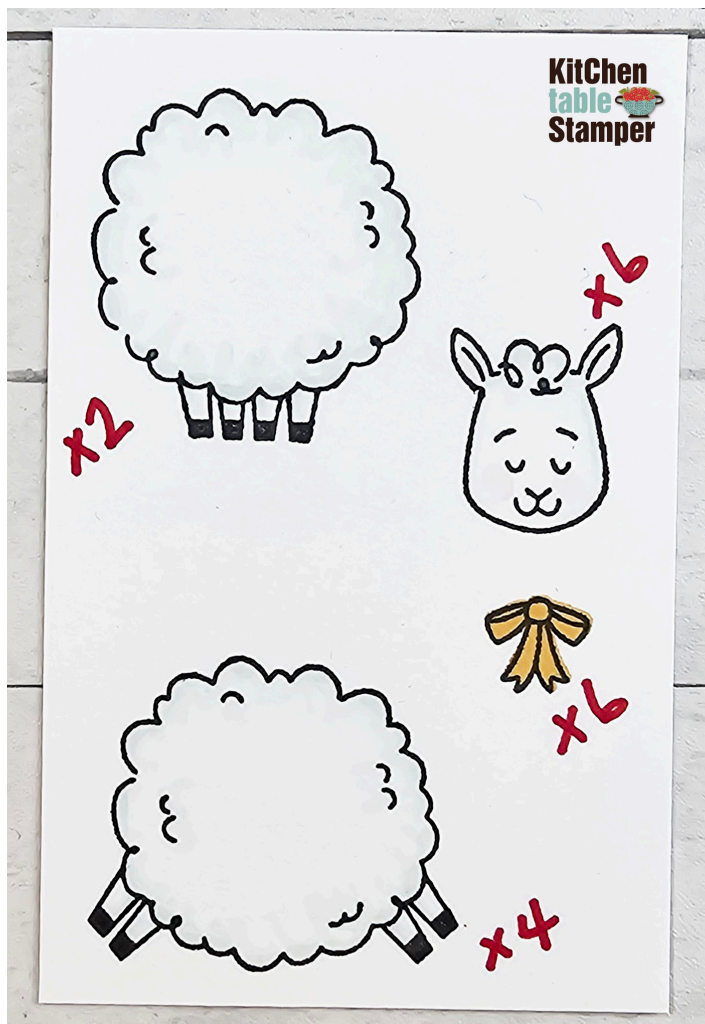

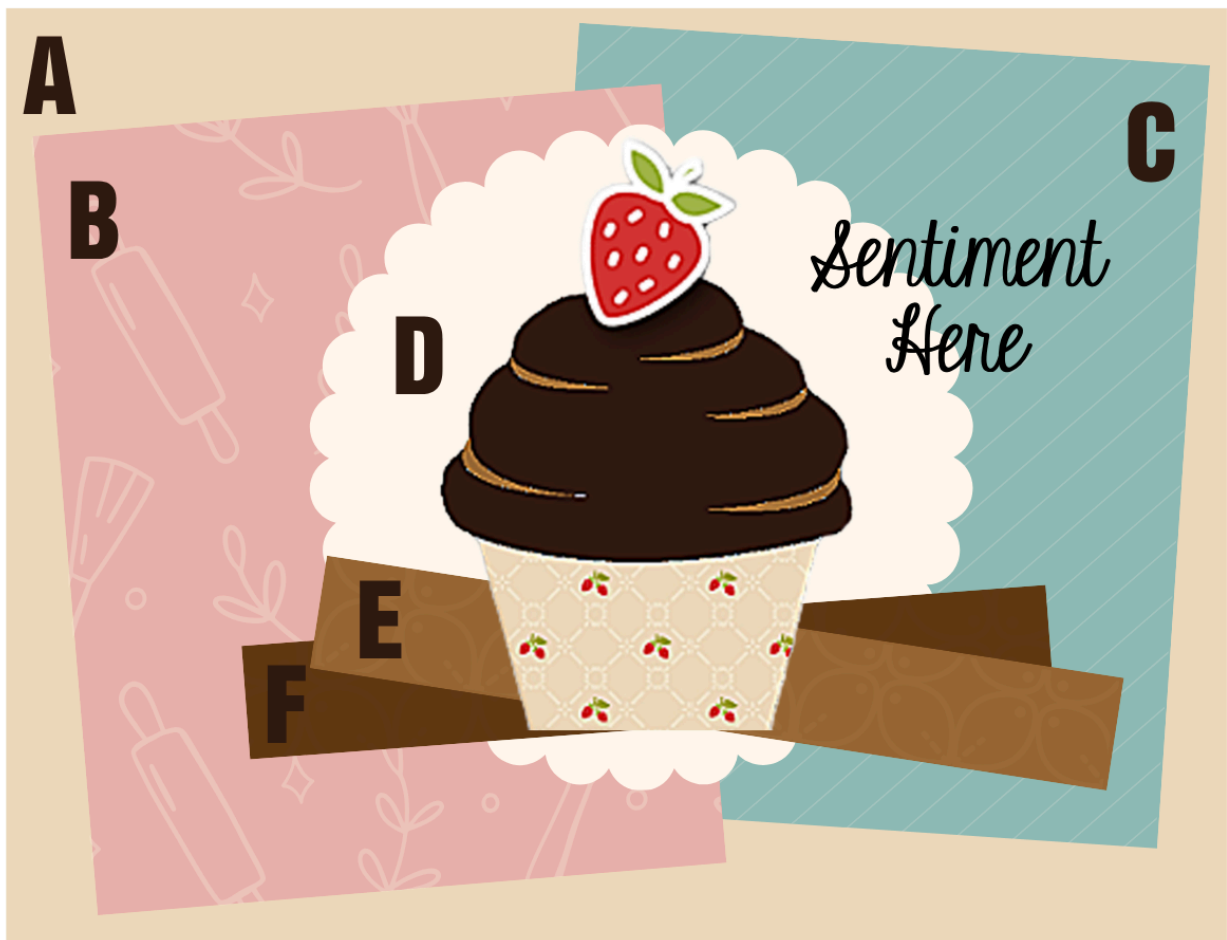

- A: 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- B: 2-3/4 x 3-1/2"
- C: 2-3/4 x 3-1/2"
- D: Any shape of your choice
- E: 3-1/2 x 1/2"
- F: 3-1/2 x 1/2"

The cupcake represents a focal image of your choice.



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EWE Make Me Happy



Measurements

- **Fresh Freesia Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and punching and fussy cutting the sheep face, body and bow using the Woolly Friends Bundle
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the greeting using the Woolly Friends Stamp Set
- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 2-1/8 x 3" banner using the Nested Essentials Dies
- **Peach Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the large flower using the Impressions Abloom Dies
- **Granny Apple Green Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the leaves using the Impressions Abloom Dies
- **Lovely & Beautiful Designer Series Paper**
 - TWO 3-1/2 x 1/2"
 - TWO 2-3/4 x 3-1/2"
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 14"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Fresh Freesia card base.
2. Emboss the Pool Party banner using the Birch Wood 3D Embossing Folder. Gently ink the embossed image using white ink. Allow time to dry.
3. Adhere the designer paper and the embossed Pool Party cardstock to the card using liquid glue.
4. Stamp the sheep's face, body and bow on a scrap of white cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
5. Color the sheep using Stampin' Blends and then punch the face and fussy cut the body.
6. Stamp the inside of the bow using Peach Pie ink and then punch.
7. Stamp the greeting two times on a scrap of Basic White cardstock. Bubble cut the word "happy" off of one of the greetings and then cut the second one to separate the two lines of text. Trim "EWE MAKE ME" ransom note style.
8. Adhere the sheep's body and greeting to the card using liquid glue.
9. Adhere the sheep's head and bow to the card using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Thread the button using Linen Thread and make a bow. Adhere the button to the flower using a Mini Glue Dot, then adhere the flower to the card using the same adhesive.
11. Adhere the leaves to the card using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Embellish using Starburst Sequins.





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You're Simply Fab-Ewe-Lous



Measurements

- **Fresh Freesia Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and punching and fussy cutting the sheep face, body and bow using the Woolly Friends Bundle
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the greeting using the Woolly Friends Stamp Set
- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the 2 x 2-3/4" postage rectangle using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Peach Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a medium and a small flower using the Delightful Wishes Dies
- **Granny Apple Green Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO leaves using the Gallery Blooms Dies
- **Lovely & Beautiful Designer Series Paper**
 - 3-1/2 x 3-1/2"
 - 1-1/4 x 3-1/2"
 - 1/2 x 3-7/8"
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 14"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Fresh Freesia card base.
2. Emboss the Pool Party postage stamp using the Birch Wood 3D Embossing Folder. Gently ink the embossed image using white ink. Allow time to dry.
3. Adhere the designer paper and the embossed Pool Party cardstock to the card using liquid glue.
4. Stamp the texture image on the Peach Pie flower using Peach Pie ink.
5. Use the capped putty end of your Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat to shape the flowers.
6. Thread the button using Linen Thread and make a bow. Adhere the button to the larger flower using a Mini Glue Dot, then adhere both of the flowers to the card using the same adhesive.
7. Adhere the leaves to the card using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Stamp the sheep's face, body and bow on a scrap of white cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
9. Color the sheep using Stampin' Blends and then punch the face and fussy cut the body.
10. Stamp the inside of the bow using Peach Pie ink and then punch.
11. Stamp the greeting on a scrap of Basic White cardstock and then cut to separate the two lines of text ransom note style.
12. Adhere the sheep's body and greeting to the card using liquid glue.
13. Adhere the sheep's head and bow to the card using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
14. Embellish using Starburst Sequins.





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Sending Flowers & Sunshine



Measurements

- **Fresh Freesia Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and punching the sheep face, body and bow using the Woolly Friends Bundle
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the greeting using the Woolly Friends Stamp Set
- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a circle using the 2-3/8" Circle Punch
- **Peach Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a large flower using the Lovely Arrangement Dies
- **Granny Apple Green Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting both detail leaves using the Lovely Arrangement Dies
- **Lovely & Beautiful Designer Series Paper**
 - 3-1/4 x 4-1/2"
 - 3-1/2 x 4-3/4"
 - TWO 1/2 x 3"
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 14"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Fresh Freesia card base.
2. Emboss the Pool Party circle using the Birch Wood 3D Embossing Folder. Gently ink the embossed image using white ink. Allow time to dry.
3. Adhere the designer paper and the embossed Pool Party cardstock to the card using liquid glue.
4. Stamp the texture image on the Peach Pie flower using Peach Pie ink.
5. Use the capped putty end of your Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat to shape the flower.
6. Thread the button using Linen Thread and make a bow. Adhere the button to the flower using a Mini Glue Dot, then adhere the flower to the card using the same adhesive.
7. Adhere the leaves to the card using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Stamp the sheep's face, body and bow on a scrap of white cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
