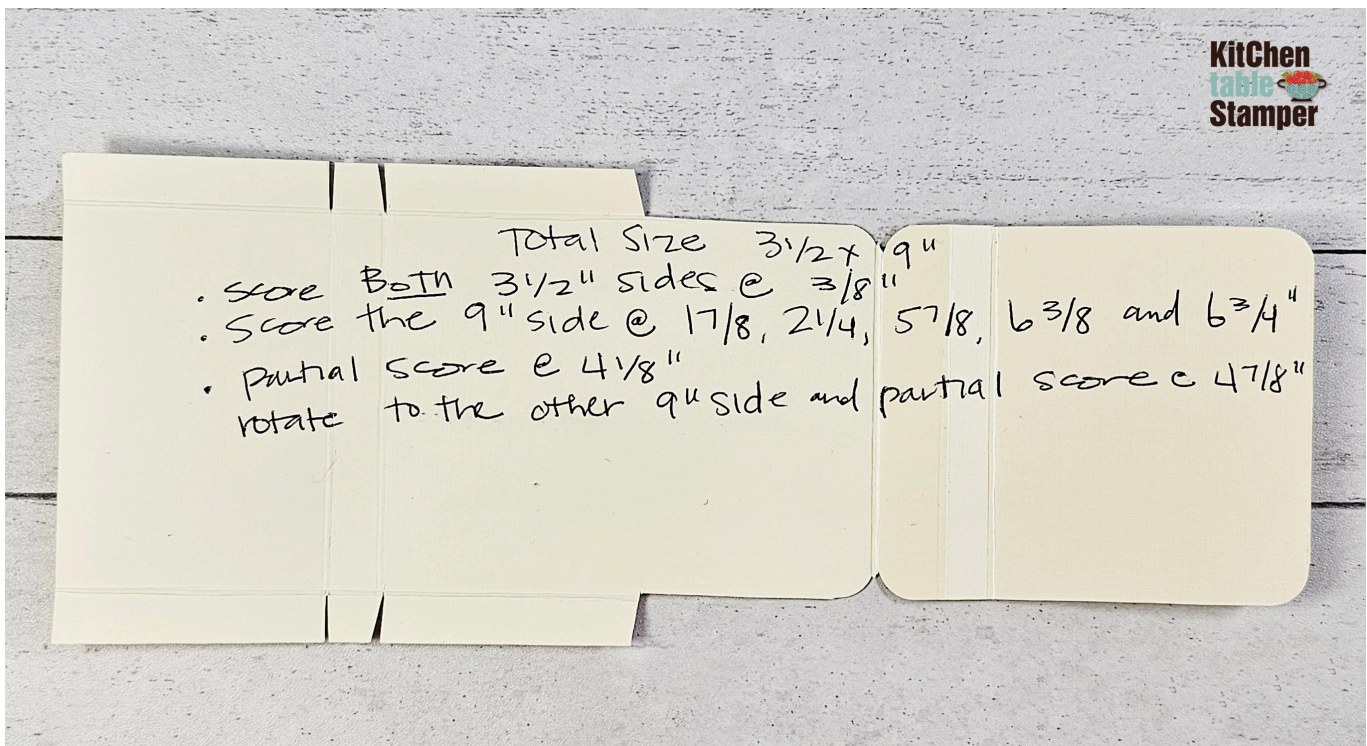

Measurements

- **Strawberry Slush Cardstock**
 - 3-1/2 x 9"
 - scored on BOTH 3-1/2" sides at 3/8"
 - scored on the 9" side at 1-7/8, 2-1/4, 5-7/8, 6-3/8 and 6-3/4"
 - partial score at 4-1/8"
 - rotate to the other 9" side and partial score at 4-7/8"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a Kissing Bear and a honey jar using the Valentine Kisses Bundle
 - scrap for die cutting a 1-7/8" postage edge square using the Stylish Shapes Dies
 - scrap for punching an arrow banner using the Three Banner Punch
- **Flirty Flamingo Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching an arrow banner using the Three Banner Punch
- **Real Read Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a heart using the Valentine Kisses Dies
- **Love Notes Designer Series Paper**
 - 2-5/8 x 3-1/2"
 - 2-5/8 x 2-1/8"
 - 2-5/8 x 1-3/4"
 - 2-5/8 x 3/8"
- **Strawberry Slush Faux Linen Ribbon**
 - about 13"
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 8"



Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the treat box then trim according to the template.
Assemble the treat box using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
2. Round the corners of the hang tab on the top of the box and the bottom corners of the front flap using a Corner Chomper. Round the top and bottom corners of the corresponding designer papers too.
3. Adhere the designer series paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Pop a couple of tea bags in the pocket and close the box using a Velcro dot.
5. Stamp the greeting left of center on the Basic White arrow banner using Tuxedo Black Memento ink then trim the Basic White and Flirty Flamingo arrow banner down. I trimmed about 1/2" off the blunt end.
6. Glue the two banners together and punch a 1/8" hole making the arrows into a matted tag. Thread with Linen Thread and tie a tiny bow.
7. Stamp the bear and honey jar on white cardstock using Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
8. Adhere the white square to the Strawberry Slush postage edge square using liquid glue then adhere the square to the box using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Adhere the bear, Real Red heart and sentiment tag followed by the honey jar using Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Embellish with Tiny Bee Trinkets.
11. Punch a 1/8" circle hole in the top tab of the box.
12. Thread front to back with Strawberry Slush Ribbon through the 1/8" circle hole in the top tab. Wrap the ribbon around the honey spoon then thread the ribbon back through the hole in the box tab from the back to the front. A floss threader makes this easy. Both ends of the ribbon should be out the front of the box tab with the honey spoon looped in. Tie a big loopy bow to secure the spoon to the box.
