Stamp a Stack Tip

Ready for a fun twist on Wonder Recipe #1 that will make more cards faster - no matter what stamp set or bundle you are using? Let's combine this one sheet wonder style Stamp a Stack with our new Cut & Mix Cards concept.

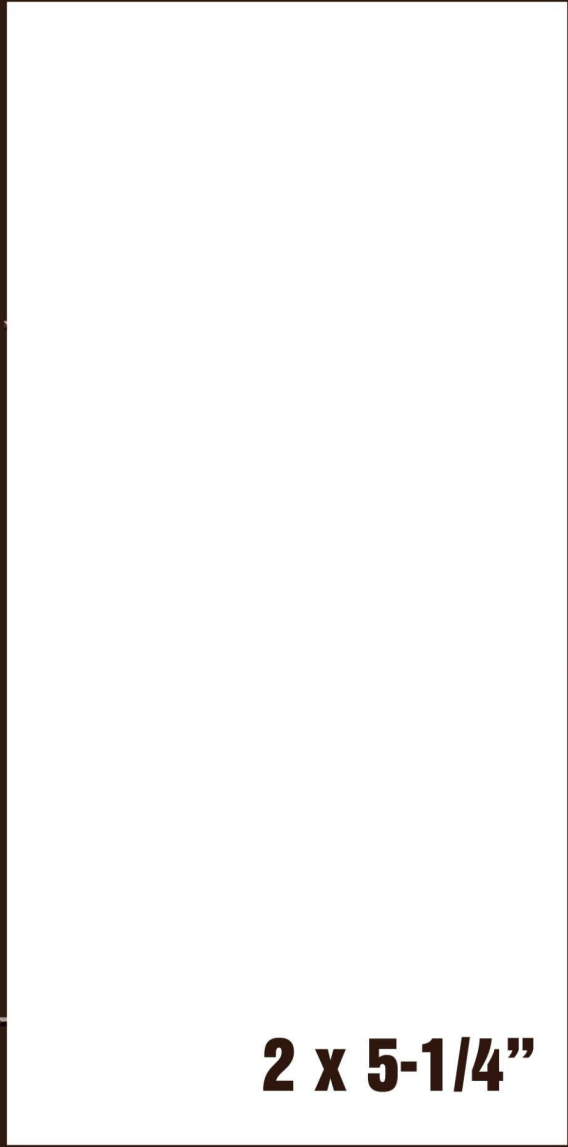
First, cut TWO 6 x 6" pieces of designer paper according to Wonder Recipe #1. Then cut 1" off of each of the 4 x 3" pieces and 3/4" off of each of the 2 x 5-1/4" pieces, then mix!

This fun Wonder Recipe Cut & Mix Card Class makes TWO each of three designs.

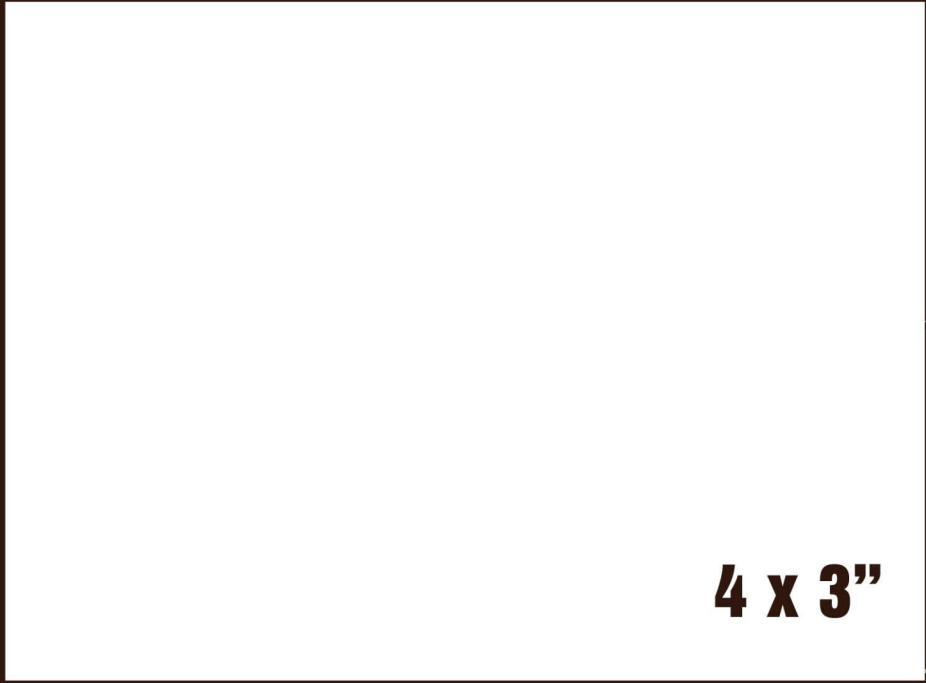

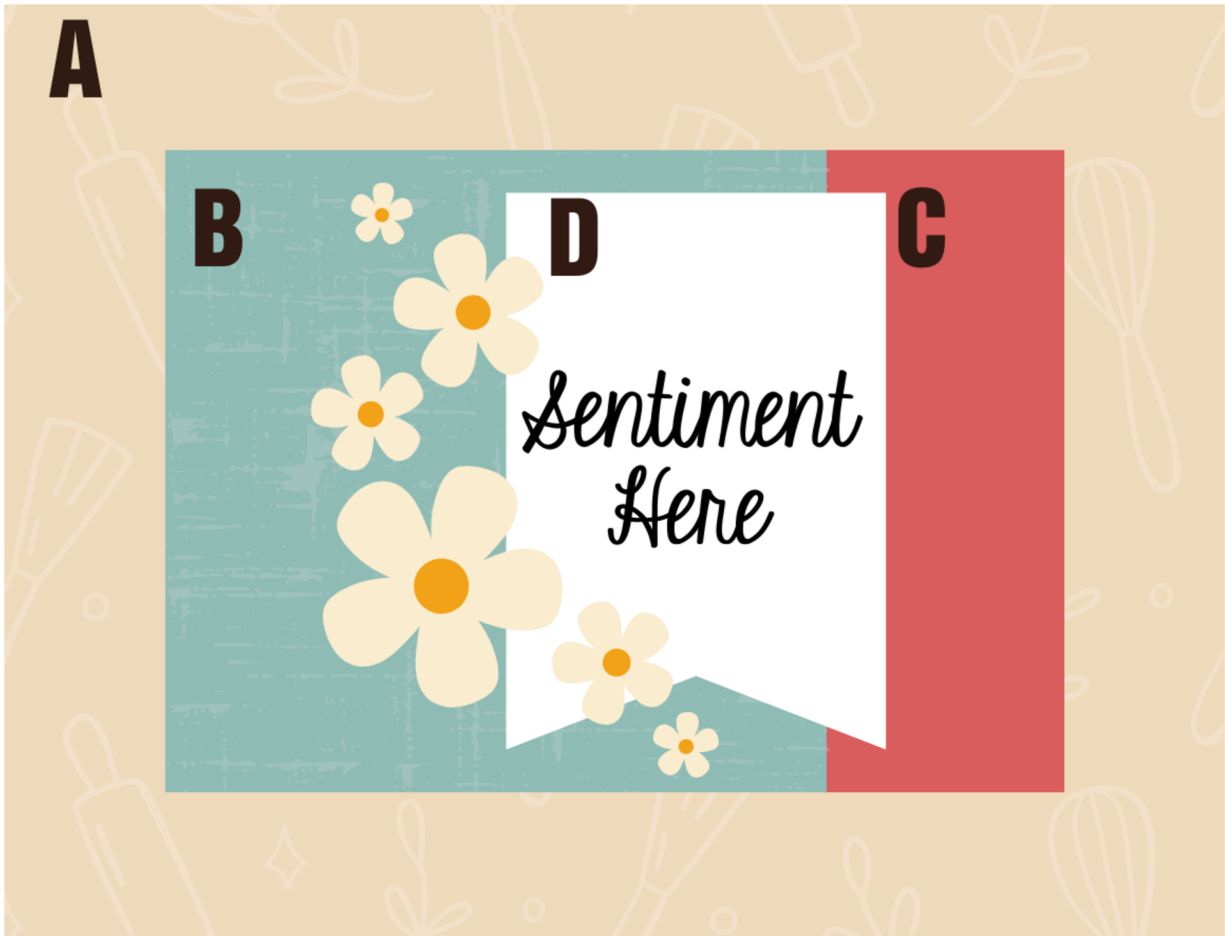

Measurements

- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White and Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting ONE arch of each color using the Creative Haven Bundle
- **Basic White and Petal Pink**
 - scraps for die cutting TWO large and THREE small flowers of each color using the Flowers of Beauty Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO leaves for each card using the Creative Haven Dies
- **Lovely Blossoms Designer Series Paper**
 - TWO 3 x 3"
 - TWO 1 x 3"
- **Petal Pink Braided Trim**
 - about 11" separated in strands - use TWO

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish TWO Cloud Cover card bases using a Bone Folder.
2. Emboss the card fronts using the Joined Together 3D Embossing Folder.
3. Adhere the designer paper to the card fronts using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the sentiment from the Creative Haven Stamp Set on the scraps of Basic White and Basic Beige cardstock using Secret Sea ink.
5. Die cut the greetings using the arch from the Creative Haven Dies. Adhere one greeting to each of the cards using Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Adhere TWO leaves to each card using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Tie TWO big loopy double bows using two strands each of the Braided Trim. Adhere a bow to each of the cards using a Mini Glue Dot.
8. Adhere the flowers to the cards using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Embellish with Neutral Matte Dots.
10. Which do you like better? Beige greeting with white flowers or white greeting with pink flowers?

Cool People Exclusive Card Sketch #25



Measurements

- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White and Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting ONE rectangle tag of each color using the Creative Haven Bundle
- **Basic White and Petal Pink**
 - scraps for die cutting TWO large and THREE small flowers of each color using the Flowers of Beauty Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO leaves for each card using the Creative Haven Dies
- **Lovely Blossoms Designer Series Paper**
 - TWO 3 x 3"
 - TWO 1 x 3"
- **Petal Pink Braided Trim**
 - about 11" separated in strands - use TWO

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish TWO Cloud Cover card bases using a Bone Folder.
2. Emboss the card fronts using the Joined Together 3D Embossing Folder.
3. Adhere the designer paper to the card fronts using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the sentiment from the Creative Haven Stamp Set on the Basic White and Basic Beige rectangle tags using Secret Sea ink.
5. Thread each tag with two strands each of the Braided Trim and tie a big loopy double bow.
6. Roll the top right corner of the tags just a little bit and then adhere one greeting tag to each of the cards using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Adhere TWO leaves to each card using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Adhere the flowers to the cards using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Embellish with Neutral Matte Dots.
10. Which do you like better? Beige greeting with white flowers or white greeting with pink flowers?

Measurements

- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White and Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting ONE large fishtail banner of each color using the Creative Haven Bundle
- **Basic White and Petal Pink**
 - scraps for die cutting THREE large and TWO small flowers of each color using the Flowers of Beauty Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO leaves for each card using the Creative Haven Dies
- **Lovely Blossoms Designer Series Paper**
 - TWO 1-1/4 x 5-1/4"
 - TWO 3/4 x 5-1/4"
- **Petal Pink Braided Trim**
 - about 11" separated in strands - use TWO

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish TWO Cloud Cover card bases using a Bone Folder.
2. Emboss the card fronts using the Joined Together 3D Embossing Folder.
3. Adhere the designer paper to the card fronts using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the sentiment from the Creative Haven Stamp Set on the scraps of Basic White and Basic Beige cardstock using Secret Sea ink.
5. Die cut the greetings using the large fishtail banner from the Creative Haven Dies. Adhere one greeting to each of the cards using Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Adhere TWO leaves to each card using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Tie TWO big loopy double bows using two strands each of the Braided Trim. Adhere a bow to each of the cards using a Mini Glue Dot.
8. Adhere the flowers to the cards using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Embellish with Neutral Matte Dots.
10. Which do you like better? Beige greeting with white flowers or white greeting with pink flowers?
