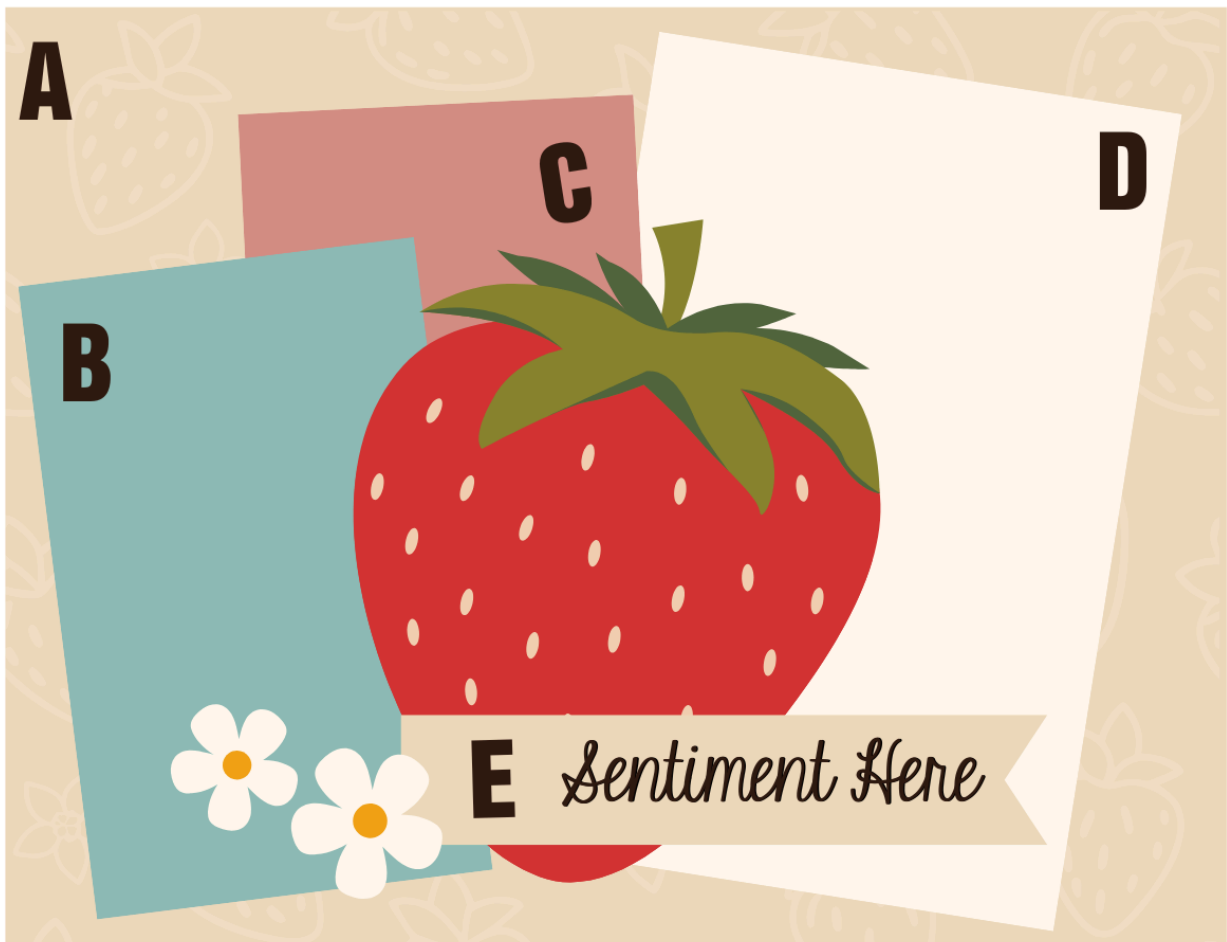
## Stamp a Stack Tip

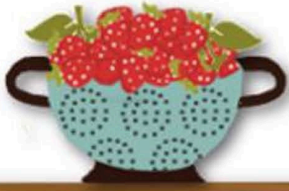

## For You Basket

### Cool People Exclusive Card Sketch #26



### Measurements

- **Shy Shamrock Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the grass and stem using the Easter Basket Bundle
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - 2-5/8 x 3-3/4"
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the bunny, TWO carrots, an egg and a chick using the Easter Basket Bundle
  - scrap for die cutting a tag using the Birthday Celebration Dies
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a basket and strips to weave using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Pretty in Pink Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the scallop piece using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Lemon Lolly Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the daffodil using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Peach Pie Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the daffodil using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Balmy Blue Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the scallop piece using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Easter Joy Designer Series Paper**
  - TWO 1-1/2 x 3"
- **Pack Your Bags Twine Three Pack**
  - about 20"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Shy Shamrock card base. Stamp the card front using the Lasting Linen stamp using Shy Shamrock ink.
2. Emboss the 2-5/8 x 3-3/4" white panel using the Lovely Stripes 3D Embossing Folder. Roll the top right corner and secure with a Stampin' Dimensional.
3. Wrap the twine around the embossed panel two times and make a bow.
4. Cut three scallops off the Balmy Blue scallop piece and adhere it to the back of the embossed white panel using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
5. Adhere the embossed white panel and the designer papers to the card using liquid glue.
6. Stamp the bunny, TWO carrots, an egg and a chick using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
7. Weave four strips of Crumb Cake cardstock in to the basket then cut off the handle. Reattach the handle one segment lower so that the basket is a little shorter. Use liquid glue and glue the handle to the back of the basket.
8. Adhere the Pretty in Pink scallops to the basket using liquid glue.
9. Trim the bunnies arms using your Paper Snips and hang the bunny with his arms over the edge of the basket. Put a bit of liquid glue on the back of bunny's arms to secure him to the basket.
10. Glue the grass to the back of the basket and then adhere the basket to the card using a combination of Stampin' Dimensionals and liquid glue.
11. Stamp the "for you" greeting on the white tag using the masking technique and Memento ink. Adhere the tag to the basket using liquid glue.
12. Add a bit of color to the daffodil pieces using Stampin' Blends Markers then pop the Peach Pie daffodil bit on to the Lemon Lolly flower using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
13. Cut a Shy Shamrock leaf off the stem. Adhere the leaf and flower to the card using Mini Glue Dots.
14. Tuck some carrots into the basket using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
15. Adhere the egg and chick using Stampin' Dimensionals.
16. Embellish using Iridescent Pearls Basic Jewels.

## For You



### Measurements

- **Shy Shamrock Cardstock**
  - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the grass and stem using the Easter Basket Bundle
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - 2-1/8 x 3-1/2"
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the bunny, TWO carrots, a flower and a chick using the Easter Basket Bundle
  - scrap for punching the arrow banner using the Three Banner Punch
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - scrap for punching a circle using the 2-1/4" Circle Punch
- **Pretty in Pink Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the scallop piece using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Lemon Lolly Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the daffodil using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Peach Pie Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the daffodil using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Easter Joy Designer Series Paper**
  - TWO 1-1/2 x 3"
- **Pack Your Bags Twine Three Pack**
  - about 24"
- **White Fluffy Trim**
  - just a bit

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Shy Shamrock card base. Stamp the card front using the Lasting Linen stamp using Shy Shamrock ink.
2. Emboss the 2-1/8 x 3-1/2" white panel using the Lovely Stripes 3D Embossing Folder. Roll the top right corner and secure with a Stampin' Dimensional.
3. Trim 1/4" off of the blunt end of the Basic White banner then stamp the "for you" greeting on the white tag using Memento ink. Punch a 1/8" hole in the pointy end of the arrow banner making a tag.
4. Wrap the twine around the embossed panel two times and make a knot at the top.
5. Adhere the designer papers along with the embossed white panel and the Crumb Cake circle using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
6. Stamp the bunny, TWO carrots, a flower and a chick using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
7. Cut a thumb notch, or a "D" out of the edge of the fluffy white trim. Put a Mini Glue Dot on the back rounded edge of the trim then adhere it to the bunny tail. Trim off the excess on the flat side so that the trim fills the tail but you can still see the stamped outline.
8. Glue one of the colored carrots to the bunny using a bit of liquid glue.
9. Add a bit of color to the daffodil pieces using Stampin' Blends Markers then pop the Lemon Lolly daffodil bit on to the Peach Pie flower using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
10. Adhere the bunny, remaining carrot, chick and flower using a combination of Stampin' Dimensionals and Mini Glue Dots. Adhere the Pretty in Pink scallop piece and the grass to the card using liquid glue.
11. Thread one end of the twine through the hole in the greeting tag and make a bow. Secure the tag using Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Cut a Shy Shamrock leaf off the stem. Adhere the leaf and flower to the card using a combination of Mini Stampin' Dimensionals and Mini Glue Dots.
13. Embellish using Iridescent Pearls Basic Jewels.

## Easter's On Its Way



### Measurements

- **Shy Shamrock Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the grass using the Easter Basket Bundle
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - 3-1/2 x 2"
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the bunny, an egg, a bunch of flowers and a chick, plus and additional egg, carrot or tulip using the Easter Basket Bundle
  - scrap for die cutting the 2-1/8 x 7/8" double chicken lip banner using the More Messages Die
- **Balmy Blue Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the 1-5/8 x 2-7/8" arch using Everyday Arches Dies
- **Pretty in Pink Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the scallop piece using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Easter Joy Designer Series Paper**
  - 2 x 3"
  - 1-1/2 x 3"
- **Pack Your Bags Twine Three Pack**
  - about 24"
- **White Fluffy Trim**
  - just a bit

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Shy Shamrock card base. Stamp the card front using the Lasting Linen stamp using Shy Shamrock ink.
2. Emboss the 3-1/2 x 2" white panel using the Lovely Stripes 3D Embossing Folder. Roll the bottom right corner and secure with a Stampin' Dimensional.
3. Wrap the twine around the embossed panel two times and make a bow.
4. Adhere the embossed white panel along with the designer papers and the Balmy Blue arch to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
5. Stamp the bunny, a carrot, an egg, bunch of flowers and a chick using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
6. Cut a thumb notch, or a "D" out of the edge of the fluffy white trim. Put a Mini Glue Dot on the back rounded edge of the trim then adhere it to the bunny tail. Trim off the excess on the flat side so that the trim fills the tail but you can still see the stamped outline.
7. Adhere the additional egg, carrot or tulip to the bunny using liquid glue.
8. Adhere the grass to the bottom of the arch using liquid glue. Adhere the Pretty in Pink scallop piece below the grass using the same adhesive.
9. Adhere the bunny, an egg, a flower bunch and a chick using a combination of Stampin' Dimensionals and liquid glue.
10. Stamp the greeting on the white banner using Memento ink. Adhere the banner to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. Embellish using Iridescent Pearls Basic Jewels.

## Hello Spring



### Measurements

- **Shy Shamrock Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the grass and a Leaf using the Easter Basket Bundle
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - 1-1/2 x 3-7/8"
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the small bunny, an egg, a Tulip, and a chick using the Easter Basket Bundle
  - scrap for die cutting the banner tag using the Endless Love Dies
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - scrap for punching a circle using the 2-1/4" Circle Punch
- **Balmy Blue Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the scallop piece using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Lemon Lolly Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the daffodil using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Peach Pie Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the daffodil cup using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Easter Joy Designer Series Paper**
  - 3 x 3"
  - 1-1/2 x 3"
- **Pack Your Bags Twine Three Pack**
  - about 8"
- **White Fluffy Trim**
  - just a bit

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Shy Shamrock card base. Stamp the card front using the Lasting Linen stamp using Shy Shamrock ink.
2. Emboss the 1-1/2 x 3-7/8" white panel using the Lovely Stripes 3D Embossing Folder. Roll the top right corner and secure with a Stampin' Dimensional.
3. Adhere the designer papers along with the embossed white panel and the Crumb Cake circle to the card front using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the small bunny, a tulip, an egg and a chick using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
5. Stamp the greeting on the white tag using Memento ink.
6. Adhere the grass to the top of the greeting tag using liquid glue. Adhere the Balmy Blue scallop piece to the bottom of the greeting tag, then adhere tag to the card using the same adhesive.
7. Adhere the small bunny, tulip, egg and chick using Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Add a bit of color to the daffodil pieces using Stampin' Blends Markers then pop the Peach Pie daffodil bit on to the Lemon Lolly flower using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
9. Adhere the stem to the tag using liquid glue, then adhere the flower to the card using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
10. Make a bow with the twine. Adhere the bow using a Mini Glue Dot.
11. Embellish using Iridescent Pearls Basic Jewels.
