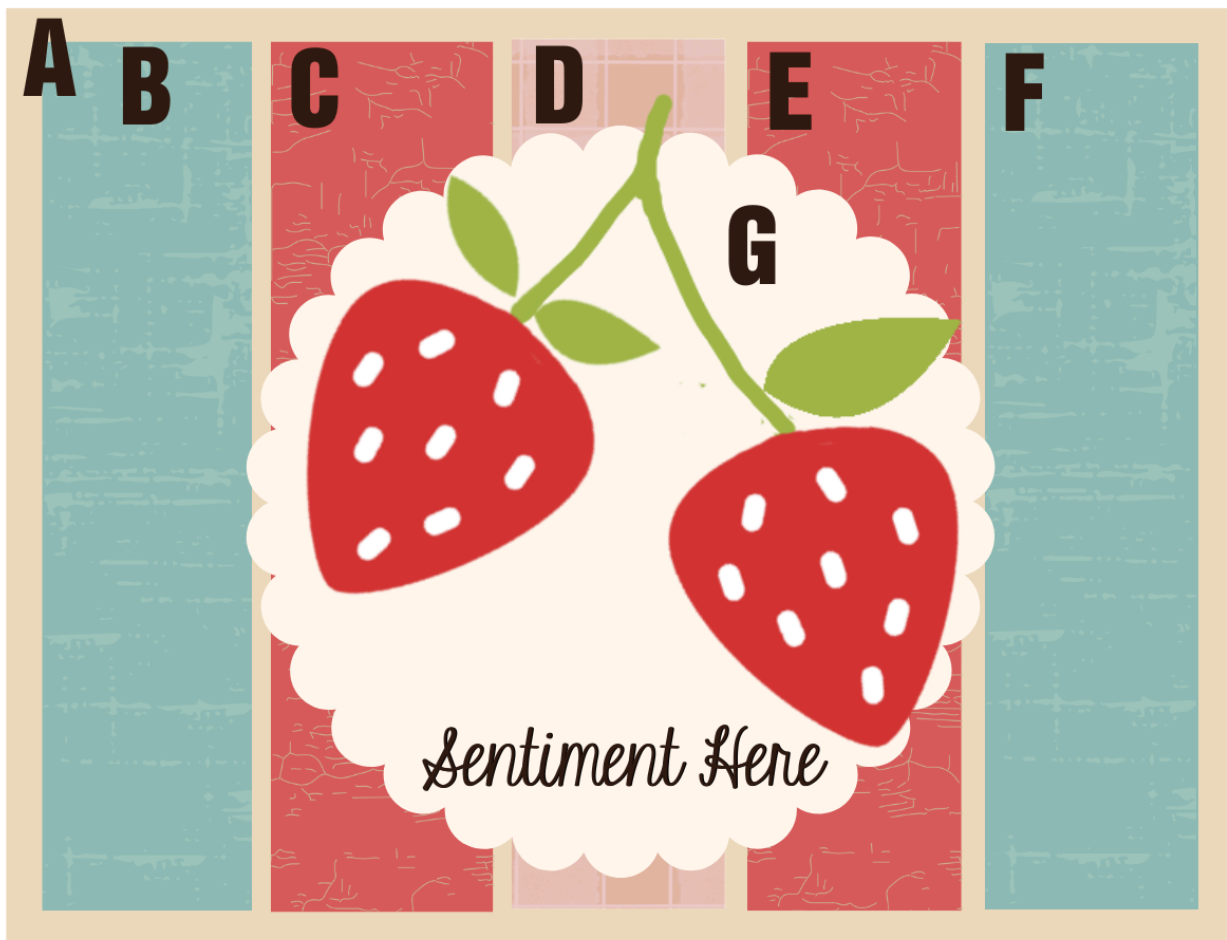

Measurements

- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Cherry Cobbler Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a dotted heart using the Hearts of Elegance Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 3-1/2 x 3-3/8" wonky circle using the Around It All Dies
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting a pair of mittens, a hat and a sweater using the Stay Warm Stamp Set
 - scrap for die cutting a branch using the Branching Out Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the pinecone using the Branching Out Dies
- **Boho Vibes Designer Series Paper**
 - FIVE 7/8 x 4"
- **Early Espresso Linen Thread**
 - about 9"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Cloud Cover card base.
2. Emboss the card front using the Beautiful Pattern Embossing Folder. Adhere the designer paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the Cherry Cobbler heart using the Lasting Linen Stamp Set and Cherry Cobbler ink.
4. Stamp the greeting on the bottom of the white wonky circle using Early Espresso ink.
5. Stamp the mittens on a scrap of Basic White Cardstock using Cloud Cover ink for the background and Secret Sea ink for the details.
6. Stamp the hat on the same white scrap using second generation Old Olive for the background and full strength Old Olive for the details.
7. Stamp the sweater on Basic White using second generation Cherry Cobbler and full strength Cherry Cobbler for the details.
8. Fussy cut the winter wear.
9. Color the branch using Deep and Old Olive Stampin' Stampin' Blends.
10. Adhere the wonky circle, heart and branch using liquid glue.
11. Adhere the mittens, hat, sweater and pinecone using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Make a bow with the Early Espresso Linen Thread. Adhere to the heart using a Mini Glue Dot.
13. Embellish using Cherry Cobbler & Pearl Adhesive-Backed Berries.

Sending Warm Hugs

Cool People Exclusive Card Sketch #13



Measurements

- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Cherry Cobbler Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a dotted heart using the Hearts of Elegance Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 3-3/8 x 3/4" with chicken lips on the right side
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting a heart, a pair of socks, a hat and a sweater using the Stay Warm Stamp Set
 - scrap for die cutting a branch using the Branching Out Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the pinecone using the Branching Out Dies
- **Boho Vibes Designer Series Paper**
 - 3-1/2 x 4-3/4"
 - 4-1/4 x 1-1/2"
- **Early Espresso Linen Thread**
 - about 9"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Cloud Cover card base.
2. Emboss the card front using the Beautiful Pattern Embossing Folder. Adhere the designer paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the Cherry Cobbler heart using the Lasting Linen Stamp Set and Cherry Cobbler ink.
4. Stamp the greeting on the white strip using Early Espresso ink.
5. Stamp the sweater on a scrap of Basic White Cardstock using Cloud Cover ink for the background and Secret Sea ink for the details.
6. Stamp the hat and heart on the same white scrap using second generation Cherry Cobbler for the background and full strength Cherry Cobbler for the details.
7. Stamp the socks on Basic White using second generation Old Olive and full strength Old Olive for the details.
8. Fussy cut the winter wear and heart. Adhere the heart to the sweater using liquid glue.
9. Color the branch using Deep and Old Olive Stampin' Stampin' Blends. Cut the branch apart creating a long and short branch. Reassemble so that the shorter branch is down so it doesn't cover the greeting.
10. Adhere the greeting, heart, and branch using liquid glue.
11. Adhere the socks, hat, sweater and pinecone using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Make a bow with the Early Espresso Linen Thread. Adhere to the heart using a Mini Glue Dot.
13. Embellish using Cherry Cobbler & Pearl Adhesive-Backed Berries.

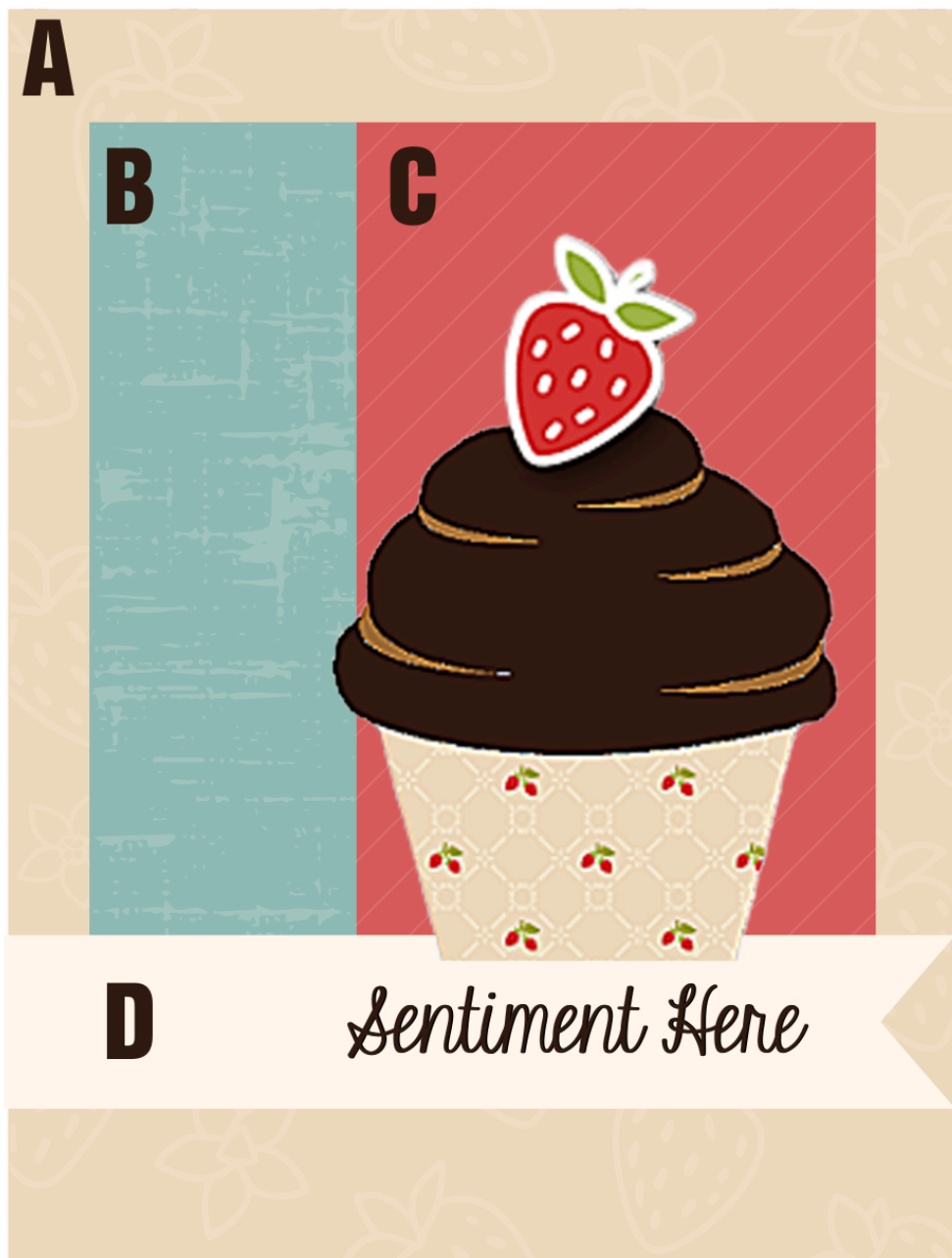

Love and Friendship Short Cut Card Sketch #24



Measurements

- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Cherry Cobbler Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a dotted heart using the Hearts of Elegance Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 4-1/8 x 7/8" with chicken lips on the right side
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting a heart, a pair of socks, a pair of mittens, a hat and a sweater using the Stay Warm Stamp Set
 - scrap for die cutting a branch using the Branching Out Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the pinecone using the Branching Out Dies
- **Boho Vibes Designer Series Paper**
 - 1-1/4 x 4"
 - 2-3/8 x 4"
- **Early Espresso Linen Thread**
 - about 9"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Cloud Cover card base.
2. Emboss the card front using the Beautiful Pattern Embossing Folder. Adhere the designer paper to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the Cherry Cobbler heart using the Lasting Linen Stamp Set and Cherry Cobbler ink.
4. Stamp the greeting on the white strip using Early Espresso ink.
5. Stamp the sweater on a scrap of Basic White Cardstock using second generation Old Olive for the background and full strength Old Olive for the details.
6. Stamp the socks and heart on the same white scrap using second generation Cherry Cobbler for the background and full strength Cherry Cobbler for the details.
7. Stamp the hat and mittens on Basic White using Cloud Cover for the background and Secret Sea for the details.
8. Fussy cut the winter wear and heart. Adhere the heart to the sweater using liquid glue.
9. Color the branch using Deep and Old Olive Stampin' Stampin' Blends.
10. Adhere the greeting, heart, and branch using liquid glue.
11. Adhere the socks, mittens, hat, sweater and pinecone using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Make a bow with the Early Espresso Linen Thread. Adhere to the heart using a Mini Glue Dot.
13. Embellish using Cherry Cobbler & Pearl Adhesive-Backed Berries.
