Double Batch #1


Our new Wonder Recipe Double Batch one sheet wonder templates start with a piece of 6 x 12" designer series paper.


Cut the paper according to the template and then use all the pieces to make a stack of cards.

 More than one piece of designer paper may be used on each card.

 Use a 6 x 12" piece of designer paper that has two coordinating sides. Flip the pieces and show off two different patterns.

 Cut more than one 6 x 12" piece of designer paper to multiply the number of cards your Wonder Recipe can create.

 Different Wonder Recipes can be cut and the pieces combined for more design options.

 Each cut piece can be divided into smaller pieces if that's where your creativity takes you.

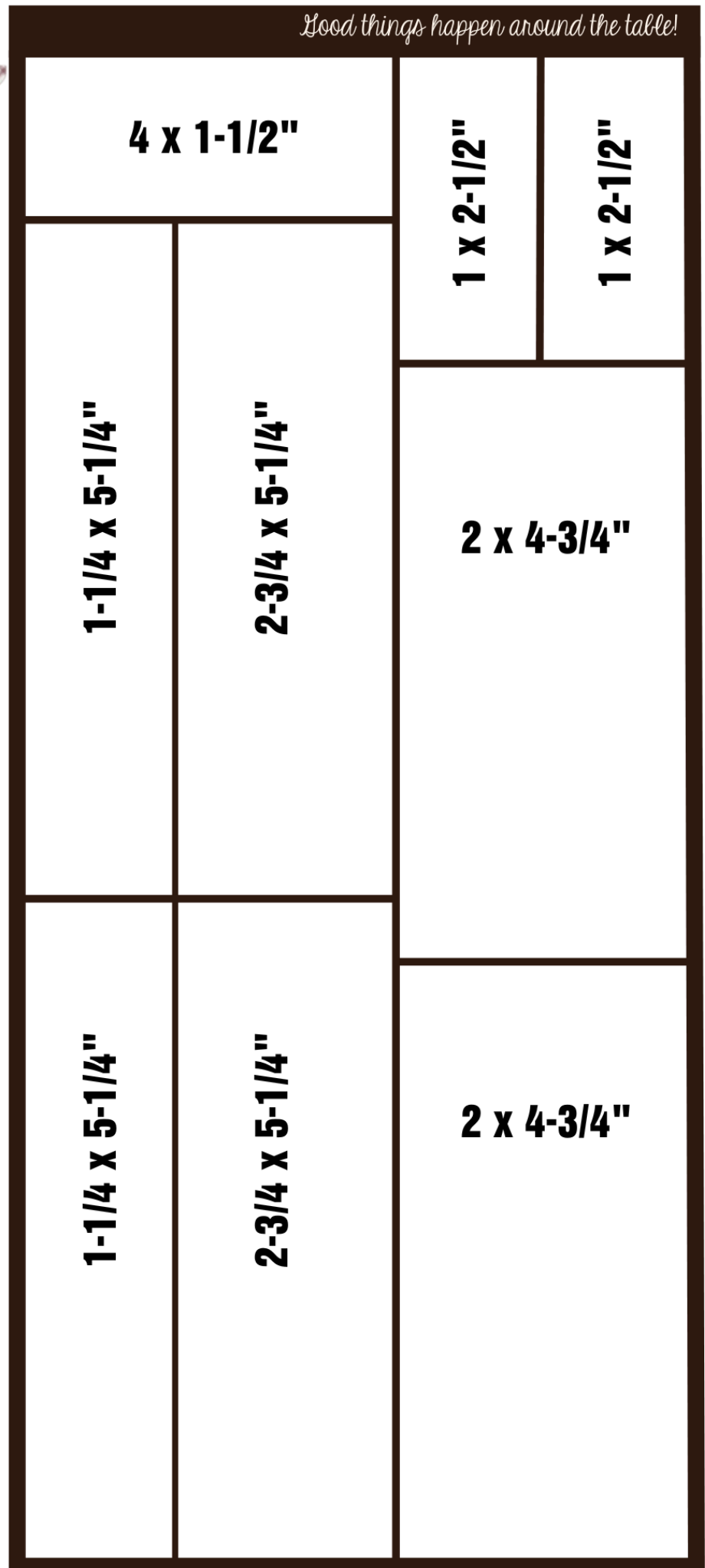

Cool People Exclusive Card Sketch #22



Measurements

- **Garden Green Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - 1-1/2 x 4"
 - scrap for die cutting lollipop details and the bow using the Gingerbread Man Dies
- **Poppy Parade Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting lollipop details using the Gingerbread Man Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the gingerbread man using the Gingerbread Man Bundle
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 3-1/2 x 1"
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the THREE gumdrops, and TWO lollipop sticks using the Gingerbread Man Bundle
- **North Pole Delivery Designer Series Paper**
 - 4 x 5-1/4"
 - 4 x 3/4"
 - 3/4 x 1"
- **Real Red Shiny Ribbon**
 - about 9" cut in half hot dog wise

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base using a Bone Folder.
2. Emboss the 1-1/2 x 4" piece of Garden Green Cardstock using the Traditional Wreath Embossing Folder. Optional: Lightly ink the embossed image using Garden Green ink.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the right side of the 3-1/2 x 1" white piece using Poppy Parade ink. Adhere the small piece of designer paper to the left of the greeting using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Swipe a little powder on the Pecan Pie cardstock using your embossing buddy. Stamp the gingerbread man on the same cardstock using Versa Mark ink. Pour white Embossing Powder over the image, shake off the excess powder and funnel it back into the container. Carefully heat emboss the image using your Heat Tool. Die or fussy cut, your choice.
5. Adhere the designer paper, embossed green piece, gingerbread man and sentiment to the card using liquid glue.
6. Stamp the gumdrops using Pool Party, Garden Green and Poppy Parade inks. Die cut.
7. Assemble ONE Garden Green and ONE Poppy Parade lollypop using liquid glue.
8. Assemble the Garden Green bow using a combination of Mini Stampin' Dimensionals and liquid glue, then adhere the bow to the card using the same adhesives.
9. Adhere the lollypops and the gumdrops using Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Tie a double bow using the divided Real Red Shiny Ribbon then adhere the bow to the card using a Mini Glue Dot or some hot glue.
11. Embellish using the Dear Dots.





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Oh Snap!



Measurements

- **Garden Green Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - 5-1/4 x 1/2"
 - scrap for die cutting a hat and scarf using the Gingerbread Man Dies
- **Poppy Parade Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a hat and a cocoa mug using the Gingerbread Man Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the gingerbread man using the Gingerbread Man Bundle
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the small whipped cream using the More Than Autumn Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the THREE gumdrops and the speech bubble using the Gingerbread Man Bundle
- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a hat using the Gingerbread Man Dies
- **North Pole Delivery Designer Series Paper**
 - 2-3/4 x 5-1/4"
 - 1-1/4 x 5-1/4"
 - 1 x 2-1/2"
- **Real Red Shiny Ribbon**
 - about 9" cut in half hot dog wise

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base using a Bone Folder.
2. Emboss the 5-1/4 x 1/2" piece of Garden Green Cardstock using the Traditional Wreath Embossing Folder. Optional: Lightly ink the embossed image using Garden Green ink.
3. Stamp the greeting on the white speech bubble using Poppy Parade ink.
4. Swipe a little powder on the Pecan Pie cardstock using your embossing buddy. Stamp the gingerbread man on the same cardstock using Versa Mark ink. Pour white Embossing Powder over the image, shake off the excess powder and funnel it back into the container. Carefully heat emboss the image using your Heat Tool. Die or fussy cut, your choice.
5. Use your scissors or a Tailored Tag Punch to cut chicken lips on the bottom of the 1 x 2-1/2" piece of designer paper. Adhere the designer papers and the embossed green piece to the card using liquid glue.
6. Stamp the gumdrops using Pool Party, Garden Green and Poppy Parade inks. Die cut.
7. Adhere the gingerbread man to the card using liquid glue. Turn the card over to the back side and trim the gingerbread man flush to the bottom edge of the card.
8. Cut the pompom off of the Garden Green hat. Cut the brim of the hat off of the Poppy Parade hat. Assemble the multicolor hat using a combination of Mini Stampin' Dimensionals and liquid glue. Adhere the hat to the card using liquid glue.
9. Adhere the gumdrops, cocoa mug, whipped cream, scarf and speech bubble to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Tie a double bow using the divided Real Red Shiny Ribbon then adhere the bow using a Mini Glue Dot or some hot glue.
11. Adhere the remaining gumdrop to the bow using a Mini Glue Dot.
12. Embellish using the Dear Dots.





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Baking Spirits Bright



Measurements

- **Garden Green Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Poppy Parade Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting candy cane details and the bow using the Gingerbread Man Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the gingerbread man using the Gingerbread Man Bundle
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 4 x 1/2"
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the candy cane background, THREE gumdrops and a lollypop stick using the Gingerbread Man Bundle
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the lollypop details using the Gingerbread Man Dies
- **North Pole Delivery Designer Series Paper**
 - TWO 2 X 4-3/4"
 - 7/8 x 1/2"
- **Real Red Shiny Ribbon**
 - about 9" cut in half hot dog wise

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the card base using a Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Traditional Wreath Embossing Folder. Optional: Lightly ink the embossed image using Garden Green ink.
2. Stamp the greeting on the right side of the 4 x 1/2" white piece using Poppy Parade ink. Adhere the small piece of designer paper to the left of the greeting using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Swipe a little powder on the Pecan Pie cardstock using your embossing buddy. Stamp the gingerbread man on the same cardstock using Versa Mark ink. Pour white Embossing Powder over the image, shake off the excess powder and funnel it back into the container. Carefully heat emboss the image using your Heat Tool. Die or fussy cut, your choice.
4. Adhere the designer paper, gingerbread man and sentiment to the card using liquid glue.
5. Stamp the gumdrops using Pool Party, Garden Green and Poppy Parade inks. Die cut.
6. Assemble the Petal Pink lollipop and the candy cane using liquid glue.
7. Assemble the Poppy Parade bow using a combination of Mini Stampin' Dimensionals and liquid glue, then adhere the bow to the card using the same adhesives.
8. Adhere the lollipop, candy cane and TWO of the gumdrops using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Tie a double bow using the divided Real Red Shiny Ribbon then adhere the bow using a Mini Glue Dot or some hot glue.
10. Adhere the remaining gumdrop to the bow using a Mini Glue Dot.
11. Embellish using the Dear Dots.
