in half.
5. Color the leaves and little flowers on the floral die cut using Stampin' Blends.
6. Adhere the divided sprig, floral die cut, and the greeting using a combination of liquid glue and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Tie a double bow using the divided ribbon. Thread the lock and key with the Linen Thread, wrap the tread around the center of the bow, then make a big loopy bow.
8. Adhere the bow using a Mini Glue Dot and support the lock with a bit of Stampin' Dimensional.
9. Embellish with Adhesive-Backed Textured Dots.

Short Cut Card Sketch #19



Measurements

- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO roses and TWO leaves using the Charming Day Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 2-3/8 x 4" label using the Countryside Corners Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the banner using the Birthday Celebration Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO long keys using the Tags to Go Dies
- **Smoky Slate Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the lock using the Tags to Go Dies
- **Beautiful Gallery Designer Series Paper**
 - 1 x 5-1/4"
 - 1/2 x 5-1/4"
 - 1-1/4 x 3-1/2"
- **Basic Beige Classic Ribbon**
 - about 9" cut in half lengthwise
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 12"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Cloud Cover card base using a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Distressed Tile Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper and white label using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the greeting on the white banner using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
4. Color the TWO roses using Stampin' Blends. Cut one of the leaves off each flower. Save them to embellish this card and card number three.
5. Adhere the flowers, both beige leaves, both keys and the greeting banner using a combination of liquid glue and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Tie a double bow using the divided ribbon. Thread the lock with the Linen Thread, wrap the tread around the center of the bow, then make a big loopy bow.
7. Adhere the bow using a Mini Glue Dot and support the lock with a bit of Stampin' Dimensional.
8. Adhere one of the leaves that you cut off of the rose to the center of the bow using a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Embellish with Adhesive-Backed Textured Dots.

Measurements

- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - scrap for die cutting the little key using the Tags to Go Dies
- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the sprigs using the Charming Day Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the flowers using the Charming Day Bundle
 - scrap for die cutting the 3-1/4 x 4-1/2" postage stamp using the Perennial Postage Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the hexagon using the Something Fancy Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO leaves using the Charming Day Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the lock using the Tags to Go Dies
- **Beautiful Gallery Designer Series Paper**
 - 2 x 5-1/4"
 - 2-1/4 x 4-1/4"
- **Basic Beige Classic Ribbon**
 - about 9" cut in half lengthwise
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 12"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Cloud Cover card base using a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Distressed Tile Embossing Folder.
2. Cut the postage rectangle down to make it 2-7/8 x 3-1/4".
3. Adhere the designer paper, followed by the postage stamp using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the greeting on the bottom of the white hexagon using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
5. Stamp the flowers on a scrap of Basic White cardstock using the same ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
6. Adhere the stamped flowers, Pecan Pie leaves and greeting using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the sprigs using liquid glue.
7. Tie a double bow using the divided ribbon. Thread the lock and key with the Linen Thread, wrap the tread around the center of the bow, then make a big loopy bow.
8. Adhere the bow using a Mini Glue Dot and support the lock with a bit of Stampin' Dimensional.
9. Adhere one of the leaves that you cut off of the rose in card number two to the center of the bow using a Mini Glue Dot.
10. Embellish with Adhesive-Backed Textured Dots.



Stamping and Coloring Guide
