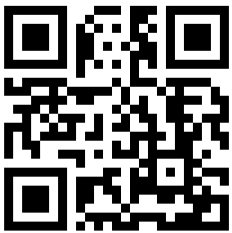

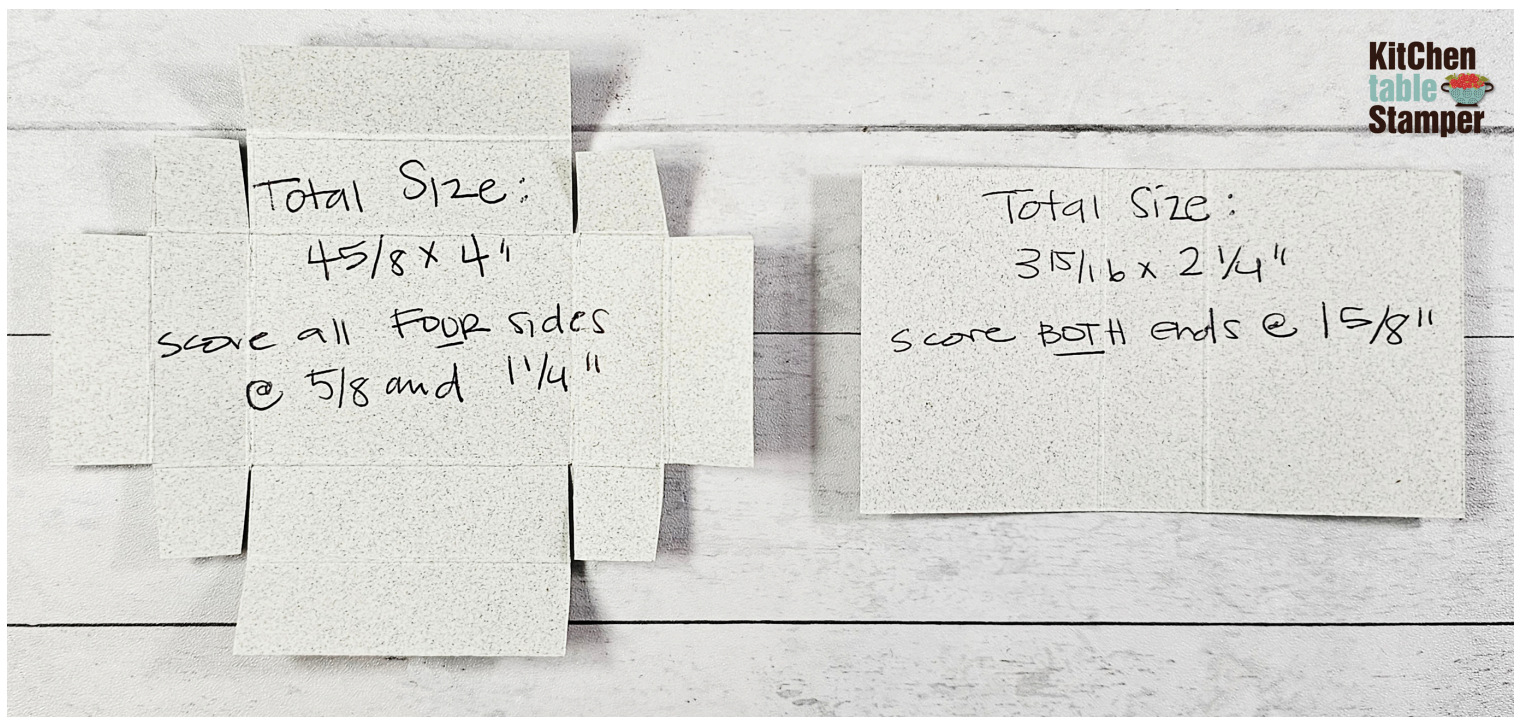

Measurements

- **Azure Afternoon Cardstock**
 - 4-5/8 x 4"
 - score all FOUR sides at 5/8 and 1-1/4"
 - 3-15/16 x 2-1/4"
 - score both ends at 1-5/8"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the bunny using the Notes of Spring Stamp Set
 - scrap for die cutting the 1-3/8" postage stamp using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Blueberry Bushel Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the short narrow banner using Stylish Shapes Dies
- **Crushed Curry Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO flowers using the Bright Skies Dies
- **Berry Burst Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching TWO circles using a 1/4" circle punch
- **Shy Shamrock Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a sprout using the Bright Skies Dies
 - scrap for die cutting TWO grass using the Easter Basket Dies
- **Bloom Impressions Designer Series Paper**
 - 2-1/8 X 1-1/2" - outside of box
 - 2 x 1-3/8" - inside of box
 - 1-3/16" square
- **Balmy Blue Sheer Ribbon**
 - about 18"



Instructions

1. Score, fold, burnish and trim the two part Azure Afternoon treat box. Assemble the inner box using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
2. Adhere the smaller rectangle of designer series paper to the inside of the inner box using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Adhere the inner box to the wrapper using Tear & Tape Adhesive. Be sure to center the inner box right to left and line up the back edge of the inner box against the bottom back score inside the wrapper
4. Wrap the ribbon around the box and tie a bow to close.
5. Secure the ribbon to the top of the box using Tear & Tape Adhesive, then use more Tear & Tape Adhesive to adhere the the 2-1/8 X 1-1/2" piece of designer paper to the top of the box.
6. OPTIONAL: Untie the bow and cut the ends of the ribbon in half hot dog wise stopping when you reach the box.
7. Cut the Blueberry Bushel double banner in half.
8. Adhere the square piece of designer paper to the white postage square. Adhere both halves of the double banner to the back of the postage square using liquid glue. Adhere to the top of the box using the same adhesive.
9. Adhere the Berry Burst flower centers to the Crushed Curry flowers using liquid glue.
10. Stamp the bunny on a scrap of white cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Fussy cut.
11. Adhere the Shy Shamrock grass, sprout, bunny and flower to the top of the box using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Adhere the second grass and flower inside of the box using liquid glue.
13. Embellish using the Purple Adhesive-Backed Sequins.
14. Place treat inside the box and re-tie the double bow.
